05.02.20 DR. FRAISER (CONT)-But that's not the worst part.

05.04.19 O'NEILL-What is?

05.06.03 DR. FRAISER-The blood sample I took showed a rather
disturbing amount of DNA that doesn't match
Teal'c's.

05.11.19 DANIEL/O'NEILL-What does that mean?

05.14.15 DR. FRAISER-Actually, I'm not sure. Uh, to be perfectly
honest with you, sir, I think I may be out of my
league here.

05.20.05 CARTER (OS)-General, if I may...

05.21.13 CARTER (CONT)-When I was assigned to the Pentagon, I had
a chance to work with Dr. Timothy Harlow.

05.25.19 CARTER (OS CONT)-He's one of the world's top genetecists.

05.27.12 CARTER (CONT)-And he has full security clearance.

06.44.22 CARTER-Okay. Bottom line?

06.48.06 HARLOW-I can't believe I'm gonna say this. It appears that the alien insect's venom is rewriting Teal'c's genetic material.

06.58.15 HARLOW (OS CONT)-And it happened very quickly in that blood sample.

07.01.19 CARTER-The Goa'uld that Teal'c carries is supposed to provide him with powerful immune capabilities.

07.34.28 TEAL'C-I have felt great pain, O'Neill.

07.39.20 TEAL'C (OS CONT)-But never sickness such as this.

07.46.06 TEAL'C (CONT)-I do not enjoy it.

07.49.04 O'NEILL-Nobody does.

07.52.04 TEAL'C-I am also feeling something else.

07.57.12 O'NEILL-Hey, I'd be scared, too.

08.03.02 TEAL'C-I do not want to become something other than who I
 am.

08.08.11 O'NEILL-Just let the doctors do their job.

08.10.28 TEAL'C (OS)-O'Neill...

08.13.27 TEAL'C (CONT)-You are my friend. (beat) When there is
 no longer any hope, I would rather die.

08.32.02 GENERAL HAMMOND-Come in.

08.33.14 O'NEILL-You wanted to see me, sir? (beat) Oh, for
 cryin' out loud...

08.41.27 MAYBOURNE-Colonel O'Neill...

08.43.22 O'NEILL-Hello, Maybourne.

08.45.26 GENERAL HAMMOND-I thought you would want to see this.

08.58.22 O'NEILL-You've got to be kidding.

09.00.06 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-It's an official order.

11.10.26 O'NEILL-What's with the chains?

11.12.19 GENERAL HAMMOND-Maybourne.

11.16.16 O'NEILL-Of course.

11.36.00 MAYBOURNE-How long do you figure he has?

11.37.26 HARLOW-That's tough to say. Depends on how strong the
larval Goa'uld is. We have drugs that may help --

11.46.00 MAYBOURNE (overlapping)-That won't be necessary.

11.47.19 HARLOW-Of course it is. We can... (beat) You want him
to change...?

12.18.27 CARTER-All I'm saying is, not withstanding what happened to Teal'c, there may be invaluable technology on that planet.

12.23.25 O'NEILL-Carter, there are bugs on that planet. Big, huge, ugly, honkin' bugs.

12.29.00 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-Colonel!

12.29.28 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-We just picked up an emergency communication from the driver.

13.57.13 CARTER-The driver's unconscious.

13.59.11 DANIEL (OS)-Jack?

14.03.26 DANIEL (CONT)-It's alive.

14.13.17 MAYBOURNE-I want as many personnel and canine units as this base has at my disposal five minutes ago!

14.18.17 O'NEILL (OS)-All of whom...

14.19.00 O'NEILL (CONT)-report to me. I'm running this search.

14.22.17 MAYBOURNE-This is still my responsibility.

14.24.15 O'NEILL-Oh, I'm holding you responsible, Maybourne.
Don't you fret. But the troops are SGC. I'm
running the show. You got a problem with that, take
it up with Hammond.

14.35.28 MAYBOURNE-I will. Striking an officer is a quick way to

15.32.02 HARLOW-The alien insect's venom is affecting his physical

15.44.08 HARLOW (OS CONT)-holding that transformation back.

15.47.23 O'NEILL-So, by taking the worm out, he might be
expediting this change?

15.54.19 DANIEL-Why would he do that?

15.58.01 DANIEL-The metamorphosis could be altering his mind.

16.13.08 DR. FRAISER-It's stable.

16.15.00 CARTER-I don't think it will be for long.

16.17.04 DR. FRAISER-I just wish I knew more about Goa'uld
physiology.

16.19.24 CARTER-The frustrating thing is, I might. Jolinar might have left me with some information, but I --

16.25.00 DR. FRAISER-Okay, look... We've got samples of the fluid from inside Teal'c's pouch.

16.29.01 DR. FRAISER (OS CONT)-So for now, we'll just have to do our best to synthesize the environment.

17.07.23 TEAL'C (INTO TRANSMITTER)-I will not say.

17.09.18 O'NEILL (INTO PHONE)-Come on, Teal'c, where are you? We
can help you.

17.15.21 TEAL'C-It is too late.

17.17.05 O'NEILL (INTO PHONE)-Alright, listen... You're changing.
You don't want this to happen. You told me you'd
rather die. (beat) Teal'c?

17.31.02 O'NEILL (VO CONT ON PHONE FILTERED)-Teal'c?

17.39.03 HARLOW (OS)-It is possible we can still save your friend
if we can get him back.

17.42.28 CARTER-How?

17.43.25 HARLOW-Well, I have access to several variations of
experimental RNA inhibitors, which are being
researched at the moment. And combined with the
natural healing abilities of the symbiote --

offer right away, when it could have helped?

18.10.22 CARTER-Okay. What do you need?

18.12.18 HARLOW-Well, we have to find out which of the drugs will
work.

18.17.03 CARTER-How?

18.19.16 HARLOW-We need the alien insect's venom.

18.26.08 GENERAL HAMMOND-How do you know you can trust Harlow this
time?

18.29.12 CARTER-I know. You think Maybourne put him up to this
just to get a specimen of the insect.

18.32.23 GENERAL HAMMOND-I wouldn't put it past him.

18.34.11 CARTER-Right at the moment, sir, we don't have a lot of
options.

18.38.07 O'NEILL-We got nothing, sir.

18.39.18 DANIEL-Must've covered twenty miles in an hour.

18.41.12 GENERAL HAMMOND-Maybourne is flying in his own personnel.

18.43.11 O'NEILL-Any action on the red phone?

18.45.05 GENERAL HAMMOND-Still indisposed.

18.46.22 CARTER-In the meantime, we have kind of good news/bad news scenario here. If we do find Teal'c soon, we may have a way of saving him.

18.53.23 O'NEILL-Okay. That's good news.

18.55.26 CARTER-But someone has to go back to BP6-3Q1...

18.59.13 CARTER (OS CONT)-and catch one of those alien insects.

19.01.01 CARTER (CONT)-Preferably alive.

19.02.02 DANIEL (OS)-And that would...

19.02.17 DANIEL (CONT)-be the bad news.

19.04.20 O'NEILL-I'll go, sir.

19.05.18 CARTER-You'll need someone to watch your back.

19.06.27 DANIEL-And I'll go, too.

19.08.03 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-I'll make sure it's...

19.08.27 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-not for nothing. We'll find
 Teal'c.

19.11.26 O'NEILL-Pack your bug spray, kids.

19.26.27 PUNK LEADER-Hey, check this dude out. Hey, man, where

19.35.28 TEAL'C-Chulak.

19.37.02 PUNK LEADER-Chulak? Where's that, East Side?

19.40.24 TEAL'C-Remove myself from my path.

19.43.13 PUNK LEADER-Listen to this guy. I'll remove myself when
 you tell me how they do tatoos like that in Chulak.

19.50.13 TEAL'C-The skin is cut with an Orak knife, and pure
 molten gold is poured into the wound.

21.18.25 DR. FRAISER-How long have they been gone?

21.21.26 GENERAL HAMMOND-I'm about ready to send SG-3 after them.

22.27.14 TECHNICIAN-Incoming wormhole! It's SG-1.

22.43.20 O'NEILL-(through mask) Lock it up! (beat, without mask)
Close those doors! (beat) Where is it...? (beat)

23.02.06 DANIEL-(through mask) There!

23.19.13 O'NEILL-Just winged it. (beat) Alright, alright! You
got it.

23.37.15 HARLOW (OS)-Not your garden variety mosquito.

23.40.03 GENERAL HAMMOND-There's no word on Teal'c yet, but
Maybourne's put out...

23.42.14 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-an all points bulletin to the
state and local police.

23.45.23 O'NEILL-We've gotta find him first, sir.

23.47.15 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-Right at the moment,...

23.48.17 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-Maybourne has the manpower
advantage and the jurisdiction.

23.51.15 CARTER-You really should see this, sir.

24.00.21 DANIEL-We thought we heard noises coming from one of the
buildings.

24.03.00 CARTER-It seems the final stage of the metamorphosis requires a dark place.

24.10.17 GENERAL HAMMOND-That's a man.

24.11.23 DANIEL (OS)-It looks like the inhabitants of the planet were...

24.12.16 DANIEL (CONT)-human. Possibly from Earth originally.

24.15.14 O'NEILL-Daniel was right.

24.17.17 DANIEL (OS)-But their entire civilization...

24.18.00 DANIEL (CONT)-was obviously wiped out by this bug. And all those inhabitants were changed.

24.23.01 CARTER-It's amazing, really. I mean, they all the technology we do -- maybe more. And they couldn't prevent their demise at the hands of a simple insect.

24.30.11 O'NEILL-Yeah, real simple. (beat) Take a look at this, sir.

24.42.10 GENERAL HAMMOND-All those things came from one body?

24.46.23 HARLOW-Of course. Equal matter conversion.

24.52.12 CARTER-It's how they reproduce. The insect's venom actually converts the body's mass into its own DNA material.

24.58.28 CARTER (OS CONT)-But a human -- or in this case, a Jaffa's total matter is much greater than one of the insects' natural mass.

25.05.01 O'NEILL-Thank you.

25.06.16 GENERAL HAMMOND-So Teal'c isn't gonna turn into just one of those things...

25.09.20 CARTER (OS)-No, sir.

25.11.08 CARTER (CONT)-He's gonna turn into a whole lot of those things.
