04.24.16 O'NEILL-Relax, Teal'c. They're just trying to take your blood pressure.

04.27.11 DOCTOR FRASIER-It's all right. That can wait for now. Teal'c, you can go and change, if you want to.

04.40.00 DOCTOR FRASIER-Okay, Colonel... Any pain, headache...?

04.44.08 O'NEILL-No.

04.46.23 DOCTOR FRASIER-Can I get you to look straight ahead, please.

04.50.02 O'NEILL (OS)-What is that?

04.50.27 DOCTOR FRASIER-It's a penlight...

04.52.02 DOCTOR FRASIER (OS CONT)-I'm sorry. You must be  
photosensitive.

04.54.17 O'NEILL-You think?

04.57.18 DOCTOR FRASIER-It's all right, Colonel. We can do this  
after debriefing, or even tomorrow.

05.05.00 O'NEILL-Thank you. (beat) Thank you.

05.26.29 TEAL'C-We went through the Stargate at precisely 0700  
this morning. The world we found on the other side  
appeared to be uninhabited.

05.37.15 GENERAL HAMMOND-So there was no immediated sign of  
danger?

05.37.27 CARTER (OS)-There were these holes.

05.39.20 CARTER (CONT)-Volcanic gas. I took some soil samples to  
test for minerals. Daniel...

05.50.24 GENERAL HAMMOND-Take your time.

05.52.16 O'NEILL-He said... He said, "Colonel, help me." (beat)  
And then he was gone.

06.04.20 GENERAL HAMMOND-Gone?

06.06.07 O'NEILL-Engulfed... in fire, sir.

06.14.09 GENERAL HAMMOND-There was nothing you could have done,  
Colonel.

06.16.04 O'NEILL-I swear to God, sir, I tried to get to him. But  
the heat was...

06.20.10 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-It blasted...

06.23.27 O'NEILL (CONT)-toward us and...

06.26.00 GENERAL HAMMOND-And what did you do then?

06.27.15 O'NEILL-There was a body of water somewhere nearby. It  
was like a, a lake... or a-a sea, maybe, uh... We  
all submerged ourselves. That's what saved us.

06.42.10 GENERAL HAMMOND-And by then...?

06.43.08 O'NEILL-By then, Daniel was gone. There was nothing,  
nothing left, sir. I ordered the team to evacuate.

06.55.17 GENERAL HAMMOND-We'll send a team through to recover the  
body.

06.57.24 O'NEILL (overlapping)-No, sir! (beat) It's... too volatile, sir. The whole area was... (beat) ... very unstable.

07.16.29 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-I've gone through it myself.

07.19.06 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-If there's anything I --

07.20.06 O'NEILL (overlapping)-Yes, sir.

07.24.06 GENERAL HAMMOND-Dismissed.

07.41.02 DOCTOR FRASIER-General... I have a few more tests to run, but I've got the results back from my visual exams.

07.46.12 GENERAL HAMMOND-And...?

07.47.11 DOCTOR FRASIER-Well, except for some minor contusions, photosensitivity, which I can probably blame on exposure to volcanic gases in the atmosphere... they're fine. Frankly, General... I'm more worried about their post traumatic symptoms.



- 07.59.10 GENERAL HAMMOND-When your lives depend on each other, you form very deep bonds. Theirs is a very dangerous job.
- 08.03.28 DOCTOR FRASIER-Well, yes. Of course, sir. It's just, I, I can't help but be concerned. Call it intuition --

10.11.23 O'NEILL (CONT)-He was a good man. For those of us lucky  
enough to have known him, he was also a friend.

12.35.23 DANIEL-Jack...? Sam? Teal'c? Anyone...?

13.00.20 O'NEILL (OS)-So we're sitting...

13.01.01 O'NEILL (CONT)-around eating some kind of gourmet  
Avedonian cuisine. Daniel tells Sha're he's gonna  
show us this cartouche thing. But before we leave,  
she stands up, plants a kiss on him that makes his  
face disappear for a day...

13.31.11 CARTER-Yeah, well, a wake is like a big party. It's supposed to give the departed a jolly sendoff.

13.36.22 O'NEILL (OS)-Sam. Teal'c.

13.39.03 O'NEILL (CONT)-Glad you made it. Something to drink?

13.41.03 CARTER-Yeah, sure. Beer.

13.43.27 O'NEILL-Teal'c...?

13.45.01 TEAL'C-I must refrain.

13.46.22 O'NEILL-There's food upstairs.

13.56.21 DANIEL (VO DISTORTED)-Help! (unintelligible), help!  
Help!

14.32.09 DANIEL-Daniel... Daniel Jackson.

14.36.20 DANIEL (OS CONT)-You...?

14.41.10 DANIEL (CONT)-My friends... The, the others...

14.42.08 DANIEL (OS CONT)-who came here with me...

15.05.28 DANIEL-I-it's a very old earth writing. It's cuneiform.  
(beat) I-it's the first kind of writing we, we've ever found on my world. (beat) Okay...

15.19.21 DANIEL (OS CONT)-It's Akkadian, not Sumerian, so...

15.24.05 DANIEL (CONT)-It's a tough one... Let me think...  
(beat)... (reading) "Reveal... fate... Omorooca..."

15.36.23 DANIEL (OS CONT)-"Reveal fate Omorooca."

15.38.14 DANIEL (CONT)-Reveal fate Omorooca?

15.41.06 DANIEL (OS CONT)-Omorooca... What is that?

15.43.17 DANIEL (CONT)-That's you? (beat) No. Something else.

15.49.19 DANIEL (OS CONT)-"Reveal fate Omorooca..."

15.53.02 DANIEL (CONT)-I, I'm sorry. I-I-I don't know what you  
want me to do. (beat) I don't know what you want  
me to do! I don't understand!

16.23.06 O'NEILL-Can we get this damn...

16.24.11 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-car outta here?

16.33.09 GENERAL HAMMOND-What's on your mind, Colonel?

16.37.27 O'NEILL-Retirement, actually.

16.39.25 GENERAL HAMMOND-You don't mean that.

16.43.12 O'NEILL-I think I do.

16.46.14           GENERAL HAMMOND-Well, I can't let you do that at the moment. I've got an assignment for SG-1. Dr. Jackson's apartment needs to be closed by Stargate personnel. National security aside, you're probably the closest thing he had to a family. It's not an order. It's a request.

17.09.17           O'NEILL-Yes, sir.

17.12.24           GENERAL HAMMOND-Why don't you come join the others in back.

17.17.11           O'NEILL-Yes, sir.

17.20.25           GENERAL HAMMOND-You know that's my car, don't you?

17.23.24           O'NEILL-You should get that window fixed.

17.28.25           DANIEL (OS)-"If a free man..."

- 17.31.21            DANIEL (CONT)-"...accuses another of murder... and fails to prove -- the accuser shall be put to death."

- 18.16.03            NEM-What fate Omorooca?
- 18.19.12            DANIEL-I, I don't, I don't know... (beat) My friends and I, we came here in peace. We're, we're explorers. We'll share information if we have it.

18.29.00 NEM-What fate Omoroca?!

18.31.15 DANIEL-I, I, I don't, I don't know...

18.40.22 NEM (OS)-Nourishment.

18.46.26 NEM (CONT)-Sleep.

18.49.12 DANIEL (OS)-Look... (beat) I can't...

18.53.27 DANIEL (CONT)-I can't tell you what I don't know.

18.58.02 NEM-You will. Or you will die.

19.24.18 CARTER-Oh, wow. Look at these. Expedition journals.  
One for each planet we visited. One for Abydos...  
(reading) "Colonel O'Neill thinks I'm a geek. I  
have no idea how to get us back. I'll never get  
paid."

19.48.27 CARTER (OS CONT)-Oh, wow.

19.50.01 CARTER (CONT)-He must've written this right after we got  
back. (reading) "Sha're is gone. Jack says we'll  
find her. If anyone can, he can."

19.58.07 O'NEILL-Come on, that's his diary. I mean, what's he  
gonna think if...

20.08.22 CARTER-I wonder what they're gonna do with all this stuff?

20.13.00 O'NEILL-Maybe give it to a museum. Or start one.

20.24.28 TEAL'C-This is a game from ancient Egypt. It is called The Jackal and the Hound.

20.31.08 TEAL'C (OS CONT)-It belonged to a Pharoah's daughter. Daniel Jackson and I once played. He said it made him feel as though he were touching history.

20.44.00 DANIEL (VO DISTORTED)-Help! Help!

20.47.28 O'NEILL-What? What is it? You all right?

20.49.15 CARTER-Uh, I-I-I just had this image in my mind. It's the second time.

20.53.08 O'NEILL-What was it?

20.54.25 CARTER-Water. Under --

20.55.24 O'NEILL (overlapping)-Bubbles rising?

20.57.11 TEAL'C (OS)-That is correct.

20.58.22 TEAL'C (CONT)-I have experienced it, as well.



21.01.10 O'NEILL-I'm telling you, something is wrong.

21.08.03 O'NEILL-Then why don't I believe it? I mean, I keep  
expecting him to walk through the door. I-I keep  
getting these... Screw this packing.

21.21.08 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-Let's get back to the base.

21.35.08 DANIEL-Where are my friends? Are they alive? Are they  
here somewhere? I demand that I be allowed to speak  
with them!

21.41.09 NEM-They are... gone.

21.43.17 DANIEL-No. They would not leave without me.

21.46.04 NEM-You are... no more.

21.49.06 DANIEL-They think that I'm --

21.50.05 NEM (OS) (overlapping)-This memory...

21.51.14 NEM (CONT)-I gave them. So that they would not return.

21.56.21 DANIEL-Why? (beat) Why are you doing this?

22.01.00 NEM-You are oldest...

22.03.25 NEM (OS CONT)-You know of...

22.05.04 NEM (CONT)-Babylon. (beat) What fate... Omorooca?

22.11.12 DANIEL-Okay. Okay. If my life is on the line here, I  
need to know more. What is Omorooca? Who is  
Omorooca?

22.22.00 NEM-My... mate.

22.26.23 DANIEL-What? On earth? In, in Babylon?

22.29.10 NEM-Yes.

22.31.08 DANIEL-And you don't know what's happened to her? (beat)  
That was four thousand years ago.

22.37.27 NEM-Knowledge. You have... knowledge.

22.41.09 DANIEL-Of Babylon, yes. But only a, a small amount of  
knowledge has survived all that time.

22.46.07 NEM-Knowledge is there.

22.48.05 NEM (OS CONT)-In your...

22.49.05 NEM (CONT)-mind.

22.50.00 DANIEL (OS)-And you are...

22.50.04 DANIEL (CONT)-asking me to remember something that  
happened thousands and thousands of years before I  
was born. T-to tell you something that I, I  
couldn't possibly know.

23.00.00 NEM-You deceive...

23.02.10 DANIEL-Why? God, why, why, why, would I do that?!

23.05.25 NEM-You serve the Goa'uld.

23.08.02 DANIEL-No! No! (beat) No, I lost my wife... my, my  
mate because of the Goa'uld. They took her from me,  
and I despise them for that!

23.16.24 NEM-Then tell me... what fate --

23.20.26 DANIEL (overlapping)-I don't know!! I don't know!!

- 23.26.20 DOCTOR FRASIER-Well, your brain chemistry's been seriously compromised. All of you have abnormally low levels of serotonin.
- 23.31.28 O'NEILL-Which means...?
- 23.32.23 DOCTOR FRASIER-Uh, it's a neurotransmitter that affects moods. Now, low levels would account for depression, but not these other affects. Come here. I want you to take a look at this. This dark...
- 23.43.07 DOCTOR FRASIER (OS CONT)-spot here appears on all of your scans. Now, it's almost...
- 23.45.26 DOCTOR FRASIER (CONT)-too small an anomaly to worry about, but for the fact that it's in virtually the same part of the cortex --
- 23.51.03 SPEAKER VOICE (VO FILTERED)-Offworld activation!

- 23.54.08 DOCTOR FRASIER (overlapping)-Colonel? Wait!
- 24.06.25 DOCTOR FRASIER (OS CONT)-Colonel...?
- 24.12.19 TECHNICIAN (VO FILTERED)-Welcome home, SG-6. Report for debriefing as 1600 hours.
- 24.18.18 DOCTOR FRASIER-Wh-what are you looking for?

24.22.05 O'NEILL-I just... I thought...

24.25.05 TEAL'C-Daniel Jackson was returning.

24.27.02 CARTER-Oh my God. I thought the same thing.

24.28.23 CARTER (OS CONT)-Why?

24.55.17 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-I know he's gone.

25.00.06 O'NEILL (CONT)-But I know he's still alive. (beat)  
Sir... We've got to go ba --

25.11.13 GENERAL HAMMOND-You're not going anywhere but the  
infirmary. (beat) I want to know what's going on,  
Doctor. One of our people could still be out there.

25.23.05 DOCTOR FRASIER-Yes, sir.

25.54.05 NEM-You cannot... leave... this place.

26.00.00 NEM (OS CONT)-You will tell me...

26.01.15 NEM (CONT)-all you know of... Babylon.

26.12.13 DANIEL (OS)-Do you know how much has been lost?

26.16.23 DANIEL (CONT)-Great libraries burned to the ground,  
cities destroyed by wars... Most of our history...

26.23.20 DANIEL (OS CONT)-is buried in time.

26.25.25 NEM-You are afraid.

26.29.03 DANIEL-Yes. I'm afraid. I'm afraid that you're asking  
the impossible of me, and you will not allow me to  
return home.

26.38.09 NEM-Omoroca... was... afraid.

26.42.10 DANIEL-On earth?

26.43.10 NEM-Yes.

26.44.10 DANIEL-Of what? Of who? I mean, give me something to  
work with here. A-a-a time frame...

26.49.28 NEM-Babylon.

26.55.10 DANIEL-A-a name... A name of someone she spoke of.

27.00.06 NEM-Belus.

27.02.12 DANIEL-Belus. Belus... Belus... something... Yes. Yes.  
Um... Belus something. Yes. In the writings of  
Berossus, a, a contemporary of Alexander the Great.  
He, he studied some very old ancient Babylonian  
texts. Pre-flood. Ugh. Tell me more.

27.29.14 NEM-Omoroca... feared Belus.

27.31.28 DANIEL-Yes. Yes. He was a, a conqueror. Tell me more.  
I need...

27.34.25 DANIEL (OS CONT)-more. Come on...

27.38.21 DANIEL (CONT)-Come on! You cannot expect me to remember every book, every text that I studied ten or twelve years ago. (beat) Look... Come back to earth with me. My, my books, my, my library -- they're all there.

27.48.09 NEM-You serve the Goa'uld.

27.50.14 DANIEL-NO!!

27.51.19 DANIEL (OS CONT)-God, no!!

27.53.09 DANIEL (CONT)-How many times do I have to tell you, no!

27.55.09 NEM-It is the fate... of humans. That Omoroca could not... prevent.

28.06.22 DANIEL-Omoroca came to earth to fight the Goa'uld? That is why she came to earth?

28.12.01 NEM-Yes.

28.15.12 DANIEL-Then my people owe her a great debt.

28.17.09 NEM-She failed.



- 28.19.02 DANIEL-No. No. There was an, an uprising, a rebellion in ancient Egypt. I mean, maybe she helped plant the seed.
- 28.25.18 NEM-The Goa'uld are among you. Within you.
- 28.29.17 DANIEL-Teal'c.
- 28.30.27 DANIEL (OS CONT)-You think because Teal'c carries around a larval Goa'uld...
- 28.34.20 DANIEL (CONT)-No, see, he joined us in the fight against the Goa'uld.
- 28.38.26 DANIEL (OS CONT)-You see, in the years --
- 28.39.24 DANIEL (CONT)-in the thousands of years since Omoroca was there, we have become a civilization that rivals that of the Goa'uld. That's how far we have come. We are free. (beat) I-if you'll just come back with me, I can show you.
- 29.00.07 NEM-Knowledge... is... here.
- 29.13.01 O'NEILL-Catchy tune. Want to explain to me what this "mood music" is all about?
- 29.19.14 GENERAL HAMMOND-Doctor MacKenzie said it might help you remember more specifically what happened. If you listen.

29.26.10 MackENZIE-We're simply using these sounds as a tool to increase your levels of concentration, Colonel.

29.33.02 O'NEILL-Well, it's very distracting. Look, we're trying to play... Teal'c...?

29.55.00 DANIEL (VO DISTORTED)-Help!

29.56.17 TEAL'C- (unintelligible)

29.58.15 O'NEILL-Teal'c... Snap out of it.

30.04.04 TEAL'C-I saw the death of Daniel Jackson.

30.09.26 O'NEILL-It's all right. The same thing keeps happening to me.

30.14.16 MackENZIE (OS)-All three of you...

30.15.19 MackENZIE (CONT)-have conflicting feelings about Daniel.

30.18.14 CARTER-I know he's dead. I know he's alive.

30.21.08 MackENZIE (OS)-Both realities...

30.22.13 MackENZIE (CONT)-can't be true. Yet both seem to be.

- 30.25.01 GENERAL HAMMOND-It's a conflict that will have to be resolved before I'll authorize your return to active duty, Colonel.
- 30.41.08 DANIEL-My friends... The others who came here with me... You made them think that I was...
- 30.45.03 NEM-Lost to them.
- 30.46.24 DANIEL-Dead?
- 30.47.20 NEM-Yes.
- 30.48.05 DANIEL (OS)-How?
- 30.51.12 NEM-I gave them... the memory... of your death.
- 30.56.19 DANIEL-If you can influence memory like that, why don't you search my mind. I mean, you say the memory is in there. That I must have come across it years ago, and I, I just don't remember.

31.28.28 NEM-I am not.

31.37.00 DANIEL-Look... I don't have four thousand years. Maybe
