 Alright, fine, just relax...

01.33.01 DANIEL - It's alright.

01.35.27 O'NEILL (OS) - Keep an eye out for Taldors I guess.

02.36.18 O'NEILL - What, who, this guy? Yeah.

02.40.15 MALE VOICE (OS) - Then you share his crime.

02.42.15 O'NEILL - What crime?

02.44.21 FEMALE VOICE (OS) - Murder.

02.47.17 O'NEILL - Alright, look, we don't know anything about a murder. He was running from something, he stopped for help. We helped.

02.56.01 MALE VOICE (OS) - For the crimes of trespassing on the ancient grounds...

02.59.18 O'NEILL - Anybody wanna jump in here?

03.01.05 FEMALE VOICE (OS) - Of aiding in a murder...

03.03.13 DANIEL - We had no intention of interfering with your justice system.

03.06.11 MALE VOICE (OS) - Of carrying weapons on ancient grounds...

03.09.17 CARTER - We're trained to defend ourselves.

03.12.03 FEMALE VOICE (OS) - You will be sent through the
stargate...

03.17.03 DANIEL - Thank you.

03.18.25 MALE VOICE (OS) - To the prison Hadante...

03.20.22 O'NEILL - Oh no no no no no no no no, this is just a
misunderstanding.

03.25.24 FEMALE VOICE (OS) - For the remainder of your lives.

04.49.01 O'NEILL (OS) - Hey!

04.58.23 O'NEILL - Well, this sucks.

05.02.01 PRISONERS (OS & ON) - (whistles, murmurs, grumbles)

05.21.17 DANIEL - Why are they whistling?

05.23.10 TEAL'C - O'Neill.

05.28.05 CARTER - Oh my God.

05.29.12 O'NEILL - What?

05.33.28 TEAL'C - The wounds are cauterized.

05.35.21 O'NEILL - Yeah? So?

05.37.00 CARTER - So whoever it was must've been standing in front
 of the gate when it opened...

05.40.25 CARTER (OS CONT) - Disintegrated by the vortex.

05.43.03 DANIEL - Why would anyone do that?

05.51.17 CARTER - It's okay...

05.53.23 CARTER (OS CONT) - We're not gonna hurt you. Please. We
 just wanna talk to you. Hey, it's alright, we just
 wanna talk to you.

05.59.27 TEAL'C - Captain Carter.

06.04.18 LINEA (OS) - Vishnoor!

06.24.14 LINEA - You have been sent through the great circle.

06.26.17 DANIEL - Well yes but that was--

06.27.10 LINEA (OS) - You have been...

06.27.24 LINEA (CONT) - sentenced to...

06.28.22 LINEA (OS CONT) - life imprisonment for your crimes or
 you would not be here...

07.40.13 CARTER - Yes sir.

07.42.29 O'NEILL - Okay, kids, this is our situation. What do we
need?

07.47.12 DANIEL (OS) - Well...

07.48.10 DANIEL (CONT) - a dial home device would be nice.

07.50.16 O'NEILL - Okay, let's assume we don't find one of those.
What else?

07.54.03 CARTER - Power to free up the superconductor, bring on
the stargate.

07.56.29 TEAL'C - So that we can dial the gate manually.

07.59.11 CARTER - It's worked before.

08.00.24 O'NEILL - Right. So we're lookin' for a power source.
Teal'c, look scary and take point.

08.11.03 PRISONERS (OS) - (murmurs and grumbles)

08.23.05 O'NEILL - We're with him.

08.33.27 DANIEL (OS) - It's like we're in Botany Bay.

08.36.21 O'NEILL - What?

08.38.27 DANIEL - Oh, uh, the original name for Sydney Harbor.
When the British first colonized Australia they
turned it into a continental prison. It was half a
world away. Course this is probably more than that.

08.51.19 O'NEILL - It's okay, Daniel. It's okay.

08..58.03 TEAL'C (OS) - Perhaps the Taldor believe the stargate
only goes here.

09.02.02 CARTER (OS) - Wherever...

09.03.02 CARTER (CONT) - here is.

09.06.08 PRISONERS (OS) - (shouts)

09.21.01 SCAVENGER (OS) - Here...

09.21.27 SCAVENGER (CONT) - I give.

09.22.24 DANIEL - You killed him?

09.23.27 SCAVENGER - No no no, not me. Killed himself. Not me.

09.28.25 O'NEILL - You're right.

09.34.27 SCAVENGER - Here...

09.36.08 SCAVENGER (OS CONT) - for you.

09.37.27 CARTER - In exchange for...?

09.39.15 SCAVENGER - Like Linea. A gift...

09.41.17 SCAVENGER (OS CONT) - for the protected one...

09.47.20 SCAVENGER (CONT) - You are very...

09.48.11 SCAVENGER (OS CONT) - strong, yes?

09.49.25 TEAL'C - I am.

09.51.06 SCAVENGER (OS) - Maybe you challenge...

09.51.28 SCAVENGER (CONT) - Vishnoor. Maybe you win. Maybe I be
 your friend.

10.00.12 TEAL'C - Maybe not.

10.10.02 O'NEILL - Okay. Uh, Daniel, you and Teal'c keep lookin'
 around Botany Bay here. Carter and I are gonna have
 a little chat with...

10.19.29 CARTER - Linea.

10.21.28 O'NEILL - Right. Something's generating the power around here, and she seems to be in charge. Oh, Daniel, you gotta trust me on this. Signs of weakness are not a good thing in prison.

10.47.15 CARTER - You know, sir, without our remote transmitters--

10.49.04 O'NEILL - Captain...

10.50.00 O'NEILL (OS CONT) - General Hammond will send a rescue team as soon as we're overdue.

10.54.19 ROSHURE (OS) - Please! They're after me, please!

10.56.25 O'NEILL - Get out!

11.05.25 CARTER - What do you think they're going to do to him?

11.07.15 O'NEILL - Not our...

11.07.27 O'NEILL (OS CONT) - problem, Captain.

11.21.29 TECH - We're getting SG-3's remote transmitter signal sir.

11.24.27 HAMMOND - Let's hope they found SG-1. Open the iris.

11.42.05 HAMMOND - Have them report directly to the briefing room.

11.56.22 LINEA - Sooner or later all new arrivals...

11.58.27 LINEA (OS CONT) - come here...

12.02.11 LINEA (CONT) - You are not from any of the island states
under the Taldor.

12.05.23 O'NEILL - Uh, no, we're from earth. Earth is-- well,
it's way out there.

12.16.04 LINEA - Then you're from a place of which I have no
knowledge... Do you intend to challenge me?

12.23.09 O'NEILL - All we really wanna do right now is get out of
here.

12.26.06 LINEA - Ahh...

12.30.00 LINEA (OS CONT) - We are deep underground. It is...

12.32.29 LINEA (CONT) - my understanding that the great circle
transported us to an entirely different world. One
that once teamed with life, but no more. This
place, thousands of years old, is all that remains.
That's why the Taldor turned it into a prison...

12.51.21 LINEA (OS CONT) - They could see no other use.

12.53.05 CARTER - So, bottom line, the stargate is the only way in
or out.

12.57.12 LINEA - Many here believe that when a prisoner comes through the stargate...

13.02.11 LINEA (OS CONT) - they can be caught in the circle's great wave and returned to the other side.

13.09.16 O'NEILL - Actually, they die.

13.16.02 CARTER - You see, what you just referred to as the great wave is actually an unstable vortex generated when the gate...

13.22.05 CARTER (OS CONT) - first opens...

13.23.25 CARTER (CONT) - Anything inside it's radius is completely disintegrated.

13.26.27 O'NEILL - There was a pair of smoking feet standing in place when we got here.

13.30.02 LINEA (OS) - There are...

13.30.14 LINEA (CONT) - two ways, and two ways only, to control a society. Through fear or through hope...

13.37.23 LINEA (OS CONT) - In this world, fear is a constant...

13.40.16 LINEA (CONT) - The belief in escape, whether founded or not al--

13.43.00 LINEA (OS CONT) --lows hope.

13.44.25 O'NEILL - So, out of hope, these people are killing themselves.

13.51.02 LINEA - If they believe it is escape...

13.53.15 LINEA (OS CONT) - who am I to say it is not?

13.56.13 O'NEILL - Well we have a better way.

13.58.18 LINEA - What would you ask of me?

14.02.13 CARTER - We need power.

14.04.18 LINEA - There are many forms of power, my dear. Some more subtle than others.

14.08.13 O'NEILL - Well for the moment, we just need the electrical kind.

14.12.28 LINEA - Then we both have something the other wants.

14.22.22 HAMMOND (OS) - They just handed you SG-1's....

14.24.04 HAMMOND (CONT) - weapons and remote transmitters and offered no further explanation?

14.27.08 WARREN - Only that they'd been accused of a crime and sent through the stargate to some sort of prison.

14.21.07 HAMMOND - What crime?

14.32.05 WARREN - They said it wasn't my concern and sent me
 straight to the stargate. I was going to take my
 men back--

14.36.15 HAMMOND (OS) - No, you did the...

14.37.05 HAMMOND (CONT) - right thing returning to base. From
 what you're tellin' me this has become a diplomatic
 problem. Lemme get SG in on it.

14.55.07 LINEA (OS) - I've long believed that the best way to get
 knowledge is to give it...

14.51.04 LINEA (CONT) - These are my activators.

15.06.21 CARTER - Is this a, a chemical reaction?

15.09.10 LINEA - Much more... The liquid permeates the hard core
 of the tear root and allows...

15.18.14 LINEA (OS CONT) - for the organic material within...

15.20.04 LINEA (CONT) - to interact on a basic level.

15.22.13 O'NEILL - Basic, meaning--

15.23.27 LINEA - That which we cannot see but of which all is
 made.

- 15.28.01 CARTER - Subatomic.
- 15.29.01 O'NEILL - Ah.
- 15.32.09 CARTER - Are we talking about organically-based cold fusion?
- 15.36.11 LINEA - I do not know your terminology.
- 15.38.21 CARTER - Uh, what you call basics, we call atoms...
- 15.42.23 CARTER (OS CONT) - Groups of protons, neutrons and electrons...
- 15.44.29 CARTER (CONT) - These are the basic building blocks...
- 15.46.21 CARTER (OS CONT) - of all matter.
- 15.48.14 LINEA - My activator spirit these materials...
- 15.51.08 LINEA (OS CONT) - to combine within the cells of the tear root...
- 15.54.17 LINEA (CONT) - When new material is made, new energy is released...
- 15.57.16 LINEA (OS CONT) - flowing through the...
- 15.58.19 LINEA (CONT) - tendrils of the plant.
- 16.01.02 CARTER - Colonel, that's cold fusion. Whatever organic mineral the roots are made of serves as a catalyst causing the atoms of her chemicals...
- 16.08.20 CARTER (OS CONT) - to fuse together. If we had...

- 16.11.01 CARTER (CONT) - this on earth we'd practically eliminate pollution--
- 16.13.17 O'NEILL - Captain. Back to basics. Will it power the stargate?
- 16.22.16 CARTER - It might.
- 16.25.27 LINEA (OS) - Activate the great circle from this side?...
- 16.28.06 LINEA (CONT) - The permutations number in the billions.
It's incalculable.
- 16.34.18 O'NEILL - Well actually she figured it out.
- 16.37.27 LINEA - You?
- 16.39.01 CARTER - Oh, it was a team effort, really.
- 16.40.25 LINEA - How?
- 16.42.02 CARTER - Uh, well--
- 16.43.14 O'NEILL - Tell you what. Provide the power we need, and we'll take you with us.
- 16.51.12 LINEA - Only then will you share the knowledge?

16.54.10 O'NEILL - That's the deal.

16.58.27 DANIEL - Teal'c, I think he's had enough.

17.02.12 TEAL'C - If you once again try to physically harm myself
or any of my companions, my patience with you will
expire.

17.12.22 O'NEILL (OS) - Well Teal'c...

17.14.22 O'NEILL (CONT) - makin' friends, are you?

17.17.09 TEAL'C - We found nothing of use.

17.18.25 DANIEL (OS) - Although I'm fairly sure this...

17.20.28 DANIEL (CONT) - this structure is the ruins of some sort
of alien gate terminal. Probably over fifteen
thousand years old. And that almost certainly pre-
dates...

17.26.13 DANIEL (OS CONT) - human civilization...

17.29.08 DANIEL (CONT) - which is not of any use, per se.

17.33.11 O'NEILL - We may have found what we need.

17.35.11 CARTER - Linea has a power source. Not just any power
source, either. This is incredible.

17.39.27 DANIEL - And she's just gonna hand it over?

17.45.06 O'NEILL - If we take her back with us.

17.47.27 DANIEL - Well can we just do that? I mean, we don't even know what she's in here for.

17.51.18 CARTER - What are we in here for?

17.53.04 O'NEILL - Jaywalking, I think.

17.55.09 TEAL'C - Clearly Linea has done something to earn the respect of these prisoners.

18.00.06 DANIEL - Well when she warned that man to stay away from Sam I saw fear in his eyes... not respect.

18.07.09 O'NEILL - I'm just going to assume you've never been in prison before.

18.11.17 DANIEL - Oh right, and you have.

18.17.00 O'NEILL - Oh yeah. Any place like this has its own set of rules. They don't have to make sense. Linea's obviously done whatever she's needed to do to survive. Just like we are. Speaking of which...

18.31.23 CARTER - Well, Colonel we're talking about powering one completely alien device with another. I mean it's not like splicing together a few wires.

18.39.27 O'NEILL - I'll take that as a maybe.

18.42.16 TEAL'C (OS) - Without remote transmitters, we still have no...

18.44.05 TEAL'C (CONT) - access to earth. The iris will be closed.

18.49.09 O'NEILL - Okay, Daniel, you know more addresses than any of us. Start putting alternatives together.

18.56.16 CARTER - Incoming.

19.09.15 VISHNOOR - You eat last.

20.05.08 LINEA - Thank you, Vishnoor.

20.15.20 PRISONERS (ON & OS) - (grabbing food walla)

21.14.01 KOVACEK (OS) - Sir, SG-1 broke the law on P3X 775...

21.19.08 KOVACEK (CONT) - We don't have to agree with their law, but we may have to respect it.

- 21.22.18 HAMMOND - It sounds to me like they just made an honest mistake.
- 21.25.10 KOVACEK - We tried to explain that, sir. On our world, unknowingly abetting a criminal doesn't merit this kind of punishment, however the Taldor, they're the judicial body, they believe...
- 21.35.15 KOVACEK (OS CONT) - in zero tolerance almost religiously...
- 21.38.01 KOVACEK (CONT) - No appeals process. Essentially a single sentence, life imprisonment, for nearly all offenses.
- 21.43.17 HAMMOND - Doesn't sound like justice to me.
- 21.45.13 KOVACEK - Perhaps not, sir, but the fact is they have virtually no crime. Just crimes of passion. Sometimes the occasional sociopath.
- 21.52.27 WARREN - General, sir, SG-3 is prepared and willing...
- 21.54.23 WARREN (OS CONT) - to go in.
- 21.55.06 KOVACEK (OS) - No sir. With all due respect...

21.57.22 KOVACEK (CONT) - force isn't the answer, sir. They're far more technologically advanced than we are. We couldn't possibly succeed in extracting SG-1 and we'd just be making an enemy.

22.06.04 WARREN - They've already made an enemy.

22.07.22 KOVACEK - No. I disagree... Sir, they're open to relations...

22.12.05 KOVACEK (OS CONT) - with us. In fact...

22.13.25 KOVACEK (CONT) - next time I think several members of the Taldor are going to allow us to see their...

22.16.24 KOVACEK (OS CONT) - faces.

22.17.14 WARREN - Sir, this is nuts. Let my team go back.

22.20.08 HAMMOND - Major, as of 0-800 tomorrow your unit is scheduled for a standard re-con of P2A-509. I expect you to be ready to carry out your mission.

22.28.17 WARREN - Yes sir.

22.30.14 HAMMOND - Major Kovacek, return to P3...

22.32.23 HAMMOND (OS CONT) - X 775...

22.34.05 /HAMMOND (CONT) - Let them know we mean business. Better yet, I'll tell them myself.

23.10.06 LINEA (OS) - I treat...

23.10.119 LINEA (CONT) - it before ingesting...

23.13.02 LINEA (OS CONT) - It's quite better than what you scraped
from the bottom of the barrel.

23.16.10 CARTER (OS) - Uh, thank you...

23.18.24 CARTER (CONT) - Actually, I came to ask you something.

23.20.09 LINEA - My crime.

23.21.10 CARTER - Yeah.

23.24.01 LINEA - There was an experiment with tragic consequences.
People died.

23.30.01 CARTER - How many people?

23.31.10 LINEA - Thousands...

23.32.22 LINEA (OS CONT) - It began with a terrible plague among
the people who sent you here...

23.36.10 LINEA (CONT) - Time was short. I offered my knowledge.
Instead of inhibiting the disease's progress, my
medicine accelerated...

23.44.29 LINEA (OS CONT) - its effects.

23.46.08 CARTER - And they blamed you.

23.48.02 LINEA - Yes.

23.49.25 CARTER - I'm not surprised. We didn't deserve this
 either.

23.53.03 LINEA - Do not think that I'm innocent.

23.56.20 CARTER - What you're saying is that you take
 responsibility for your actions.

23.59.28 LINEA - Yes. I have decided to...

24.06.17 LINEA (OS CONT) - accept your offer.

24.08.19 CARTER - Great. I'll tell the Colonel.

24.11.11 LINEA - You have altered the balance of power here. I
 have no...

24.13.23 LINEA (OS CONT) - choice.

24.16.07 CARTER - I'm sorry. I don't understand.

24.17.28 LINEA - It is only a matter of time before Vishnoor and
 his followers chal--

24.21.14 LINEA (OS CONT) --lence your friends.

24.23.03 CARTER - I'll warn them. Thank you.

24.01.07 KOVACEK (OS) - But they do seem to want to maintain diplomatic contact.

25.05.04 FEMALE VOICE (OS) - Special envoy, you may embark when ready.

24.21.13 HAMMOND - Well here goes.

25.22.20 KOVACEK - Since this is your first time, sir, a quick word of advice. It's better to exhale just prior to crossing the event horizon. One's instinct is to inhale...

25.31.01 KOVACEK (OS CONT) - immediately upon arriving on the other side. Also--

25.34.00 HAMMOND - I think I'll figure it out okay. You're sure they dialed the correct address?

25.40.24 KOVACEK - Yes sir.

25.46.05 HAMMOND - The things I do for these people.

25.54.02 DANIEL (OS) - Okay, so Cimmeria's out...

25.55.21 DANIEL (CONT) - So is Chulak.

25.57.15 O'NEILL (OS) - Captain.

25.59.11 CARTER - She says she'll give us power as long as we take her with us.

26.02.11 O'NEILL - Well that's fine, but we still need a destination.

26.05.06 DANIEL - Okay, well P3A 707 might work, but, uh, there's no tellin' how long we'd be there--

26.11.25 O'NEILL - For cryin' out loud...

26.13.27 O'NEILL (OS CONT) - Let's go.

26.23.12 DANIEL - What's goin' on?

26.24.21 CARTER (OS) - They think it's a way of escape.

26.26.07 DANIEL (OS) - What?...

26.26.27 DANIEL (CONT) - Excuse me. Listen to me.

26.29.09 O'NEILL - Daniel!

26.33.18 DANIEL - Look, this won't save you.

26.36.02 O'NEILL - Daniel, get out of there.

26.38.07 DANIEL - You won't escape. You'll die.

26.40.13 ROSHURE - Out of my way!

27.02.10 VISHNOOR - How dare you interfere?

27.05.11 DANIEL (OS) - I was tryin' to save those men's lives.
 They're dead now...

27.10.00 DANIEL (CONT) - They haven't escaped anywhere. They are
 dead.

27.13.01 LINEA - Vishnoor... Leave him.

27.20.22 VISHNOOR - He challenges me... I accept.

27.25.01 DANIEL - How can you let this happen? Roshure just threw
 his life away.

27.28.07 LINEA - It was his life...

27.30.00 LINEA (OS CONT) - The rules are the rules...

27.31.29 LINEA (CONT) - Even I must obey them.

27.46.05 CARTER (OS) - Linea...

27.46.21 CARTER (CONT) - you can stop this!

27.48.21 LINEA - I told you this was going to happen.

27.53.20 CARTER (OS) - Teal'c! Teal'c!

28.28.14 CARTER (OS) - He's still alive. Just barely.

28.38.23 FEMALE VOICE (OS) - You are most punctual.

28.40.17 KOVACEK - Thank you.

28.41.08 MALE VOICE (OS) - You are the one called General Hammond?

28.43.21 HAMMOND - Yes. I'm responsible for those people you have
in prison.

28.48.21 KOVACEK - By using the word responsible, the General is
in no way assuming accountability for the actions of
SG-1. Begging your pardon, sir, I don't want you to
end up in prison along with them.

28.59.13 HAMMOND - On the contrary. I would gladly hold myself
responsible. I ordered them to this world in the
first place.

29.07.01 FEMALE VOICE (OS) - Is this an admission of guilt?

29.08.24 KOVACEK - No.

29.09.15 HAMMOND - Yes it is. As a matter of fact, if you would
allow me to take the place of SG-1--

29.16.11 MALE VOICE (OS) - You ordered them to aid a murderer?

29.18.22 HAMMOND - No.

29.20.04 FEMALE VOICE (OS) - Then you're not guilty.

29.21.18 MALE VOICE (OS) - Not guilty.

29.23.25 FEMALE VOICE (OS) - Assumption of guilt by proxy is
rejected.

29.27.08 HAMMOND - If my people are not released, the imprisonment
of the members of SG-1 will be considered a hostile
act. Peaceful relations between our two worlds will
end right here, right now.

29.42.28 MALE VOICE (OS) - Our law is immutable.

29.44.23 HAMMOND - Your law is unjust.

29.46.12 KOVACEK - I'm not sure if this--

29.47.10 HAMMOND - What's it going to be?

29.49.08 FEMALE VOICE (OS) - Release is impossible.

29.50.29 HAMMOND - Why?

29.52.01 MALE VOICE (OS) - There are not returns from Hadante.
 For anyone.

30.01.23 LINEA - There. I have done what I can.

30.10.11 CARTER - I don't understand what happened.

30.12.17 LINEA - Your friend prevailed.

30.19.06 LINEA (OS) - What is your name?

30.21.09 SIMIAN - Simian. I took food. I was hungry. Starving.
 They sent me here.

30.29.06 LINEA (OS) - Hold still...

30.30.22 LINEA (CONT) - Hold still.

30.34.12 CARTER - He's blind.

30.35.20 LINEA - Yes. But not always so.

30.39.09 SIMIAN (OS) - It's taken from me...

30.40.00 SIMIAN (CONT) - a little each day.

- 31.51.24 O'NEILL - Little brain damage along the way?
- 31.54.06 DANIEL - No, uh uh, SG-3 was scheduled to go on a mission to P2A 509. General Hammond said so in our last planning briefing...
- 32.02.17 DANIEL (OS CONT) - We rendezvous with SG-3 and we use their remote...
