GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-whatsoever.

01.20.15 TECHNICIAN (OS)-Incoming traveler!

TECHNICIAN (CONT)-SG-11 is returning.

01.23.05 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-There'd better be...

GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-a damn good explanation.

- 01.44.09 GENERAL HAMMOND-Everyone alright?!
- 01.46.04 O'NEILL (OS)-Uh...

O'NEILL (CONT)-no. No... Ugh... God...

- 03.09.21 O'NEILL (OS)-Hi, kids.
- O3.11.23 CARTER-We're about ready to ship out, sir. You gonna be okay?
- 03.15.26 O'NEILL-I'm not dead, Captain. Just grounded for a few days.
- 03.19.26 CARTER-Well, if the bullet-proof glass hadn't slowed it down...
- 03.22.03 O'NEILL-Oh, please. Aliens are always pokin' me full of holes.
- 03.26.22 CARTER-Right.

- 03.28.01 DANIEL-Uh, you might be interested to know that the arrow was Native North American, but of advanced design.
- O3.33.20 CARTER-Our preliminary reports show that it was made of pure forged...
 - CARTER (OS CONT)-Trinium. If there are Native Americans on this planet, they've come a long...
 - CARTER (CONT)-way technologically in the past few hundred years.
- 03.43.00 DANIEL-And we just marched in and started mining.
- O3.47.25 GENERAL HAMMOND-I've just talked to the Pentagon. While they're obviously concerned about finding SG-11, they also want...
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-to avoid further upsetting the indigenous people.
- 03.57.07 CARTER-Meaning they don't want to risk losing the Trinium.
- 04.00.03 GENERAL HAMMOND-Your secondary objective is to negotiate a mining treaty with these people.
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-Obviously we started our relations on the wrong foot.

- 04.08.23 O'NEILL-But that's so rare, sir.
- 04.12.04 GENERAL HAMMOND-Captain, as you are taking over command of SG-1 on this mission,...

GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-my superiors...

GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-have ordered me to remind you to be diplomatic.

- 04.21.08 CARTER-Yes, sir.
- 04.22.11 O'NEILL-Just as I would be.
- 04.28.17 GENERAL HAMMOND-SG-1, you have a goal.
- 04.34.23 O'NEILL (OS)-Sam?
- 04.36.06 CARTER-Colonel?
- 04.39.00 O'NEILL-First command... (beat) Cool.
- 04.43.11 CARTER-I'll do my best, sir.
- 04.45.03 O'NEILL-I know you will, Captain.
- 04.47.00 CARTER-Thanks.

- 05.17.21 TEAL'C (VO ON RADIO FILTERED)-Captain Carter... I am outside the blasting site. It appears deserted. I will investigate further.
- 05.23.23 CARTER (INTO RADIO)-Affirmative. At location now.
- O5.36.23 CARTER-Ooof. Coffee's...

 CARTER (OS CONT)-boiled dry.
- DANIEL-(reading) ...currently extracting an average of 47

 pounds of Trinium ore per day. To increase our .

 production four fold, as the engineers have

 requested -- (TO CARTER) It's a...

 DANIEL (OS CONT)-requisition request from Captain Conner.
- 05.59.03 CARTER-Looks like they all stopped what they were doing

and just left.

DANIEL (CONT)-He just stops in mid-sentence.

- O6.04.00 TEAL'C-I found no sign of struggle at the blast site.

 However, a pair of footprints led me to two separate detonators. The first had been discharged. The second had not.
- O6.14.01 CARTER-So SG-11 was taken by surprise before the second charge went off.

- O6.17.13 TEAL'C-That was my first conclusion. But there were no footprints leading away from the mine. It is as if they disappeared where they were standing.
- 06.26.10 DANIEL-Creepy...
- 06.48.13 TEAL'C-I am certain I heard something.
- 06.53.21 DANIEL-Ghosts?
- 06.55.20 TEAL'C-Jaffa do not believe in such things.
- 06.57.28 CARTER-Let's see if we can't find something more tangible.
- 07.16.13 TEAL'C (OS)-Captain Carter!
- 07.45.16 CARTER-Trinium. Just like the arrow. (beat) Can you interpret it, Daniel?

07.55.24

DANIEL-It's, uh, it's a clan crest. I believe akin to the style of the Central Coast Salish Indians. It, it tells...

DANIEL (OS CONT)-the story of the Clan's origin.

DANIEL (CONT)-This one tells of how they were brought here from a distant planet by evil rulers. Now, according to this figure, uh, the evil rulers were probably...

DANIEL (OS CONT)-Jaffa taking them from Earth.

08.13.07 CARTER-So this was once a Goa'uld planet?

08.16.03

DANIEL-Well, according to the crest, the Goa'uld were destroyed by Xe-ls,...

DANIEL (OS CONT)-who's protected them ever since.

08.25.01

CARTER-Xe-1s?

08.25.27

DANIEL (OS)-He's the Salish's...

DANIEL (CONT)-main spirit. On Earth, he's a benevolent one traditionally and, and represented by this Raven figure.

08.37.22

CARTER-What?

08.43.22

TEAL'C-A wolf. There! (beat) It was there.

- 09.01.26 DANIEL-I heard that.
- 09.02.28 CARTER-Me too. Teal'c...? Ugh...
- 10.02.19 CARTER-Whoa! Hi. We were just stretching our legs. (TO DANIEL/TEAL'C) If we're prisoners, it's a good sign that Conner and SG-11 are too.
- 10.28.23 TEAL'C-This dwelling makes an odd prison.
- 10.31.09 CARTER-I don't know. These walls are made of a flexible Trinium fiber.
 - CARTER (OS CONT)-I'll bet it's waterproof, and it is incredibly strong.
- 10.43.12 DANIEL-It's amazing. They've, they've managed to evolve technologically, yet essentially maintain their way of living.
- 10.49.20 TEAL'C-Yet we have observed no facilities for manufacturing. There should be visible indications of processing.
- 10.56.28 DANIEL-Well, the Salish on Earth are migratory, depending on the season, so...

- 11.04.11 CARTER-I wonder how far we are from the mining camp?
- 11.08.03 TONANE-Couple of days walk. I am Tonane.
- 11.13.10 CARTER-Captain Samantha Carter. SGC.
- 11.15.26 TONANE-Long name.
- 11.18.15 CARTER-Okay. How 'bout... Sam?
- 11.20.19 TONANE-Sam.
- 11.22.06 CARTER-Uh, these are my friends. Doctor Daniel Jackson...
 - 11.26.03 TONANE-Doc?
 - 11.27.06 CARTER-Daniel is fine.
 - 11.29.08 TEAL'C-And I am Teal'c.
 - 11.31.00 TONANE-The spirits say you have a demon inside you, Teal'c.
 - 11.33.27 TEAL'C-The demon will cause you no harm. I give you my word.

- 11.37.27 TONANE-Normally, that would mean a great deal to me. But how do I know the value of your word. We have only just met.
- 11.44.24 CARTER-We mean you no harm, Tonane.
- 11.46.25 TONANE-If you mean us no harm, why did you bring weapons?
- 11.49.16 CARTER-Self-defense. Our friends are missing. We need to find them.
- 11.53.15 TONANE-They're not missing. They're with the spirits.
- 11.55.23 DANIEL-Wh -- you mean dead?
- 11.57.09 TONANE-Oh, no, no... With the spirits.
- 12.01.09 CARTER-Oh. The, the spirits.
- 12.05.13 TONANE-You don't know the spirits, Sam?
- 12.07.05 DANIEL-Oh, we, we know the spirits. We definitely,

 definitely know the spirits. But, but there's so

 many in the forest. Specifically which spirits are
 they with?

- 12.16.00 TONANE-Xe-ls probably... maybe T'akaya.
- 12.19.21 CARTER-Are we prisoners?
- 12.22.02 TONANE-No. You're free to go.
- 12.26.21 CARTER-Can we have our weapons back?
- 12.29.06 TONANE-Okay.
- 12.36.11 CARTER (OS)-One more thing, Tonane...

 CARTER (CONT)-our friends.
- 12.40.09 TONANE (OS)-We were returning to our winter camp,...

 TONANE (CONT)-and we saw your friends making war on the mountain,...

TONANE (OS CONT)-trying to take the Ke.

- 12.46.03 CARTER-Ke... Trinium?
- 12.48.03 TONANE-Yeah, that's what your friend called it.

 TONANE (OS CONT)-After Xe-ls took your friends, he told

 me...
 - TONANE (CONT)-to shoot an arrow through the Circle of Standing Water to warn your kind not to return. I guess we didn't understand.

- 12.58.24 CARTER-Oh, no, we understood. But warning or no warning, it's not our custom to abandon our friends.
- 13.04.17 TONANE-I could introduce you to Xe-ls,...

 TONANE (OS CONT)-and we could tell him it was all a misunderstanding.
- 13.09.07 CARTER-So what you're saying is you'll, you'll take us to where our friends are.
- 13.12.21 TONANE-I don't know where your friends are, but Xe-ls will. (beat) Wouldn't hurt to ask, right, Sam?
- 13.20.11 CARTER-Right.
- 13.26.03 TEAL'C-Clearly Tonane is blaming the spirits for his actions.
- 13.28.22 CARTER-Well, clearly. But if this is the only way to get back SG-11, I say we let him.
- DANIEL-Look, wherever we're going, there's probably going to be a ceremony of some kind. I don't know. They might even ask you to dance. But whatever it is, no matter how ridiculous it may seem, just try to go along with it.

- 14.07.04 CARTER-Don't worry. Tonane! Uh, I was wondering... How is it that you remove the impurities from the Ke so that it won't crumble?
- 14.18.15 TONANE-Well, first we ask the, uh, spirits to ask the mountain for the Ke. And if the mountain is in a good mood, he drops the Ke into the river. The river cleans the Ke until it's shiny. And then we take it out of the river, and shape it into whatever we need.
- 14.41.23 TONANE (OS)-Xe-ls! T'akaya!
- 14.47.09 DANIEL-You're not gonna perform a ceremonial dance?
- 14.52.05 TONANE-My great, great grandfather used to call up the spirits that way. But one day, Xe-ls just said "Call my name!" And that's what we do.
- 15.10.20 TEAL'C-Captain Carter...
- 15.14.12 TONANE-T'akaya, my friend. My, your coat shines beautifully today. (TO CARTER) A little flattery couldn't hurt, Sam.

- 15.25.11 CARTER-My, what big eyes...
 - CARTER (OS CONT)-you have.
- 15.29.28 TONANE-Ask her about your friends.
- 15.36.10 CARTER-T'akaya... (beat) Do you think our friends might be...?
- 15.52.08 TONANE-She's right there.
- 15.55.02 CARTER-I can only see a wolf, Tonane.

 CARTER (OS CONT)-A, a beautiful animal, granted,...

 CARTER (CONT)-but not a spirit.
- 16.03.04 TONANE-You can't see the wind either, Sam. But you know it's there.
 - TONANE (OS CONT)-You can hear it... You can feel it...
 - TONANE (CONT)-You can see its effects on the trees...

It's the same with the spirits.

- TONANE (OS CONT)-You see a wolf, but T'akaya is there.
- 16.26.03 DANIEL-Tonane, is, is that Xe-ls?
- 16.28.03 TONANE-Yes, it is, Daniel.

16.33.19 DANIEL-Xe-ls...

DANIEL (OS CONT)-We mean you...

DANIEL (CONT)-and Tonane no harm. We apologize for any misunderstanding you've had with our friends.

(beat) If you would release them, we'd be very grateful. (TO OTHERS) Did you hear that? I'm almost sure that he said he would release them.

- 17.00.13 TEAL'C-I believe I heard it also.
- 17.03.26 TONANE (OS)-Is that what you heard, Sam?
- 17.06.01 CARTER-Uh, what I heard was a <u>little</u> different.
- 17.10.23 TONANE (OS)-I thought I heard...

TONANE (CONT)-him say that he would think about it, and that he would get back to us.

- 17.15.26 CARTER (OS)-Right. That's what I heard.
- 17.17.28 DANIEL-Well, are you sure? I mean, he, he just...
- 17.19.24 CARTER-Daniel, forget it. Let's just let the bird think about it. Come on. Tonane, do you mind if we look around a little while Xe-ls is making up his mind?

- 17.30.22 TONANE-Fine by me. Xe-ls will catch up to us.
- 17.58.06 TONANE (OS)-Well, that was fast.
- 18.01.11 CARTER-Uh... I'm sorry. I missed that one.
- 18.07.02 TONANE-Xe-ls has granted your request. Your friends will be released.
- 18.13.16 CARTER-Did he say when?
- 18.15.25 TEAL'C-Captain Carter...
- 18.41.19 CONNER-Captain Carter...?
- 18.46.01 TONANE-How does it feel to see the wind, Sam?
- 18.57.26 CARTER (OS)-So, where have you been for the...

 CARTER (CONT)-last forty-eight hours?
- 19.00.14 CONNER-I... can't say. Last thing I remember, I was writing out a requisition for more blasting caps.

 Next thing I know, I'm walking out of this mist... and there you are.
- 19.11.28 DANIEL-And that's it?

- 19.14.06 CONNER-Yes. Except my head feels like I just got back from a three-day pass. But I don't remember...
 - CONNER (OS CONT)-having a good time. We must have been drugged.
- 19.22.12 TEAL'C-As were we.
- 19.23.27 TONANE-Hello, Cap. Still smiling, I hope.
- 19.28.12 CONNER-You...
- 19.29.12 CARTER-Whoa!

CARTER (OS CONT)-Tonane...

- CARTER (CONT)-Captain, this is Tonane. He's our friend.

 He said he asked you to stop blasting. Is that

 true?
- 19.37.27 CONNER-Yes he did. But we'd already set two hot charges.

 I told him to wait until after the blast,...

 CONNER (OS CONT)-then we'll talk.

CONNER (CONT)-He just walked away.

19.48.08 CARTER-Okay. It's not so important right now. You can save it for the report. Tonane, perhaps you and I could have that conversation that Captain Conner should have had with you earlier.

- 19.58.03 TONANE-About taking the Ke from the mountain?
- 19.59.15 CARTER-Yes.
- 20.01.24 TONANE-That's not up to me, Sam. You have to ask the Elders of my village.
- 20.13.21 ELDER #1-I am sorry. We understand, Sam, that you have no ill intentions, that you only wish to extract the Ke. (beat) But your methods are wasteful and violent. They not only upset our people,...

 ELDER #1 (OS CONT)-but our spirits. (something in Native American)
- 20.38.00 ELDER #2-Why can you not be content with the Ke that the spirits send down the river?
- 20.43.07 CARTER-Our people may need more than the river can provide. But we don't wish to shorten your supply.

 Now, we do...
 - CARTER (OS CONT)-have other mining methods that are less destructive.

- 20.53.04 ELDER #1-(somthing in Native American) Perhaps Tonane could return...
 - ELDER #1 (OS CONT)-with you through the Circle of Standing Water and see these methods.
- 21.05.03 CARTER-Uh, y-yeah. That's a solution. Um... Have any of your people ever traveled through...
 - CARTER (OS CONT)-the circle before?
- 21.15.26 ELDER #2-The spirits say it's too dangerous.
- 21.18.12 TONANE-Can't be that dangerous. They're alive. And I love to travel.
- 21.26.03 CARTER-Great. Then it's settled.
- 21.34.07 CARTER (VO)-So the elders agreed to allow Tonane...

 CARTER (CONT)-to come back and observe our alternative mining methods and... here we are.
- 21.40.11 O'NEILL-Sounds like fun. I'm sorry I missed it. Good job, Captain.
- 21.44.14 CARTER-Thank you, sir. How's the --?
- 21.45.24 O'NEILL-Fine. Fine.

- 21.48.02 TONANE (OS)-Oh, I thought you were gonna....

 TONANE (CONT)-show me your mining methods, George.
- 21.51.20 GENERAL HAMMOND-We intend to. But first we need you to take a brief...

GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-medical exam.

- 21.55.09 O'NEILL-George?
- 21.58.20 GENERAL HAMMOND-Tonane, this is Colonel Jack O'Neill.
- 22.00.25 TONANE-Jack...?
- 22.02.15 O'NEILL-Yeah. That'll do. It's an honor to meet you, sir.
- 22.09.24 GENERAL HAMMOND-I know it looks strange, Tonane, but it's completely safe.

GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-Even our people are being examined.

- 22.15.19 CONNER-Don't worry, Tonane. It won't hurt.
- 22.27.21 TONANE-Stop the images, please. (beat) These ways are just as wasteful and destructive as the others.

- 22.36.14 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-It's only the first part of the process, Tonane. Later we restore the land, and...

 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-replant the trees. You haven't seen those images yet.
- 22.44.17 TONANE-I'm convinced that our way is best.
- 22.47.03 O'NEILL-Your way meaning your spirits ask the mountain to send the stuff to you down the river?
- 22.54.19 TONANE-Yes, Jack. It's the best way. The only way we will allow you to take the Ke.
- 23.05.01 GENERAL HAMMOND-I see. Perhaps, uh, Doctor Jackson would show you the rest of our facility. I'm sure you'll...

GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-find it interesting.

- 23.13.22 DANIEL-Uh, yes. I'd, I'd also like to show you images of your ancestors.
- 23.19.26 TONANE-Ancestors?

- 23.21.01 DANIEL-Oh, yeah, yeah. This may come as a, a bit of a shock, but we believe that your, your great-great-great-great-great Grandfather may have actually come from here.
- 23.30.07 TONANE-From here?
- 23.31.14 DANIEL-Um, I'll show you...
- 23.41.14 O'NEILL-Well, his mind's made up.
- 23.45.06 GENERAL HAMMOND-That's unfortunate.
- 23.47.05 CONNER (OS)-They are offering to...

 CONNER (CONT)-share the Trinium, sir.
- 23.49.22 GENERAL HAMMOND-Small deposits washed down from the mountains over thousands of years.
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-That may be enough Trinium to meet the needs of Tonane's....
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-tribe, but not enough for any practical application. Therefore, I have been ordered to...
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-consider other initiatives.
- 24.03.06 CARTER-Initiatives?

- 24.04.17
- GENERAL HAMMOND-Nothing sinister, Captain. The NID has a proposal before the Pentagon suggesting that when the Salish migrate south,...
- GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-we send another SG team to the planet to...
- GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-continue extracting samples, and leave again before the Salish return.
- 24.20.01 O'NEILL-You mean steal it.
- 24.21.21 CARTER-I'm not comfortable with that, sir.
- 24.23.10 CONNER-Sir, they set us free last time, but if they caught us mining the mountain again, they might not be so gracious.
- 24.30.10 GENERAL HAMMOND-I don't like the idea of lying to Tonane's people any more than you do.
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-But the next time...
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-the Goa'uld, we might not be so fortunate.
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-We need whatever...
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-military advantages we can find.

 If that means Trinium --

 - CARTER (CONT)-I am all for getting the Trinium, but there has to be an alternative.
- 24.49.19 O'NEILL-Is anyone at the Pentagon or along the chain of command remotely concerned about their aboriginal rights, repeating history, that annoyingly pesky moral stuff...
- 25.00.10 GENERAL HAMMOND-That's enough, Colonel.
- 25.02.00 CARTER-With respect, General, I think he's right.
- 25.04.00 O'NEILL-Yeah, what the hell. Worked before...
- 25.06.01 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-I've got assurances that it will only be...
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-a small exploratory operation with much less damage...
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-to the mountainside.
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-And hopefully, what they don't know won't hurt them. Dismissed.

 IMPOSTOR WARNER (OS CONT)-Colonel O'Neill. If you know where he is,...
 - IMPOSTOR WARNER (CONT)-take me to him. Otherwise, if you harm him or myself, your people will never be returned to you.
- 29.22.03 O'NEILL-We don't respond well to threats.
- 29.26.01 IMPOSTOR WARNER-Neither do we.
- 29.48.02 ALIEN/XE-LS-You... will... be... punished.
- 29.55.21 O'NEILL-Alright. Let's get him -- <u>it</u> -- back to the infirmary.
- 30.14.07 IMPOSTOR HAMMOND-It's alright, airmen. She's with me.
- 30.28.00 T'AKAYA-I have lost contact with Xe-ls.
 T'AKAYA (OS CONT)-Has Tonane been found?
- 30.32.12 ALIEN #1-Not yet.

- 30.35.13 T'AYAKA-Stay here in the form of the General. No one is to leave. I will find Xe-ls and Tonane. If we lose contact, destroy this place and return home with the others.
- 31.14.02 DANIEL-Anyway, like I was saying... this is, um, a storeroom...

DANIEL (OS CONT)-and the reason we,...

DANIEL (CONT)-we store things is so that we always have them on hand like, like this.

- 31.25.00 TONANE-Can I go home now?
- 31.26.21 DANIEL-Okay, Tonane. I, I won't lie to you. There is a problem. We have to find Jack.
- 31.31.14 TONANE-Okay. He's not in here.
- 31.36.00 DANIEL-Right.
- 31.43.14 O'NEILL-Is he gonna be alright?
- 31.45.07 CARTER-It's hard to say, sir. The only real sign will be when he has the strength to make us all disappear.
- 31.54.19 DANIEL-Jack?

- 31.55.20 O'NEILL-Daniel?
- 31.56.20 DANIEL-Are you you?
- 31.57.25 O'NEILL-Yeah? You?
- 31.59.11 DANIEL-What?
- 32.01.06 O'NEILL-Never mind. Tonane, we need to talk.
- 32.08.20 TONANE-Daniel says you have some problems. Maybe I should just go home.
- 32.11.09 O'NEILL-Uh, not just yet. Our people are disappearing all over the base, and it has something to do with you. Did you know Conner and SG-11 are really aliens?
- 32.25.11 TONANE-What are aliens?
- 32.28.08 O'NEILL-Come here. _(beat) <u>That</u> is an alien. It also happens to be one of your spirits.
- 32.42.20 CARTER-Probably Xe-ls.

- 32.46.02 TONANE-Xe-ls? Is that you? (beat) If he was, Jack, he'd probably answer.
- 32.58.16 TEAL'C-In the world of my origin, there were beings who pretended to be gods, so they could conquer my people and rule with fear. Perhaps that is the way of your spirits.
- 33.10.12 TONANE-I feel sorry for your people, Teal'c, but my spirits aren't evil. They don't rule us. They protect us.
- O'NEILL-Tonane... (beat) That is Xe-ls. And right now he's trying to conquer this base. Now, I want to kow why. More importantly, I want to know how to stop him.
- 33.33.27 TONANE-The spirits I know...

TONANE (OS CONT)-wouldn't threaten your people...

TONANE (CONT)-unless you were doing something to threaten mine. Are you, Jack? (beat) Because if you are, there's no way to stop them.

TONANE (OS CONT)-Xe-1s and T'akaya...

TONANE (CONT)-and the other spirits, they'll destroy you.

- 34.20.13 DANIEL-Okay. From what I overheard, they won't destroy the base until they've found Tonane.
- 34.25.04 TEAL'C-Clearly we must convince the aliens that we will make no further attempts to extract Trinium...

 TEAL'C (OS CONT)-from their world.
- O'NEILL-The fact is, we got caught plotting...

 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-behind closed doors. Now, I don't know how we're gonna convince 'em...
 - O'NEILL (CONT)-our word is good for squat. I mean, my God, we shot that one. We come across any more of 'em, I don't think it's gonna be a very long conversation.
- 34.44.09 DANIEL-Okay. Well, we can still appeal to the Elders.

 DANIEL (OS CONT)-Tell them what's happened.
- 34.52.14 O'NEILL-You mean fess up? (beat) Yeah, okay. You and Teal'c try to gate back and see if you can get 'em to speak to the spirits for us.
- 35.14.06 O'NEILL-Tonane, it's time for the truth.
- 35.30.10 DANIEL-No. Just let me try and talk to her first. Wait here.

35.45.23 DANIEL-T'akaya... Before you make me disappear...

DANIEL (OS CONT)-or bite me... Just...

DANIEL (CONT)-hear me out.

- 36.11.28 DANIEL-Wait wait wait wait! I know where Xe-ls is!
- 36.14.12 T'AKAYA-Where? Where is Xe-ls?
- 36.20.21 DANIEL-Do you promise to hear me out?
- 36.27.28 CARTER-Sir, it's possible he's still suffering the effects of the Zat gun.
- 36.31.15 O'NEILL-I don't think so, Captain. He just doesn't want to show himself.
- 36.43.16 DANIEL (OS)-Wait!

DANIEL (CONT)-No! Jack...

DANIEL (OS CONT)-it's okay. (beat) Just let them tend to Xe-ls.

- 36.56.11 O'NEILL-How do I know you're really Daniel?
- 37.01.04 DANIEL-Because...
- 37.04.12 O'NEILL-Yeah. Okay.

37.37.00 XE-LS-Thank you. (beat) T'akaya, destroy this place!

37.50.24 DANIEL-Wait! You promised to listen.

37.55.07 XE-LS-"What they don't know, won't hurt them."

XE-LS (OS CONT)-Isn't that what your leader said,
 Colonel?

XE-LS (CONT)-Their word means nothing.

38.03.04 T'AKAYA-And so would mine, if I were to do as you ask. I have made a promise to...

T'AKAYA (OS CONT)-this one...

T'AKAYA (CONT)-so that we could save your life.

38.16.16 XE-LS-I'm listening. But I do not guarantee...

XE-LS (OS CONT)-will sway me from punishing you.

38.22.13 O'NEILL-For what?

38.24.13 XE-LS-For trying to deceive the Salish, and steal our Ke.

XE-LS (OS CONT)-And for attempting to destroy the trust and faith between Tonane's...

XE-LS (CONT)-people and my own.

38.40.05 O'NEILL-Okay. I give you my word that we'll give up this mining operation.

- 38.51.07 T'AKAYA-Even if we could trust you, your superiors will not be swayed by your oath.
