01.17.12 GUARD 1-Can we take that as a fold?

01.20.11 GUARD 2 (OS)-Just finish the hand. She's out.

01.36.22 GUARD 1-What the...?

01.44.21 GUARD 1-Whoa!

01.51.27 GUARD 3-I take it this has never happened before...

02.15.08 GUARD 1-What are you doin'?

02.41.21 GUARD 1 (OS)-What are you doing?! Don't touch it!

02.59.09 GUARD 1-Hold your fire! (beat) Identify! Hold it!

03.10.07 GUARD 1 (OS CONT)-Identify yourself!

03.23.13 APOPHIS (DISTORTED)-Jaffa! Kree!

03.30.08 APOPHIS (OS CONT DISTORTED)-Teal'c! Kree!

03.35.04 GUARD 3-Get your hands off me!

03.44.08 GUARD 1-Let her go!!

04.10.15 APOPHIS (DISTORTED)- (unintelligible), Jaffa!

04.11.27 GUARD 2 (OS CONT INTO PHONE)-We're under fire down here!
We need --

04.29.05 APOPHIS (DISTORTED)- (unintelligible)

04.31.29 SOLDIER IN COMMAND-Go! Go! (unintelligible)

04.58.28 GENERAL HAMMOND-Hold your fire!

07.03.17 SOLDIER (OS)-There's a ladder over here.

07.18.18 MAJOR SAMUELS-Colonel Jack O'Neill?

07.20.07 O'NEILL-Retired.

07.22.05 MAJOR SAMUELS-I'm Major Samuels.

07.23.26 O'NEILL-Air Force?

07.26.04 MAJOR SAMUELS-Yes, sir. I'm the General's Executive Officer.

07.29.16 O'NEILL-Want a little piece of advice, Major?

07.32.16 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-Get re-assed...

07.33.03 O'NEILL (CONT)-to NASA. That's where all the action's gonna be. Out there.

07.41.14 MAJOR SAMUELS-I'm, uh, I'm under orders to bring you to see General Hammond, sir.

07.44.18 O'NEILL-Never heard of him.

07.45.22 MAJOR SAMUELS (OS)-He replaced General West. He says it's important. Has to do with "The Stargate".

08.35.25 MALE ANNOUNCER (VO FILTERED)-Tag team number nine to sub-level two, bed shaft twenty-four...

08.44.11 MAJOR SAMUELS-We have to take a second elevator the rest of the way, sir. It's a long way down.

08.48.22 O'NEILL-Yeah, I know. I've been here before.

08.52.23 MAJOR SAMUELS-Ah. Of course.

09.05.18 OTHER OFFICER-This way, sir.

09.19.10 GENERAL HAMMOND-Come.

09.21.02 MAJOR SAMUELS-General Hammond: Colonel Jack O'Neill.

09.24.07 O'NEILL-Retired.

09.25.23 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-I can see that.

09.27.17 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-Me, I'm on my last tour. Time to start getting my thoughts together, maybe write a book. You ever think of writing a book about your exploits in the line of duty?

09.35.13 O'NEILL-I've thought about it. But then I'd have to shoot anyone that actually read it. (beat) That's a joke, sir. Most of my work the past ten years was classified.

09.49.03 GENERAL HAMMOND-Yes, of course.

09.52.09 O'NEILL-Major Samuels mentioned something about the Stargate.

09.54.18 GENERAL HAMMOND-Down to business. I can do that. This way...

10.07.15 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-Anyone you know, Colonel?

10.08.26 DOCTOR-They're not human.

10.10.24 O'NEILL-You think?

10.13.08 DOCTOR-Best we can tell, these slits are actually a
pouch, similar to that found on a marsupial.

10.18.09 MAJOR SAMUELS (OS)-Like a kangaroo.

10.19.22 DOCTOR (OS)-We haven't done an autopsy yet.

10.22.08 GENERAL HAMMOND-These people, or aliens -- whatever you
wanna call them -- came through, killed four of my
people and kidnapped another, using advanced
weapons.

10.33.13 O'NEILL-Weapons, sir?

10.37.20 MAJOR SAMUELS-We can't figure out how they operate.

10.47.28 GENERAL HAMMOND-Seen one before, I take it?

- 10.49.14 O'NEILL-Yes, sir. But there are no creatures like this on Abydos. Those people were human. They were from Earth. Ra brought 'em there thousands of years ago.
- 10.59.02 GENERAL HAMMOND-I know all about that. But your report said this Ra was in fact some kind of alien that lived inside a human body.
- 11.07.02 O'NEILL-Yeah. His eyes glowed; that was our first clue.
- 11.15.15 GENERAL HAMMOND-Are you sure he's dead, Colonel?
- 11.17.08 O'NEILL-Unless he could survive a tactical nuclear warhead blowin' up in his face, I'm positive. Why?
- 11.24.12 GENERAL HAMMOND-Colonel, these people -- or whatever they are -- were guarding another man who retreated back...
- 11.31.03 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-through the Stargate.
- 11.33.19 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-I got a good look at his eyes, Colonel. They glowed.
- 11.41.12 GENERAL HAMMOND (VO)-How do you feel about...
- 11.41.26 GENERAL HAMMOND-the Stargate mission after all this time, Colonel?

11.44.24 O'NEILL-How do you mean?

11.46.15 GENERAL HAMMOND-Well, it's been over a year. Has your...

11.47.22 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-perspective changed?

11.49.15 O'NEILL-Well, sir, I --... (beat) Was that...?

12.00.04 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-Kawalsky and Ferretti, yes. They
were under your...

12.01.14 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-command on the first Stargate
mission. Tell me about Daniel Jackson, Colonel...

12.07.05 O'NEILL-Why are they questioning my men?

12.09.09 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-They're not your men anymore,
Colonel. You retired.

12.12.09 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-Daniel Jackson...?

12.15.27 O'NEILL-You read the report?

12.17.03 GENERAL HAMMOND-Yes.

12.17.20 O'NEILL-It's all there.

12.18.23 MAJOR SAMUELS-Is it?

12.23.09 O'NEILL-What's this all about, General?

12.24.14 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-You didn't like...

12.24.20 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-Daniel Jackson, did you?

12.26.02 O'NEILL (OS)-Daniel was a scientist.

12.28.16 O'NEILL (CONT)-He sneezed a lot. Basically, he was a
geek, sir.

12.32.17 MAJOR SAMUELS-So you didn't have a lot of time for him?

12.34.03 O'NEILL (OS)-I didn't say that.

12.35.19 O'NEILL (CONT)-He also saved my life and found the way
home for my men and me. A little thing like that
kinda makes a person grow on you. Know what I mean?

12.42.11 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-According to the mission brief,
your...

12.43.21 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-orders were to go through the
Stargate, to detect any possible threat to Earth,
and if found, to detonate a nuclear device and
destroy the gate on the other side.

12.54.11 O'NEILL-Yes.

12.55.19 MAJOR SAMUELS (OS)-But that's not what...

- 12.55.28 MAJOR SAMUELS (CONT)-you did, is it?
- 12.57.14 O'NEILL-Not right away. Ra's forces overpowered my team,
and took the weapon before I could arm it.
- 13.04.20 MAJOR SAMUELS-But -- with Dr. Jackson's help -- you
eventually regained control, and did, in fact,
detonate the weapon, yes?
- 13.10.07 O'NEILL-Yes.
- 13.11.01 GENERAL HAMMOND-So, to the best of your knowledge, Daniel
Jackson and everyone else you knew on Abydos is
dead, correct?
- 13.20.04 O'NEILL-That's correct.
- 13.21.29 GENERAL HAMMOND-Good. Then you won't mind if I authorize
a go-ahead on our plan.
- 13.34.08 GENERAL HAMMOND (VO)-This...
- 13.34.15 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-quartz material the Stargates are
made of -- it must be tough stuff if it can
withstand a Mark 3.

13.41.09 O'NEILL-Well, we sent a robot probe through after we got back, sir. It was flattened on the other end. Obviously, the Abydos Stargate had been buried in the rubble.

13.50.07 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-But somehow, it got unburied.

14.00.28 O'NEILL-Oh my God... (beat) You're sending another bomb?

14.10.20 GENERAL HAMMOND-Mark five this time. If these creatures did re-open the Abydos gate, we intend to reseal it for good.

14.20.27 O'NEILL-General... you can't do that...

14.25.03 GENERAL HAMMOND-Countdown's already started. Unless you have something to add...

14.42.22 O'NEILL-General Hammond?

14.44.09 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-Sir?

14.50.10 O'NEILL (CONT)-I regret to inform you that my report was not entirely accurate.

14.54.22 GENERAL HAMMOND-You didn't detonate the bomb...

- 14.56.02 O'NEILL-Oh, I did detonate the bomb. And it was aboard Ra's spacecraft. So it did kill him and eliminate the risk to Earth.
- 15.01.10 MAJOR SAMUELS-However...?
- 15.02.10 O'NEILL-However... Ra's ship was in orbit above the planet at the time. Neither the gate nor anything else on the planet was destroyed. Daniel Jackson is alive and living with the people on Abydos.
- 15.16.26 GENERAL HAMMOND-You violated direct orders. Why?
- 15.18.18 O'NEILL-Because the people of Abydos are no threat to us. They deserve to be left alone.
- 15.21.15 GENERAL HAMMOND-That's not up to you --
- 15.22.18 O'NEILL-With all due respect, sir... If I'd come back here and reported the Gate on the other side was still intact, we would've sent another bomb. Just like you were about to. It wasn't necessary to let those people die. The threat from Ra was gone.
- 15.35.10 MAJOR SAMUELS-What about the probe we sent through? It was crushed instantly.

- 15.38.08 O'NEILL-After we came home, Daniel buried the Gate in rocks, making my return or anybody else's impossible.
- 15.44.06 GENERAL HAMMOND-Well, those four bodies lying in the infirmary say otherwise, Airman. (beat) We'll send the bomb through on schedule --
- 15.55.11 O'NEILL (overlapping)-General, you can't do that!
- 15.56.24 GENERAL HAMMOND-Oh, I can't?
- 15.57.22 O'NEILL (OS)-There are...
- 15.57.25 O'NEILL (CONT)-innocent people on that planet!
- 15.59.13 GENERAL HAMMOND-There are innocent people here! I have my orders too, Colonel. I obey mine. Take Colonel O'Neill to the Holding Room. Let's give him some time to think about things while I decide what to do with him.
- 16.14.20 MAJOR SAMUELS-Sergeant...
- 16.33.07 KAWALSKY-Colonel O'Neill, sir.
- 16.35.09 O'NEILL-I'm retired, Kawalsky. Lose the salute.

16.42.01 KAWALSKY-Me and Ferretti didn't tell them anything.

16.44.17 O'NEILL-I appreciate that.

16.46.27 KAWALSKY-Hey, those kids on Abydos saved my life, too.

16.50.09 O'NEILL-Yeah... The kids...

16.57.16 KAWALSKY-They're the whole reason that we kept the
secret.

17.00.06 KAWALSKY (OS CONT)-Right?

17.02.06 O'NEILL-Yeah.

17.04.23 KAWALSKY-That one kid idolized you. Remember him? Weird
name... What was it?

17.10.22 O'NEILL-Skaara.

17.12.21 KAWALSKY-Right. Remember how he was always saluting you?

17.18.14 O'NEILL-Yeah. My kid used to do that when he was little.
Skaara kinda reminded me of him.

17.27.21 KAWALSKY-Oh, man, Colonel... You and me went through that whole mission together. I never even knew you had a son.

17.37.22 O'NEILL-Well, he died... Just before the Abydos mission.

17.45.29 KAWALSKY-I'm sorry, sir. I had no idea.

17.58.07 GENERAL HAMMOND-How many people did you say are on Abydos?

18.01.24 O'NEILL-That we saw? Maybe... five thousand. (beat)
Does this mean you're reconsidering sending the bomb, sir?

18.13.12 GENERAL HAMMOND-It means I'm open to suggestions.

18.15.21 O'NEILL-General, let me take a team through that Gate.
We'll find out who those aliens are. Kawalsky and I...

18.21.21 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-have been there before. We know the lay of the land.

18.24.00 O'NEILL (CONT)-We know the people.

18.24.21 GENERAL HAMMOND-You think you know them. Jackson could be dead. You don't know what you'd be walking into...

18.28.24 O'NEILL-Sir, there is one way to find out...

18.35.13 GENERAL HAMMOND-Right. We'll have the prototype probe shipped...

18.38.28 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-from M.I.T.

18.40.01 O'NEILL (OS)-General...

18.40.28 O'NEILL (CONT)-We don't need that probe.

18.43.06 KAWALSKY-We don't?

18.43.28 O'NEILL (OS)-Nope.

18.45.25 O'NEILL (CONT)-This'll do.

19.06.09 WOMAN TECHNICIAN (OS)-Initiate (unintelligible) sequence...

19.07.00 TECHNICIAN (OS) (overlapping)- (unintelligible) images (unintelligible)...

19.07.24 SCREEN READS:
 SEQUENCE
 IN PROGRESS

19.08.26 TECHNICIAN (OS)-Roger.

19.09.27 TECHNICIAN (VO FILTERED)-Chevron four, encoded!

19.11.16 GENERAL HAMMOND-Care to explain this concept?

19.15.01 TECHNICIAN-Chevron five, encoded!

19.18.04 O'NEILL-Jackson has allergies.

19.20.11 KAWALSKY-I get it.

19.21.00 O'NEILL (OS)-He'll know this...

19.21.06 O'NEILL (CONT)-came from me, and not from someone -- with
 all due respect, sir -- like yourself.

19.37.05 SCREEN READS:
 SEQUENCE
 IN PROGRESS

19.23.21 TECHNICIAN (OS)-Chevron...

19.24.02 TECHNICIAN (CONT)-six encoded.

19.31.09 SCREEN READS:
 SEQUENCE
 COMPLETE

19.47.00 TECHNICIAN-Chevron seven,...

19.48.06 TECHNICIAN (OS CONT)-Lock.

20.10.00 TECHNICIAN-The, uh, object should reach final destination
 in five seconds.

20.14.29 TECHNICIAN (OS CONT)-Four... three... two... one...
 (beat) The object should now be through the Abydos
 Stargate.

20.25.15 GENERAL HAMMOND-Now what?

20.26.15 O'NEILL (OS)-Now we wait.

20.27.22 O'NEILL (CONT)-If Daniel's still around, he'll know what
 the message means.

20.30.29 MAJOR SAMUELS-What if the aliens get it?

20.33.04 O'NEILL-Well... they could be blowin' their noses right
 now...

20.36.18 MAJOR SAMUELS-They could be planning an attack.

20.38.14 O'NEILL (OS)-Aw, come on, Samuels. Let...

20.39.21 O'NEILL (CONT)-me be the cynic around here, okay? Sir,
this could take some time.

22.05.05 BOX READS:
THANKS

22.08.03 O'NEILL (OS)-Permission to take a...

22.08.22 O'NEILL (CONT)-team through the Stargate, sir?

22.10.18 GENERAL HAMMOND-Assuming I get the President's
authorization... The mission briefing will be at oh-
eight-hundred hours. Consider yourself recalled to
active duty, Colonel.

22.35.17 MAJOR SAMUELS (OS)-Ten hut!

22.39.10 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-Gentlemen, take your seats.

22.44.17 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-Where's Captain Carter?

22.46.01 MAJOR SAMUELS-Just arriving, sir.

22.47.13 O'NEILL-Carter?

22.48.10 GENERAL HAMMOND-I'm assigning Sam Carter to this mission.

22.50.18 O'NEILL-I'd prefer to put together my own team, sir.

22.52.17 GENERAL HAMMOND-Not on this mission. Sorry. Carter's
our expert on the Stargate.

22.56.28 O'NEILL-Where is he transferring from?

22.58.18 CARTER (OS)-She is transferring from the Pentagon.

23.07.10 CARTER (CONT)-I take it you're Colonel O'Neill. Captain
Samantha Carter reporting, sir.

23.13.27 KAWALSKY-But, of course, you go by "Sam".

23.16.11 CARTER-You don't have to worry, Major. I played with
dolls when I was a kid.

23.19.18 KAWALSKY-G.I. Joe?

23.20.22 CARTER-No, Major Matt Mason.

23.22.13 KAWALSKY-Oh. Who?

23.23.27 FERRETTI-Major Matt Mason -- Astronaut doll. Did you
have that cool little backpack...

23.27.05 FERRETTI (OS CONT)-that made him fly?

23.28.05 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-Let's get started.

- 23.29.15 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-Colonel?
- 23.30.17 O'NEILL-Thank you. For those of you on your first trip through the gate... You should be prepared for what to expect.
- 23.36.12 CARTER-I've practically memorized your report from the first mission. I'd like to think I've been preparing for this all my life.
- 23.42.08 KAWALSKY (OS)-I think what the Colonel is...
- 23.42.22 KAWALSKY (CONT)-saying is... Have you ever pulled out of a simulated bombing run in an F-16 at eight plus gees?
- 23.48.03 CARTER-Yes.
- 23.52.21 KAWALSKY-Well, it's way worse than that.
- 23.54.16 FERRETTI-By the time you get to the other side, you're frozen stiff, like you've just been through a blizzard, naked.
- 24.00.17 CARTER (OS)-That's a result of the...
- 24.01.02 CARTER (CONT)-compression your molecules undergo during the millisecond required for reconstitution.

24.05.07 O'NEILL (overlapping)-Oh, here we go...

24.06.17 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-Another scientist.

24.07.17 O'NEILL (CONT)-General... please.

24.09.02 CARTER-Theoretical astro-physicist.

24.11.14 O'NEILL-Which means...?

24.12.28 GENERAL HAMMOND-Which means she is smarter than you are,
Colonel. Especially in matters related to the
Stargate.

24.24.06 CARTER-Colonel, I was studying the gate technology for
two years before Daniel Jackson made it work and
before you both went through. I should have gone
through then. But, sir, you and your men might as
well accept the fact that I am going through this
time.

24.37.01 O'NEILL-Well, with all due respect, doctor, I --

24.39.11 CARTER (overlapping)-It is appropriate to refer to a
person by their rank,...

24.41.13 CARTER (OS CONT)-not their salutation.

24.43.16 CARTER (CONT)-You should call me Captain, not Doctor.

- 24.46.07 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-Captain Carter's assignment to this unit...
- 24.48.00 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-is not an option -- it's an order.
- 24.49.25 CARTER-I'm an Air Force officer just like you are, Colonel.
- 24.53.00 CARTER (OS CONT)-And just because my reproductive...
- 24.53.21 CARTER (CONT)-organs are on the inside instead of the outside doesn't mean I can't handle whatever you can handle.
- 25.04.18 O'NEILL-Oh, this has nothing to do with you being a woman. I like women. I've just got a little problem with scientists.
- 25.15.09 CARTER-Colonel, I logged over a hundred hours in enemy airspace during the Gulf War. Is that tough enough for you? (beat) Or are we gonna have to arm wrestle?
- 25.29.01 MAJOR SAMUELS-I hate to throw a damper on your enthusiasm,...
- 25.33.02 MAJOR SAMUELS (OS CONT)-but I still say the safest, most logical way to deal with this...
- 25.35.16 MAJOR SAMUELS (CONT)-is to bury the Stargate, just like the ancient Egyptians did --

- 25.39.18 MAJOR SAMUELS (OS CONT)-make it impossible for the aliens to return. It's the only way to eliminate the threat.
- 25.42.25 O'NEILL-Except it won't work.
- 25.43.24 GENERAL HAMMOND-It worked before.
- 25.44.25 O'NEILL-They know what we are now. They know how far we've come. We're a threat to them.
- 25.50.24 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-They've got ships, General.
- 25.52.13 O'NEILL (CONT)-Ra had one as big as the great pyramids. They don't need the Stargate to get here. They can do it the old-fashioned way. Now, with all due respect to Mr. Glass-is-half-empty over...
- 26.03.07 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-here, don't you think that maybe we should use the Stargate to...
- 26.06.02 O'NEILL (CONT)-do a little reconnaissance before they decide to come back? Again?
- 26.18.15 GENERAL HAMMOND-I'll give you exactly 24 hours to either return or send a message through -- no kleenex boxes, please. Otherwise, we'll assume the worst, and send a bomb through.
- 26.29.14 O'NEILL-Understood.

26.47.05 GENERAL HAMMOND-Try to follow orders this time, Colonel.

26.49.21 O'NEILL-Sir?

26.50.25 GENERAL HAMMOND-This time you bring Daniel Jackson back.
Is that clear?

26.54.03 O'NEILL-Yes, sir. (TO TROOPS) Move out!

27.13.09 O'NEILL-Captain...?

27.14.29 CARTER-Don't worry, Colonel. I won't let you down.

27.17.24 O'NEILL-Good. I was gonna say "ladies first"...

27.23.09 CARTER-You know, you really will like me when you get to
know me.

27.25.28 O'NEILL-Oh, I adore you already, Captain.

27.30.13 CARTER-My God...! Look at this... The energy the gate
must release to create a stable wormhole -- it's
astronomical, to use exactly the right word. (beat)
You can actually see the fluctuations in the event
horizon...

28.32.00 CARTER (OS)-Oh... I think I'm gonna be sick...

28.38.24 CARTER (CONT)-Ugh...

28.42.02 O'NEILL-Maybe you shouldn't have had that big lunch, huh?

29.12.24 DANIEL-Cha'hali! Cha'hali. Lower your guns. (beat)
Hello, Jack. Uh, welcome back.

29.47.16 O'NEILL-Skaara.

29.48.24 SKAARA-O'Neill. I did not think to be seeing you again.

30.00.05 O'NEILL-Daniel... How you doing?

30.01.25 DANIEL-Uh, good... You?

30.03.10 O'NEILL-Much better, now that I see everybody's okay.

30.06.06 FERRETTI-Greetings from Earth, Dr. Jackson.

30.08.18 DANIEL-Hello, Ferretti.

30.10.03 KAWALSKY-Brought you a little somethin', Daniel.

30.12.09 DANIEL-Kawalsky... (beat) Sha're...

30.19.12 DANIEL (OS CONT)-Don't be shy.

30.28.20 O'NEILL-Hi.

30.31.00 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-Good to see you again.

30.35.06 DANIEL-So, I figured it was only a matter of time before
you had to tell the truth about us still being here.

30.39.07 O'NEILL-Yeah. Why the militia? Has something else come
through?
