07.49.22 SAMUELS (OS)-The...

SAMUELS (CONT)-current thinking at the Pentagon is to do nothing to
alert the Goa'uld we know they're there.

07.54.06 GENERAL HAMMOND-Let me guess who's bright idea *that* was.

07.57.15 SAMUELS-General Hammond, may I speak freely?

SAMUELS (OS CONT)-I know I seem to have lost your respect,...

SAMUELS (CONT)-for whatever reason...but we wouldn't be in this situation — that is, at the brink of war with the Goa'uld — if you had heeded my advice and buried the Stargate in the first place.

 warrior. (BEAT) But you should not have come.

12.56.23 TEAL'C-I stand by my friends.

TEAL'C (OS CONT)-I believe this world may be our only hope in...

TEAL'C (CONT)-one day overcoming the false gods.

13.03.00 BRA'TAC (OS)-Yes.

BRA'TAC (CONT)-As pathetic as that may seem at the moment...
 ...I agree.

13.12.16 DANIEL-You do?

13.13.16 BRA'TAC-I may even have been able to save this world had you not interfered.

13.17.08 O'NEILL (OS)-Hey!

O'NEILL (CONT)-What do you think we've been trying to do? It is *our* world you're talking about here —

13.25.05 BRA'TAC-Enough, human! This is not the place to talk of these things.

BRA'TAC (OS CONT)-I have been ordered by...

BRA'TAC (CONT)-Apophis himself to execute you. (BEAT) An order I intend to disregard. Come!

13.59.10 GENERAL HAMMOND-They still haven't moved from this position?

14.01.21 TECHNICIAN (OS)-No, sir. Not for the last eighteen hours.

14.04.04 GENERAL HAMMOND-What in God's name are they waiting for?

14.06.25 SAMUELS-My mission analysis team at the Pentagon believes they're waiting to see what moves we make.

SAMUELS (OS CONT)-Amazingly, neither the Russians nor the...

SAMUELS (CONT)-Chinese have detected the Goa'uld presence, yet.

Of course, they're not looking. So, from space, we should *appear* to be a vulnerable and...

SAMUELS (OS CONT)-unsuspecting world.

14.22.21 GENERAL HAMMOND-Got 'em just where you want 'em, do you, Samuels?

14.26.10 TECHNICIAN (OS)-Sir,...

TECHNICIAN (CONT)-there may be another reason why they haven't
attacked.

TECHNICIAN (OS CONT)-We just completed the computer enhancement:

There was an energy burst, coming from what...

TECHNICIAN (CONT)-we think may be the "bridge" of one of the ships,
recorded at seventeen fifty hours. Just before they stopped.

14.46.10 SAMUELS-That's it?

14.47.07 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-For all we know, that flash —...

GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-whatever it was — could be part of their
ship's...

GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-normal function.

14.52.27 TECHNICIAN-Except that the burst came from *within* the ship itself, sir,
and it was fairly...

TECHNICIAN (OS CONT)-powerful.

14.57.26 SAMUELS-Maybe an explosion... An accident?

15.00.17 GENERAL HAMMOND-Or sabotage.

15.02.10 TECHNICIAN-SG-1?

15.05.07 SAMUELS-I hardly think so.

SAMUELS (OS CONT)-For one thing, it's impossible to gate...

SAMUELS (CONT)-to a ship. (BEAT) Forgive me, Sir, I know how
important SG-1 is to you, but this is wishful thinking.

15.16.22 GENERAL HAMMOND-So is your plan, Colonel. That hasn't stopped us from
going ahead with it.

15.23.01 TECHNICIAN 2 (OS)-General Hammond,...

TECHNICIAN 2 (CONT)-sir, the first group on the Alpha list has just arrived.

15.27.05 GENERAL HAMMOND-Thank you.

15.31.29 BRA'TAC-Here are your weapons. You will need them.

15.38.09 O'NEILL-Um, Bra'tac, you mentioned something about saving the world?
Care to elaborate on that?

15.45.13 BRA'TAC-By assaulting Klorrel, you have made that...

BRA'TAC (OS CONT)-impossible.

15.47.22 DANIEL (OVERLAPPING)-Why?

15.48.24 BRA'TAC (OS)-Among the Goa'uld,...

BRA'TAC (CONT)-a pharaoh's power is more often challenged by their sons
than by...

BRA'TAC (OS CONT)-their enemies. Once...

BRA'TAC (CONT)-we had joined battle with your world, I was prepared to
lead my wing against Apophis -- in Klore's name.

16.02.24 TEAL'C-Apophis would assume your attack was ordered by Klore, and
reciprocate. A daring plan.

16.09.02 BRA'TAC (OS)-I had hoped to drive a stake of mistrust between them.

BRA'TAC (CONT)-Now I fear they will bond against their common enemy.

16.15.16 O'NEILL (OS)-What *bond*?

O'NEILL (CONT)-Klore's dead.

16.18.15 BRA'TAC (OS)-He will rise again.

16.24.03 DANIEL-The sarcophagus...

16.26.23 O'NEILL-Wait a minute. You put him in that thing to bring him back?

16.31.09 BRA'TAC-I knew it would delay their attack until he arose. Perhaps when
 the warships of your world attack,...

 BRA'TAC (OS CONT)-we'll be able to –

16.36.15 CARTER (OVERLAPPING)-Uh... Excuse me...did you say the ships of *our*
 world?

16.40.06 BRA'TAC-Surely you *have* such vessels.

16.42.22 DANIEL-Well, we have a number of...shuttles.

16.46.03 O'NEILL (OVERLAPPING IN UNISON)-Shuttles...

16.49.10 BRA'TAC-These *shuttles*...they are a formidable craft?

16.55.23 O'NEILL-Oh, yeah. Yeah. (TO DANIEL, UNDER BREATH)-Bad day.

17.07.16 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS FILTERED)-Ladies and gentlemen, as you have
 all been made aware,...

17.10.16 TECHNICIAN (OS OVERLAPPING)-Chevron four encoded...

17.12.04 GENERAL HAMMOND-...this nation – the entire world – faces a deadly
 threat.

17.18.23 TECHNICIAN (FILTERED)-Chevron five encoded...

17.20.23 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-With this knowledge, you have all volunteered
 for a mission...

 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-intended to preserve humankind. You've
 been chosen because you represent the best we have...

 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-in all fields of expertise.

17.35.18 TECHNICIAN (OS)-Chevron six encoded...

17.37.04 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-Now, what you have not yet been told – for
 reasons...

 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-of security – is where you're going...

 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-or how you're going to get there.

17.46.16 TECHNICIAN (OS)-Chevron seven, locked!

17.51.26 GENERAL HAMMOND-You're going to step through *that*.

 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-Once through the Stargate,...

 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-you will find yourself on the opposite side
 of this galaxy...a place we call Alpha site. If we do not prevail, you,
 and those that follow, will call it *home*. A new colony. Godspeed.

18.33.20 KLOREL (MECHANICALLY DISTORTED, FILTERED)-*Kel mal tak, Tauri!*
Let us burn their world to ashes!

18.46.16 TECHNICIAN (OS)-They're moving!

18.49.04 SAMUELS (INTO PHONE)-Restart the countdown. Hold at t-minus
twenty seconds. We'll launch the weapons the moment they settle
into orbit.

19.03.15 TEAL'C-We accelerate. Klorei has risen.

19.06.07 BRA'TAC-Then the campaign has begun. Once we launch, we will do what
damage we can.

19.13.03 O'NEILL-How many in your wing?

19.16.04 BRA'TAC-Three.

19.20.09 O'NEILL-*Three?*

19.22.02 BRA'TAC-Teal'c makes four.

19.23.10 O'NEILL-Oh, well...*four.*

19.25.15 BRA'TAC (OS)-I have trained these warriors since they were *Chal'tii*.
BRA'TAC (CONT)-They have sworn their lives to me. It is no simple thing
to ask.

19.33.18 O'NEILL-And we appreciate it, believe me, but what are the odds of taking
out a ship like this with four gliders and, maybe, a shuttle?

19.42.04 TEAL'C (OS)-A Goa'uld attack vessel is heavily armed,...
TEAL'C (CONT)-shielded and capable of launching a legion of gliders
against us. I would say...slim.

19.49.16 O'NEILL (OS)-Okay,...
O'NEILL (CONT)-call me a pessimist, but I think it's time for a new plan.

19.53.11 BRA'TAC-We offer to lay down our lives...
BRA'TAC (OS CONT)-for your world, human.
BRA'TAC (CONT)-You cannot ask more.

19.58.12 O'NEILL (OS)-No,...
O'NEILL (CONT)-I can't. But I think a better idea is to get the other guys to
lay down *their* lives for *their* world first. (BEAT, TO CARTER)-How long
before the C-4 goes?

20.09.22 CARTER-Forty-one minutes, sir.

20.11.14 O'NEILL-With any luck at all, this ship is gonna blow within the hour.
It might be a good idea for us to get to the other one.
O'NEILL (OS CONT)-Can you do that?

20.42.12 SAMUELS (INTO PHONE)-That's it! They're in a geosynchronous orbit over
the United States. Lock in that attack profile, and advise the President
we are go for launch!

21.18.05 TECHNICIAN-Vandenberg reports a good launch.

21.20.00 SAMUELS-Yes! I'm sorry, sir. For what it's worth, I seriously doubt SG-1 is
aboard the alien ships.

21.30.11 TECHNICIAN (OS)-The weapons should reach their targets...
TECHNICIAN (CONT)-in...four minutes.

21.36.23 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-In the meantime, let's keep moving...
GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-these people through to the Alpha...
GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-site.

21.41.28 TECHNICIAN (INTO MICROPHONE)-Group nine, prepare to disembark.

21.43.27 SAMUELS-Sir, we might as well wait and see the result of our strike before
moving more people through.

21.49.11 GENERAL HAMMOND-I don't think so.

21.50.13 SAMUELS-Evacuation may be unnecessary.

21.52.08 GENERAL HAMMOND-From your mouth to God's ears, Colonel.

22.01.04 BRA'TAC-Have you more of this "4-C"?

22.04.10 O'NEILL-It's called C-4.

22.06.11 CARTER-And the answer is no. We used it all to take out this ship.

22.09.18 DANIEL-Well, you guys must have something left.

22.13.06 BRA'TAC-We shall have to cross that bridge when we come to it.

22.16.23 O'NEILL-You know, that particular cliché doesn't *always* work.

22.25.02 TECHNICIAN (OS)-The warheads have separated.
TECHNICIAN (CONT)-One minute to go.

22.28.03 GENERAL HAMMOND-Any indication of countermeasures?

22.29.23 SAMUELS-I don't think they're going to know what hit them.

22.35.13 KAH'L-My Lord, they launch weapons against us.
