01.00.08 GENERAL HAMMOND-Jacob Carter.

01.01.28 O'NEILL-Carter?

01.02.15 CARTER-As in my father, Sir. Yes.

01.04.10 JACOB CARTER (OS)-George told me you were...
JACOB CARTER (CONT)-up for the Air Medal for your work in --
what the hell was that again, uh?

01.09.21 CARTER-Deep Space Radar Telemetry.

01.11.27 JACOB CARTER-Right.

01.13.05 JACOB CARTER-I have cancer, Sam.

01.15.01 CARTER-What?

01.15.29 JACOB CARTER-Lymphoma.

01.17.07 CARTER-Oh God, Dad.

JACOB CARTER (OS)-This thing's going to go on for...

JACOB CARTER (CONT)-months, so you don't have to check up on
me tomorrow or anything.

01.22.19 CARTER-Dad, please don't go like...

CARTER (OS CONT)-this.

05.10.26 O'NEILL-General?

05.11.22 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-I'm prepared...

GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-to send SG-1 through to the
coordinates Captain Carter saw in her vision, if you
agree.

05.18.03 CARTER (OS)-Colonel, I know...

CARTER (CONT)-you're skeptical about these things, but I am

05.29.15 O'NEILL-Let's check it out.

05.43.06 CARTER-Colonel, is it all right if I catch up with you?

06.38.16 CARTER (INTO PHONE)-You're sure?

06.56.20 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-You're father?

07.00.18 CARTER-Yes, sir.

07.02.07 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-How is Jacob?

07.04.17 CARTER-He claims he's okay.
CARTER (OS CONT)-Not that he'd tell me if he weren't.
CARTER (CONT)-Did you know he actually got an apartment here in town?

07.11.15 GENERAL HAMMOND-He wanted to be closer to his daughter during...

07.15.22 CARTER-During his last days.

07.20.00 Sir, this is the first time I've left on a mission where I felt I might be leaving something behind. Like I might miss something important.

07.29.05 GENERAL HAMMOND-Understandable. I'll put a temporary replacement...

 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-on SG-1. You can stay here.

 CARTER (CONT)-But I don't think I'm replaceable on this one.

07.45.01 GENERAL HAMMOND-True. But your father... --

07.50.18 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-Sam,...

 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-I've known Jacob a long time. That's not true.

07.58.18 CARTER-Sir, he's always too concerned about appearing the strong soldier.

 CARTER (OS CONT)-The last thing he would want is for me to...

 CARTER (CONT)-see him in hospital bed losing a battle.

08.10.20 I should get going, Sir. I don't want to hold things up.

08.15.06 GENERAL HAMMOND-Captain.

08.20.03 You're more like your father than you'd like to admit.

- 08.50.21 TEAL'C-There is no evidence of footprints or tracks of any
 kind.
- TEAL'C (OS CONT)-If the Tok'ra were here, they have not been
 near the gate in many days.
- 09.00.20 O'NEILL-Ah, where's that yellow brick road when you need it,
 eh, Dorothy?
- 09.06.12 CARTER-Some sort of dunes over there.
- 09.09.28 O'NEILL-Dunes it is.
- 09.21.08 O'NEILL-Worthless.
- 09.27.14 O'NEILL (OS)-No one's tread here in a while.
- 09.29.26 TEAL'C (OS)-The Tok'ra are known for their ability to mask
 their trails. They are, as you say, stealthy in their
 actions.
- 09.41.28 DANIEL-Yeah, stealthy would be a good word, Teal'c.
- 09.45.23 O'NEILL-Good guys or bad guys?

09.50.23 CORDESH-We mean you no harm.
CORDESH (OS CONT)-But I warn you, if you make any aggressive
 moves,...

CORDESH (CONT)-we will fire upon you.

09.56.18 O'NEILL-Same here.

09.58.11 CORDESH (OS)-Oh,...

CORDESH (CONT)-but I think we will have the advantage. There
 are more of us.

10.06.07 O'NEILL (OS)-This is true.

10.07.16 MARTOUF-This one is a Jaffa. Apophis sect.

10.10.22 TEAL'C-I am no longer in the service of Apophis.

10.13.01 MARTOUF-Who, then, are you in service to?

10.15.02 TEAL'C (OS)-I...

TEAL'C (CONT)-am allied with these, the Tauri.

TEAL'C (OS CONT)-In battle against...

TEAL'C (CONT)-Apophis.

10.20.04 DANIEL (OS)-And all...

DANIEL (CONT)-other Goa'uld.

10.22.22 CARTER-Be careful, Daniel.

10.23.06 DANIEL (OS)-Why?

10.23.26 CARTER-Because they are Goa'uld.

10.25.16 CORDESH (GOA'ULD VOICE)-Do not call us that. We are not
Goa'uld.

10.41.02 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-Hammond.
GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT INTO PHONE)-Put him through.

10.47.09 Jacob, you okay? Oh, no. I'll be right there.

11.05.17 O'NEILL-You know, in some galaxies, this is called loitering.
How long do you think we can keep it up?

11.15.27 CARTER-Martouf?

11.19.22 MARTOUF-I do not know this woman.

11.21.13 CARTER-But I'm right, aren't I? That's your name -- Martouf.

11.25.27 MARTOUF-It is. How do you know me?

11.29.04 CARTER-I don't. But I knew someone who did. His name was
Jolinar of Malkshur.

11.37.24 CORDESH (GOA'ULD VOICE)-Where is Jolinar.

11.41.12 CARTER-He died saving my life.

11.43.24 DANIEL (OS)-That's why...
DANIEL (CONT)-we're here, to seek out the Tok'ra.

11.46.05 O'NEILL-Assuming, of course, you are the Tok'ra.

11.51.10 CORDESH (GOA'ULD VOICE)-And if we're not?

11.53.06 O'NEILL-Well, I guess we all start shooting. There's blood,
 death, hard feelings. It'd suck.

12.00.22 MARTOUF (OS)-And if we are...
MARTOUF (CONT)-this thing you call Tok'ra.

12.03.12 TEAL'C (OS)-If you are indeed the...
TEAL'C (CONT)-Tok'ra of Jaffa legend, we should form an
 alliance.

12.08.28 CARTER (OS)-I learned a lot from...
CARTER (CONT)-Jolinar. Enough to know that we could be
 good...
CARTER (OS CONT)-friends. And, frankly, enough to know...
CARTER (CONT)-that you are the Tok'ra.

12.24.08 MARTOUF-I believe this one speaks the truth.

12.29.05 Perhaps we should just listen to what they have to say.

12.53.11 O'NEILL-Well, that's better, isn't it? So, take me to your leader.

13.01.08 CORDESH (GOA'ULD VOICE)-I will take you to whom you seek, but there is one condition. You must leave your weapons with us.

13.07.15 O'NEILL-Ah, no. No.

13.09.12 CARTER-They won't hurt us, Colonel.

13.10.27 O'NEILL (OS)-They're...
O'NEILL (CONT)-Goa'ulds, Carter.

13.13.08 CARTER-They won't hurt us.

13.15.06 O'NEILL-Any you, what, feel this?

13.16.28 CARTER-No. I can remember it.

13.20.27 TEAL'C (OS)-O'Neill,...
TEAL'C (CONT)-if they are the Tok'ra, we are in no danger.

.3.26.24 DANIEL-If you asking for opinions, I vote we take the chance.

13.33.26 O'NEILL-Okay. But I want it understood that we're doing this
in the spirit of future relations. I expect us to be
treated as such.

14.10.01 MARTOUF-Please, come closer together.

14.13.08 O'NEILL-Why?

14.14.13 DANIEL-Jack --

14.15.20 CARTER-It's okay.

14.17.13 O'NEILL-Oh, it is?

14.34.18 CORDESH (OS)-This way.

14.38.25 CARTER (OS)-This looks just like the place in my dream.
CARTER (CONT)-But that was on the planet that we, they were
fleeing.

- 14.46.04 TEAL'C (OS)-It is said throughout the legend of the Tok'ra,
 when...
- TEAL'C (CONT)-they arrive on a planet they go deep
 underground.
- TEAL'C (OS CONT)-It is said they possess the technology to
 actually grow tunnels.
- 14.55.26 CARTER-This looks like some sort of crystal material, so
 theoretically it could be growing.
- 14.58.28 TEAL'C (OS)-Apophis had me searching for tunnels such as
 these for many years. We never found them.
- TEAL'C (CONT)-It is believed when the Tok'ra move on, the
 tunnels are destroyed.
- 15.09.17 O'NEILL-Carter. What's the story with this Martouf?
- 15.14.05 CARTER-I'm not sure. I get the feeling I know almost all of
 these people, but my memories of Martouf are the
 strongest. It's like I have some weird bond with him.
- 15.25.23 MARTOUF-Please, come this way.
- 16.04.10 JACOB CARTER-George.
- 16.07.04 GENERAL HAMMOND-Jacob. Are you alright?

.12.07 JACOB CARTER-I've been better.

16.14.05 GENERAL HAMMOND-I was under the impression that the cancer hadn't gone this far.

16.18.27 JACOB CARTER-So was I. They cleaned out all the lymph nodes. Problem is, apparently, one squadron of those little buggers got themselves reassigned in my liver.

16.29.29 GENERAL HAMMOND-Let me make a call, get Captain Carter recalled.

16.32.01 JACOB CARTER (OVERLAPPING)-There's no need.

- 17.56.19 GENERAL HAMMOND-I'm sorry, Jake.
- 18.15.15 CORDESH (GOA'ULD VOICE)-People of the Tauri, let me introduce

- 18.28.07 O'NEILL-Hi.

18.55.22 O'NEILL -Yeah.

18.57.16 GARSHAW (GOA'ULD VOICE) -Were you among those who rid the
galaxy of the Supreme System Lord, Ra?

19.20.10 GARSHAW (GOA'ULD VOICE) -We, too, are Tok'ra.

19.23.11 O'NEILL -Finally.

19.25.03 CARTER -It's a pleasure to meet you.

20.09.24 DOCTOR (OS)-Okay, he's in V-tech. Let's go, let's shock him
at two hundred.

20.12.10 NURSE (OS)-Two hundred.

20.12.26 DOCTOR (OS)-Okay, clear.

20.19.08 DOCTOR-Again, at three hundred.

20.20.02 NURSE (OS)-Three hundred.

20.21.12 DOCTOR (OS CONT)-Clear.

20.26.24 DOCTOR-Normal sinus. Okay.

20.31.10 Hey, General, how are you doing?
DOCTOR (OS CONT)-Alright, he's in A-plastic crisis. Let's
give him a unit of packed cells. Check his...
DOCTOR (CONT)-vitals every fifteen minutes and, uh, let me

20.44.00 GENERAL HAMMOND-Doctor.

20.46.07 DOCTOR-He's, uh, stable, for now.

20.49.06 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-May I ask, ...
GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-how long does he have?

20.53.05 DOCTOR-Can't say with a cancer like this. Could be, uh, five days or five minutes.

20.59.01 Sorry. If there's any family for you to contact, I'd recommend you get them here A-S-A-P.

21.16.04 GARSHAW (GOA'ULD VOICE)-So, am I to understand you did not invite Jolinar to use you as a host?

21.20.16 CARTER-That is correct. He did it in an emergency situation to escape an assassin.

21.25.00 CORDESH (GOA'ULD VOICE)-Then if you are not a voluntary host, how do we know that you did kill Jolinar yourself.

21.33.02 CARTER-Uh, well, because I, I didn't. I mean, I, I guess you're just gonna have to trust us on that.

21.38.04 CORDESH (GOA'ULD VOICE)-And why should we trust you?

21.39.26 O'NEILL-You know something? I've been asking myself the same damn question.

21.46.14 Why should we trust you. You are, after all, Goa'ulds.

21.50.20 DANIEL-Jack --
