- 13.12.07 FRAISER-Sir, with your permission...
- 13.17.19 GENERAL HAMMOND (INTO MIC FILTERED)-Colonel O'Neill,...
- 13.19.22 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT INTO MIC FILTERED)-This is going to take some time.
- 13.37.08 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS INTO PHONE)-I don't really give a damn what Colonel...

 Initiate Wildfire.
- 14.50.28 VOICE (ON INTERCOM FILTERED)-Attention. Level four quarantine is now in effect. Switching to internal power and life support.

- 15.11.18 O'NEILL-Hot...
- 15.13.15 FRAISER-I know. You have a very high fever. It's being caused by an infection.
- 15.18.20 FRAISER (OS CONT)-I'll give you a broad spectrum antibiotic to help fight it.
- 15.24.16 TECH GUY (INTO MIC FILTERED)-The artifact's internal temperature just leveled off at a hundred and forty nine degrees fahrenheit.
- 15.31.16 TEAL'C-Sergeant. Your progress here is unsatisfactory.
- 15.36.05 SILER-Can't go any faster, sir. This is the hardest stuff I've ever come across.
- 15.41.09 TEAL'C-Then I will delay you no further.
- 15.45.27 CARTER-We're gonna need everyone's help. Colonel O'Neill is alive, but, obviously, he's in trouble.
- 15.51.02 DANIEL (OS)-The data we managed to gather...
- DANIEL (CONT)-before this happened is all in the base computer. It's not much, but it's all we have. Use it.

- 15.58.22 CARTER-Don't rule anything out, and don't make any assumptions.
- 16.01.22 DANIEL-I'll be leading the translation team.
- 16.03.20 CARTER-And we'll be working out of the astrophysics lab, but we're all gonna have to work together on this one. Any questions?
- 16.09.03 SG LEADER-So obviously we're dealing with a weapon.
- 16,11,27 CARTER-That's an assumption, Captain. Alright. Let's get to work. (TO FRAISER) How is he?
- 16.22.11 FRAISER-He's developed an infection. I've got him pumped full of antibiotics, which, amazingly, seem to have slowed his progress...

- 16.29.28 FRAISER-I think you should see this.

- 16.45.25 CARTER (OS)-And it's infected the Colonel.
- 16.47.09 FRAISER-This is why I wanted you to see it. I took this from a section of Colonel O'Neill's uniform around his wound...
- 16.53.15 CARTER-Well, what are you saying? It's infected his clothes as well as living tissue?
- 16.57.03 FRAISER-And it's matabolizing the fibers exactly as if it was living tissue. Like an indiscriminate form of necrotizing fasceitus.
- 17.03.13 CARTER-Flesh eating disease... (beat) Okay, you said slightly radioactive?
- 17.09.15 FRAISER-Yeah.
- 17.11.00 CARTER-Lieutenant?
- 17.12.13 CARTER (OS CONT)-We used ultraviolet when we were performing test on the iris' structural integrity...
- 17.16.22 SIMMONS-Right.
- 17.18.18 CARTER-Yeah.
- 17.23.18 SIMMONS (OS INTO PHONE)-Uh, let's get some UV...

- 17.24.20 SIMMONS (CONT INTO PHONE)-units in the gate room.
- 17.27.12 CARTER (INTO MIC)-Teal'c... Colonel...
- 17.29.09 CARTER (OS CONT INTO MIC FILTERED)-It's gonna get a little dark in there for just a few seconds while we try something.
- 17.55.01 SIMMONS-Okay... Bringing up the UV lights... now.
- 18.03.19 FRAISER-Oh my God...
- 18.21.19 CARTER-This is an even bigger problem than we thought.
- 18.25.07 SIMMONS (OS)-Captain Carter...?
- 18.28.13 SIMMONS (CONT)-What's happening to me?
- 18.44.09 CARTER (VO)-This organism can eat through...
- 18.45.10 CARTER (OS CONT)-virtually any substance, even concrete.
- 18.48.24 GENERAL HAMMOND-This entire complex is made of concrete.
- 18.51.24 CARTER-Worse than that, we've already determined that it's got a taste for the base wiring,...
- 18.55.14 CARTER (OS CONT)-which means that it's gonna affect or...
- 18.56.28 CARTER (CONT)-rather <u>infect</u> our computers and communications.

- 19.00.07 GENERAL HAMMOND-Then we need to kill it.
- 19.01.24 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-How do we do that?
- 19.03.20 FRAISER (OS)-We've sprayed around the base computer...

 FRAISER (CONT)-mainframe with a sort of pesticide, but it hasn't even slowed the organism down.
- 19.09.18 GENERAL HAMMOND-What was that you just gave me?
- 19.11.19 FRAISER-Tetracycline. It's kept the infection at bay in Colonel O'Neill, and it seems to work prophylactically in everyone else I've managed to get a shot into. But, sir, I'll need more --
- 19.20.08 GENERAL HAMMOND (overlapping)-Absolutely not. A wildfire directive means nothing in or out. You know that.
- 19.25.00 FRAISER-Sir, Lieutenant Simmons' infection is even more far gone than Colonel O'Neill's,...
- 19.29.11 FRAISER (OS CONT)-but he's allergic to Tetracycline,...
- 10.31.10 FRAISER (CONT)-and none of the alternatives I have on base --
- 19.32.27 GENERAL HAMMOND (overlapping)-Don't make me repeat myself, Doctor.

- 19.43.18 FRAISER-With your permission, sir, I'd better get back to the infirmary.
- 19.55.19 GENERAL HAMMOND-Captain...?
- 19.57.02 CARTER-Sir?
- 19.58.07 GENERAL HAMMOND-I need your honest assessment. Can we beat this thing?
- 20.02.06 CARTER-Well, like the Colonel always says, never give up, right? I'm not sure, sir.
- 20.12.00 GENERAL HAMMOND-Maybe it's time we considered evacuating personnel through the Stargate.
- CARTER-I thought of that, but to where? There's no guarantee that we can stop the organism from coming through the gate along with us. I don't think we have the right to infect another world.
- 20.20.18 GENERAL HAMMOND-Well, there are a number of uninhabited worlds we could gate through.
- 20.30.25 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-Albeit, most are uninhabited...
- 20.33.03 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-for a good reason.
- 20.34.00 CARTER (OS)-Even if we could...

- 20.35.02 CARTER (CONT)-evacuate a number of survivors, practically every one of us is now infected by the organism to some degree.
- 20.41.13 CARTER (OS CONT)-Without antibiotics, we'd all be like Lieutenant Simmons by now.
- 20.45.13 CARTER (CONT)-The survivors would run out of supplies within a few days.
- 20.48.13 GENERAL HAMMOND-At least they'd have that much time to find a solution.
- 20.51.12 CARTER-It's not worth the risk in my opinion, sir. We don't even know what the orb would do if we tried to activate the Stargate again.
- 21.01.26 GENERAL HAMMOND-Very well. We'll make our stand right here, Captain.
- 21.05.14 CARTER-Yes, sir. (beat) It won't take us without a fight, sir.
 - 21.13.22 GENERAL HAMMOND-Damn right it won't.
 - 21.34.23 O'NEILL-Teal'c...
 - 21.36.19 / TEAL'C-I am here, O'Neill.

- 21.41.08 O'NEILL-It's hot.
- 21.43.00 TEAL'C (OS)-The fever burns within you.
- 21.49.23 O'NEILL-You?
- 21.51.05 TEAL'C-The symbiote I carry appears to protect me.
- 21.54.21 O'NEILL-Way to go, Junior.
- 21.59.25 TEAL'C-Doctor Fraiser will find a cure.
- 22.11.06 O'NEILL-Teal'c, you don't have to stand around.
