03.15.08 DOCTOR FRASIER (OS CONT)-Now, if we can learn about it, and safely duplicate its...

03.17.14 DOCTOR FRASIER (CONT)-effect, we can save lives on earth.

03.19.11 DANIEL-Without destroying Teal'c in the process.

03.22.07 GENERAL HAMMOND-Well, I guess the boys in Langley won't be able to study a Goa'uld after all.

03.27.04 TEAL'C-It is still a possibility.

- 03.30.01 CARTER-Teal'c, you can't. I mean, you don't have an immune system without your Goa'uld. We can't play with your life like that.

- 03.53.24 O'NEILL (OS) (overlapping)-We had to shoot...
- 03.54.18 O'NEILL (CONT)-our way out, maybe made a bad impression...
- 03.57.17 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-It's out of the question.
- 03.58.17 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-I can't authorize it.
- 04.06.16 TEAL'C-Then I will speak of it no further.

04.12.03 GENERAL HAMMOND-Dismissed.

04.16.17 DANIEL-What was that?

04.18.19 O'NEILL-I don't know. I'll find out.

04.35.11 O'NEILL-Mind if I...? Yeah... (beat) Look, I'm sorry if I didn't... You do understand why we can't go back to Chulak, right? (beat) They'll get that drug to work long before that thing dies inside of you.

05.06.09 TEAL'C (overlapping)-I am not concerned about my life. I am concerned for the life of my son.

05.13.14 O'NEILL-Your son?

05.15.15 TEAL'C-His name is Rya'c. I have not spoken of him... or of my wife.

05.28.00 O'NEILL-You left a family back there...? Ugh. Teal'c, you told the -- no, you swore to the General you had no ties back there. Why didn't you tell us the truth?

- 05.51.06 TEAL'C-A warrior becomes vulnerable if his family is held hostage to the enemy.
- 05.57.13 O'NEILL-You didn't think we'd trust you if we knew...  
Teal'c, how the hell are we supposed to trust you now? Huh? You got any more surprises?
- 06.10.10 TEAL'C-With or without you, O'Neill, I must return to Chulak.
- 06.15.05 O'NEILL-Either way it's suicide, my friend.
- 06.19.00 TEAL'C-Within days, my son will come of age.
- 06.22.05 TEAL'C (OS CONT)-He will be called to the religious life of our world.
- 06.25.03 TEAL'C (CONT)-He will undergo the ceremony of implantation -- the Prim'ta. The day when a young boy receives his first Goa'uld symbiote, and becomes a true Jaffa. Just as all of the Jaffa before him.
- 06.40.03 O'NEILL-I take it you don't want that to happen.

06.42.13           TEAL'C-It is the means by which the goa'uld enslave the Jaffa. I am not the only one among my people who believes this. My first teacher, the Jaffa master, Bra-tac, he knew very well the Goa'uld are false gods. But I cannot... I will not allow my son to become a slave.

- 07.30.21 DANIEL-The warrior Jaffa class are the foundation of Goa'uld power. They serve as both incubators for their young, and as their army. An army made almost invulnerable by the restorative powers of the Goa'uld larva they carry. I mean, it's, it's literally a Faustian bargain.

- 07.48.20 CARTER (CONT)-if we could undermine the loyalty of the very group the Goa'uld depend on to maintain their power.
- 07.53.11 GENERAL HAMMOND-How many of these other Jaffa can you be sure of?
- 07.56.05 O'NEILL-We're pretty sure of at least... one guy...
- 08.01.07 GENERAL HAMMOND-One?
- 08.02.05 DANIEL (OS)-Yes. And, and where...
- 08.03.07 DANIEL (CONT)-there's one, there has to be more than one.
- 08.08.01 GENERAL HAMMOND-Oh, absolutely.



08.10.11 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-Colonel, will you join me in  
my...

08.11.15 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-office a moment?

08.16.04 O'NEILL-Sure.

08.21.18 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-Shut the door. (beat) Have a seat,  
Jack. (beat) This is not my first barbecue,  
Colonel.

08.41.15 O'NEILL-Sir?

08.42.26 GENERAL HAMMOND-I'd love to get a Goa'uld larva that the  
labcoats in Langley can study. But I don't order my  
best people on a mission behind enemy lines unless I  
think it's absolutely necessary.

08.53.23 O'NEILL-I believe it is, sir.

08.55.03 GENERAL HAMMOND-Why? There's something you're not  
telling me, Colonel. If you don't want to...

08.58.13 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-to come clean about the real  
motivation behind this mission, then fine.

09.02.26 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-The mission is not approved. You  
will go...

09.04.28 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-where I tell you to go.

09.06.11 O'NEILL-Sir, please --

09.06.18 GENERAL HAMMOND (overlapping)-Dismissed!

09.20.21 O'NEILL-General... Teal'c has a son.

09.25.03 GENERAL HAMMOND-What did you say?

09.26.28 O'NEILL-Back on Chulak.

09.29.17 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-His kid's about to be implanted with  
one of those...

09.32.06 O'NEILL (CONT)-larva things at a ceremony, and Teal'c  
wants to stop it.

09.36.06 GENERAL HAMMOND-Why?

09.39.00 O'NEILL-"Why", sir?

09.40.17 GENERAL HAMMOND-Teal'c was an enemy soldier. He's  
compromised --

09.43.14 O'NEILL-General, he was afraid we wouldn't trust him if  
we knew he had a family back there. Was he right?  
(beat) When Teal'c saved our lives on Chulak, he  
gave up his family, sir. Don't you think we owe him  
something?

10.06.16 O'NEILL (OS)-Teal'c!

10.07.24 O'NEILL (CONT)-What are you doing?

10.08.20 GENERAL HAMMOND-Stand back from the keyboard!

10.11.08 TEAL'C-I am returning to Chulak for my son.

10.13.17 GENERAL HAMMOND-No. I'm sorry. I can't let you do that.

10.29.07 O'NEILL-C'mon, Teal'c... Don't do it this way.

10.33.13 TEAL'C-I risk no one's life but my own. Why will you not  
let me return?

10.38.09 GENERAL HAMMOND-You know far too much about this  
command,...

10.49.17 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-this facility, our defenses...

10.43.06 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-I can't let that kind of knowledge  
fall into enemy hands.

10.46.08 TEAL'C-I will die before allowing that to happen.

10.48.05 GENERAL HAMMOND-Dammit, Teal'c! That's just what's going to happen if you go through that gate alone! (beat) Which is why I'm inclined to authorize a mission to return to Chulak and allow you to bring your son back.

11.23.02 TEAL'C-Thank you, General Hammond.

11.28.00 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-When is this...

11.28.08 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-ceremony supposed to happen?

11.30.14 TEAL'C-Within the day.

11.44.24 CARTER-Daniel... glasses.

11.50.24 TEAL'C-O'Neill, I am in your debt.

11.53.13 O'NEILL-Aw, it's nothing.

11.57.07 TEAL'C-We shall return.

12.00.20 O'NEILL-Ready to ship out, sir.

12.03.11 GENERAL HAMMOND (ON RADIO FILTERED)-God speed, Colonel.

12.10.22 TECHNICIAN (OS)-Check (unintelligible)...

- 12.15.04 FEMALE TECHNICIAN (OS)-All systems check...
- 12.36.26 TEAL'C (OS)-These are scholars from the court of Apophis.  
I am to escort them to the temple.
- 12.41.13 HEAD PRIEST-Why do you not show your face, my Lord?
- 12.43.15 TEAL'C (OS)-My helmet was damaged in combat. It must be  
repaired.
- 12.48.02 HEAD PRIEST-Perhaps I can help...
- 12.50.10 TEAL'C (OS)-Nemeth kree! You dare touch me, Priest?  
(beat) I shall tell Apophis of your vigilance,  
Priest. You shall be rewarded.
- 13.43.06 TEAL'C (OS)-We will go directly to my former home. The  
ceremony should take place there.
- 13.48.14 O'NEILL-Alright, Teal'c... Show us the way.
- 14.17.06 O'NEILL (OS)-Teal'c... Is this your...?
- 14.20.11 TEAL'C (OS)-My former home.
- 14.22.14 TEAL'C (CONT)-A gift from Apophis for many years of  
service.

15.03.03 DANIEL-What does this mark mean? I don't recognize this.

15.05.27 TEAL'C-This was the home of shol'va.

15.10.11 DANIEL-Traitor.

15.15.19 O'NEILL-Well, it looks like this happened a long time ago.

16.13.27 TEAL'C-Tek'ma-te, Bra-tac!

16.20.15 BRA-TAC-Teal'c...!

16.22.00 TEAL'C-It is good to see you, friend.

16.30.02 BRA-TAC-Were I an enemy, you would be dead.

16.32.07           TEAL'C-My wife and son?

16.34.24           BRA-TAC-I am told they escaped the burning. (beat) I  
                  thought you might return in time for your boy's  
                  ceremony, Teal'c. Brave. But unwise...

16.45.16           TEAL'C-If you were awaiting my return, perhaps there are  
                  others.

16.48.22           BRA-TAC-Others don't know you as I do. But I expected  
                  you to come alone.

16.56.00           TEAL'C (OS)-They are friends.

16.58.25           TEAL'C (CONT)-Colonel O'Neill... Captain Carter...

17.03.23           TEAL'C (OS CONT)-Daniel Jackson...

17.05.04           TEAL'C (CONT)-Warriors of great skill and cunning.

17.07.05           CARTER-Ah, Teal'c, that's --

17.08.19           TEAL'C (OS)-My first teacher, Bra-tac... The greatest  
                  Jaffa master I have ever known.

17.13.18           O'NEILL-It's an honor to meet you, sir.

17.16.02           BRA-TAC (OS)-You...

- 17.17.14 BRA-TAC (CONT)-You were among the warriors who defeated the palace guard at Chulak? A human woman?
- 17.22.21 CARTER-Hey, I'll have you know I kicked my share of --
- 17.24.01 BRA-TAC (overlapping)-And you? A warrior of great skill and cunning? I could snap you like kindling!
- 17.31.01 BRA-TAC (OS CONT)-How could you bring these Hasshak with you?
- 17.34.14 O'NEILL-Hey, hey, hey...! Who you callin' a Hassick?  
(beat) What's a hassick?
- 17.44.23 BRA-TAC-You challenge me, Hasshak?
- 17.46.10 O'NEILL-Uh, no. I don't think we came to fight you.
- 17.49.08 BRA-TAC-A shame...
- 17.55.22 O'NEILL (OS)-We're here on a mission.
- 17.57.05 O'NEILL (CONT)-If you don't want to be part of it, just say so.
- 18.00.22 BRA-TAC-(laughs) You choose your friends well, Teal'c.  
(beat) Though were I a hundred years younger, it might not have been quite so easy.



18.16.05 O'NEILL-You're over a hundred years old? (beat) God,  
I'm sorry...

18.33.02 BRA-TAC-A hundred and thirty three.

18.35.01 O'NEILL-You must work out.

18.42.08 BRA-TAC-No one has ever defied the Goa'uld and lived to  
tell of it. There was much talk in Chulak of the  
warriors of earth.

18.50.04 O'NEILL-Really?

18.51.12 TEAL'C-Our time here is limited. (beat) Can you take us  
to find my wife and son?

19.04.04 BRA-TAC-Your family is Kresh'ta.

19.06.00 BRA-TAC (OS CONT)-Outcasts. The Kresh'ta live...

19.08.17 BRA-TAC (CONT)-in a handful of camps outside the city. I  
do not know which one your family belongs to.

19.15.00 TEAL'C-Then we should begin now.

19.17.03 O'NEILL-Teal'c...

19.21.17 TEAL'C-I would not leave Chulak without seeing my son.

- 19.29.20 O'NEILL-Captain... I want you and Daniel to go back to the Stargate. Take up positions where you can lay down cover fire. We might need it.
- 19.37.17 CARTER-Yes, sir.
- 19.38.16 DANIEL-Uh, a minute ago, we were warriors of great skill and cunning.
- 19.41.19 O'NEILL-Wait there for us for 24 hours. If we're not back by then, we probably won't be.
- 19.48.13 CARTER-Yes, sir, we'll be waiting. Good luck, sir.
- 19.59.25 TEAL'C-If we are discovered, you will be brought before Apophis along with us.

20.21.06 BRA-TAC-We go south. Those camps nearest the city.

20.25.18 BRA-TAC (OS CONT)-I believe your wife would go there.

20.27.11 TEAL'C-I agree.

20.32.10 O'NEILL-South is good...

20.49.09 O'NEILL (OS)-Hey, Teal'c! Maybe Bra-tac's feeling a  
little tired, might want to take a little rest here  
--

20.54.09 BRA-TAC (overlapping)-You will follow. Teal'c and I will  
lead.

20.57.07 O'NEILL-No, no, no, actually, you see... I'm in charge  
here --

21.00.13 BRA-TAC-The Stargate is well patrolled. Your deceptions  
will not work a second time. You'll need my help to  
stay alive, human.

21.07.25 O'NEILL-Yeah, alright, whatever... I'm easy...

21.10.01 BRA-TAC-Teal'c tells me your world is without gods.  
Difficult to imagine.

- 21.14.28 O'NEILL-Well, it's not without gods. A lot of people believe there is a God... Not everyone believes in the same God in the same way, but... Well, let's just say nobody believes in anyone with glowing eyes and a snake in his head.
- 21.29.22 BRA-TAC-Then you serve no one?
- 21.31.23 O'NEILL-I serve the S.G.C. under a General Hammond.
- 21.34.14 BRA-TAC-So, this Hammond is...?
- 21.37.00 O'NEILL-Just a man. A very good, very... bald man...
- 21.42.15 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-from Texas.
- 21.44.26 CARTER-Poor Teal'c. What he must've gone through, keeping quiet about his family...
- 22.04.12 DANIEL-Jaffa Priests. That's, that's Apophis' emblem.
- 22.07.23 CARTER-What are they carrying? (beat) What's that?
- 22.26.06 DANIEL-It's a bell.
- 22.28.18 CARTER-As in church bell?

22.31.06 DANIEL-Probably.

22.33.23 CARTER-I haven't been to church in a while.

22.53.00 MAN IN VILLAGE-Jaffa!

23.29.23 TEAL'C (OS)-Priest,...

23.31.11 TEAL'C (CONT)-Stand aside.

23.33.06 PRIEST-Teal'c? The traitor. (beat) You dare to show  
yourself, Shol'va?

23.40.01 TEAL'C-I have no wish to harm you, Priest. But I will  
not allow you to perform the Prim'ta on my son.

24.11.06 DREY-AUC-Teal'c.

24.19.10 O'NEILL-And this would be...?

24.21.17 TEAL'C-My wife. Drey-auc.

24.50.08 DREY-AUC (OS)-I had to beg the priests to perform the  
ceremony.

24.53.00 DREY-AUC (CONT)-They brought the tablet and the tent for  
the Prim'ta all the way to camp. Why have you  
returned?

- 24.57.24 TEAL'C-My son will not be a slave, Drey-auc. He will  
taste freedom, as I have.
- 25.10.15 DREY-AUC-Freedom, Teal'c? You have condemned your son to  
death.
- 25.25.24 DREY-AUC (OS)-Your heresy is an abomination, Teal'c.
- 25.28.20 DREY-AUC (CONT)-Even by the outcasts I am shunned.
- 25.31.13 TEAL'C-The abomination is my people enslaved by the  
Goa'uld.
- 25.34.21 DREY-AUC-How can you call the gods that you served for so  
long your enemy?
- 25.39.02 TEAL'C-Since the Earth people opened my eyes. The  
Prim'ta is slavery.
- 25.44.19 DREY-AUC-Did you see where I am raising your son? (beat)  
Is this better than the home Apophis granted you as  
First Prime?
- 25.53.01 TEAL'C-It is not.

- 25.56.11 DREY-AUC-You have abandoned and betrayed us. (beat) Do you know what I have endured to convince the priests that we are still loyal? (beat) They were about to lift the banishment so that we could return to the city!
- 26.11.26 TEAL'C-So you want this more for yourself than for our son...? I will speak to him.
- 26.20.08 DREY-AUC-No...! No...! He believes you are dead.
- 26.23.04 TEAL'C-Dead?
- 26.24.20 DREY-AUC-It is easier than the truth.
- 26.25.18 TEAL'C-What have you told him, woman?
- 26.28.28 DREY-AUC-What would you have me tell him? (beat) That a father left his son for people he does not know? Who are not his blood? You tell him that, husband. You witness the dishonor in his eyes.
- 26.47.16 TEAL'C-Drey-auc...
- 26.48.09 DREY-AUC-Come. Carry your son back to the hovel that has become his home.

28.03.17 CARTER-We have to get a closer look.

28.30.20 TEAL'C-Rya'c...? Rya'c...?

28.41.07 RYA'C-Father... (beat) I knew he was not dead.

28.57.01 TEAL'C-How long has the sickness been in him?

29.01.07 DREY-AUC-Since we were driven from our home. Do you understand now? (beat) Without the healing powers of the Goa'uld, he will die.

29.19.13 TEAL'C-What have I done?

29.25.07 O'NEILL-How's he doing, Teal'c?

29.27.03 TEAL'C-He is dying.

29.31.10 O'NEILL-I'm no doctor, but I know Scarlet Fever...

29.33.28 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-when I see it.

29.38.24 TEAL'C-Can it be treated by your earth medicines?

29.41.16 O'NEILL-Ah, there's some vaccines, anti-biotics... (beat)

30.10.00 TEAL'C-What of your earth doctors?

30.13.01 O'NEILL-If we can get him through the Stargate, maybe.

30.24.25 DANIEL-Bingo. Goa'uld larva.

30.29.13 CARTER-Out here in the open like this? No guards?

30.32.19 DANIEL-Well, who on Chulak needs to steal one?

30.36.12 CARTER-~~We~~ do.

30.39.11 DANIEL-Right.

30.52.02 CARTER-Okay. We can do this.

30.55.01 DANIEL-I'm ready.

30.56.11 CARTER-Okay. On three. One... two... three...

31.06.00 DANIEL-Okay... on four.

31.08.15           CARTER-Four. I really, really, really hate these things.

32.30.02           O'NEILL-Carter and Daniel should be here.

32.37.28           DREY-AUC-Oh... He no longer draws breath, Teal'c!

32.41.11           TEAL'C-Rya'c...

32.43.13           TEAL'C (OS CONT)-Rya'c...!

32.44.26           O'NEILL (OS)-Teal'c...

32.46.00           O'NEILL (CONT)-We should try to make it to the Stargate.

32.47.17           TEAL'C-By then it will be too late. (beat) There is  
                  another way.

32.54.00           DREY-AUC (OS)-No... no... no...

33.05.16           O'NEILL-Teal'c...

33.07.04           O'NEILL (OS CONT)-You wanna think about this.

33.09.09           O'NEILL (CONT)-You can't live for more than a couple of  
                  hours without that thing.

33.12.11           BRA-TAC-It is a father's right.

33.17.06           DREY-AUC-What of you, Teal'c?

33.38.20           TEAL'C-I am sorry, my son, that it is I who must do this  
                  to you. But I do it to save your life... (beat)  
                  forgive me, my son. Forgive me...

34.17.02           DANIEL-Do you think these things need to be fed?

34.24.16           CARTER-Go, go!

34.41.14           DANIEL-What the hell do we do now?

34.42.28           CARTER-Drop and cover your head. This is gonna be close.

35.03.14 DANIEL (OS)-Well, that was insane.

35.05.02 CARTER-Let's get back to the Stargate.

35.12.24 O'NEILL (INTO RADIO)-Keep coming, Captain. You're almost  
here.

35.16.00 BRA-TAC-The Goa'uld within him is strong. He is healing  
well.

35.19.05 O'NEILL-When will he be strong enough to travel.

35.22.26 TEAL'C-Soon. But by then, O'Neill... I will no longer
