- 10.16.12 SAMANTHA-How's the, the splint feel?
- 10.17.17 O'NEILL-Captain. You have to believe me.
- 10.25.14 SAMANTHA-I want to, sir. I just don't see how.
- 10.30.11 O'NEILL-Then we better start lookin' for a way.
- 10.33.16 O'NEILL (OS CONT) Because...
- 10.34.21 O'NEILL (CONT)-I'll be damned if I'm gonna die on some godforsaken block of ice a million light years from home.
