00.10.01 DANIEL (OS)-When we found...

DANIEL (CONT)-Ernest Littlefield on PB2-908, we also
 discovered a repository of information.

00.15.00 O'NEILL-Meaning of life sort of stuff...

00.18.05 DANIEL (OS)-Yes. Based on the four distinct alien
 languages inscribed in the wall, we concluded it was
 some sort of...

DANIEL (CONT)-meeting place, where these four races would
 --

00.24.24 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-We all re-read the mission...

GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-reports, Dr. Jackson.

00.27.02 DANIEL-Okay. Right. Well, two days ago, the probe sent
 back this image from P3R-272.

DANIEL (OS CONT)-Now, if you look closely, you'll see
 that the symbols match one of the inscriptions from
 the meeting place on Ernest's planet.

DANIEL (CONT)-So you realize what this means.

- 00.50.23 GENERAL HAMMOND-Do you know what the circle of symbols says?
- 00.54.11 DANIEL-No. I don't, I don't even know what it sounds like. But based on the Norse Rune at the bottom of this inscription, I'm positive that one of the four races in the alliance...
- DANIEL (OS CONT)-is Thor's race, the Asguard.
- DANIEL (CONT)-Obviously, that would make the aliens that belong to this language their allies.
- 01.13.02 TEAL'C-I do believe this world is worth exploring, Daniel Jackson.
- 01.32.25 CARTER-Very strange. Breathable air... moderate temperature... Where's the life support coming from?
- 01.43.01 O'NEILL-Walls are solid.
- 01.47.16 TEAL'C-As the probe indicated, there appears to be no exit.
- 01.55.21 O'NEILL-Well... this was an intergalactic waste of time.

02.01.06 CARTER-Well, wait a minute, sir. Where's the power for
the lights coming from?

CARTER (OS CONT)-What's, what's the point of this place?

02.08.14 DANIEL (OS)-Hello?!

DANIEL (CONT)-Hello?! I'm Daniel Jackson! We're
peaceful explorers from the planet Earth. (beat)
It's worth a try.

02.22.16 O'NEILL-Daniel, how long you figure we ought to hang out
here and scratch our cosmic heads?

02.29.14 DANIEL-Well, we can't just give up.

02.32.00 O'NEILL-Why not? Let's go home. (beat) Okay. That's
something.

O'NEILL (OS CONT)-Watch yourself there, Teal'c.

03.04.07 DANIEL-What do you see?

03.05.26 TEAL'C-Blackness. Filled with colored lights.

03.33.27 CARTER-Colonel...?

03.37.11 DANIEL-Jack, can you hear me?

03.41.08 CARTER-His pulse is racing! Daniel, dial the gate!

04.58.10 DR. FRAISER (OS)-Pupils are back to normal.
DR. FRAISER (CONT)-Pulse is fine. You feel okay?

05.05.19 O'NEILL-Great. Don't remember a thing.

05.07.26 CARTER (OS)-You were catatonic for about an hour...
CARTER (CONT)-after that thing released your head.

05.11.22 DR. FRAISER (OS)-Physically I can't...
DR. FRAISER (CONT)-find anything wrong with you.

05.15.04 O'NEILL-Well... okey-dokey.

05.24.06 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-What caused this device to appear?

05.27.15 DANIEL-We're not sure.

05.28.22 TEAL'C-Colonel O'Neill passed through a circle on the
floor just before the device appeared. I was the
first to look into it.

05.34.16 GENERAL HAMMOND-What did you see?

- 05.35.14 O'NEILL-Lights. He saw lights. (beat) That's what he said he saw -- lights. We done?
- 05.45.13 GENERAL HAMMOND-Not exactly. Why didn't the device react to Teal'c the same way it did to you?
- 05.51.04 O'NEILL-I don't know.
- 05.52.22 TEAL'C-Perhaps because I am a Jaffa.
- 05.55.04 CARTER-We've seen alien technologies that have been sensitive to the presence of a Goa'uld before.
CARTER (OS CONT)-Like, uh, Thor's hammer.
- 06.00.28 O'NEILL-Teal'c looked. I looked. It grabbed my head. I passed out. I came to. We're here. We're home.
Can we go?
- 06.09.12 CARTER-Sir, are you okay?
- 06.13.05 O'NEILL-I'm fine. Just fine. Little tired, maybe.
- 06.20.03 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-Colonel,...
GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-are you sure you're okay?

06.25.10 O'NEILL-I am absolutely fine. There is nothing CRUVUS
with me. (beat) What?

06.39.18 DANIEL-You just said there's nothing CRUVUS with you.

06.43.12 O'NEILL-I did not.

06.44.19 DANIEL-Yes, you did.

06.46.27 O'NEILL-No, I didn't.

06.47.21 DANIEL-Yes, you did.

06.48.16 O'NEILL-Didn't.

06.49.05 DANIEL (OS)-Did.

06.49.26 O'NEILL (OS)-Didn't.

06.50.06 DANIEL-Did.

06.50.28 O'NEILL-CRUVUS -- what is that?

06.52.22 DANIEL-I don't know. (beat) Well, I'm guessing in the
context of what you're saying that you were trying
to say there was nothing wrong with you.

- 07.02.07 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-Why don't you take some time to relax, Colonel.
- GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-You're dismissed.
- GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-But do me a favor and stay on the base.
- GENERAL HAMMOND-Keep an eye on him.
- 07.35.13 TEAL'C (OS)-What is the reason for these padded gloves, O'Neill?
- 07.40.08 O'NEILL-So we don't hurt each other. I'll be honest with you, Teal'c; It's so that you don't hurt me.
- 07.47.20 TEAL'C-If our purpose is not to cause each other harm, why then are we doing battle?
- 07.52.10 O'NEILL-What can I tell you? It's boxing. It's fun. C'mon... (beat) Come on, Teal'c. You gotta move around a little bit. You gotta dance.
- 08.06.00 TEAL'C-I do not understand, O'Neill. Are we preparing to dance or to do battle?
- 08.12.00 O'NEILL-Teal'c, if you don't move around, you're a sitting duck. You're a target. Huh? Like that. (beat) I'm sorry. You all right?

08.27.04 TEAL'C-I am fine.

08.28.12 O'NEILL-Well, that's why you gotta move --

08.34.07 TEAL'C-How was that, O'Neill?

08.36.07 O'NEILL-It was good. That was good. Uh... The thing
 about keeping your hands up... Is my nose bleeding?

08.43.20 TEAL'C (OS)-You're fine.

08.45.24 O'NEILL-Keep your hands up... Gotta keep your, your feet
 movin'... and, uh bend your COZARS, keep your COZARS
 bent...

08.53.16 TEAL'C-I am unfamiliar with that word.

08.56.26 O'NEILL-What? COZARS? COZARS. You gotta bend your
 COZARS.

09.04.14 TEAL'C-I believe you are referring to your legs, O'Neill.

09.25.14 O'NEILL-All right. What the hell is going on with me?

09.31.13 DANIEL-What do you mean?

- 09.32.14 O'NEILL-Well, apparently, I have lost the FALLATUS to speak properly. (beat) That wasn't a joke. I didn't do that on purpose.
- 09.42.25 TEAL'C-Several times now, Colonel O'Neill has used strange words in place of common terms.
- 09.48.28 DANIEL-Okay. Wh-what was that...
DANIEL (OS CONT)-word you just used?
- 09.52.06 TEAL'C (OS)-I believe it...
TEAL'C (CONT)-was fallatus.
- 09.55.07 DANIEL-Okay. That sounds kind of close to medieval Latin. So... possibly a derivation, possibly even a root. (beat) Faculatus is Latin for ability. You said you lost the fallatus to speak to speak properly.
- 10.18.21 O'NEILL-NOO ANI ANQUEETAS.
- 10.23.05 DANIEL-What?
- 10.26.23 O'NEILL-NOO ANI ANQUEETAS. HIC QUA VIDEEM.
- 10.37.25 DANIEL-Jack, a-are you reading this?

- 10.39.21 O'NEILL-I don't know. You tell me.
- 10.41.24 DANIEL (OS)-Well, I-I don't know. I haven't even...
DANIEL (CONT)-been able to associate the sounds with the
symbols. Do you know what this means?
- 10.47.03 O'NEILL-No!! I was just lookin' at it, and the words
popped right into my FRON. Does anybody think this
is odd?
- 11.05.00 DANIEL-The language he's speaking has similar sounds to
medieval Latin, but it's still quite different.
- 11.08.24 CARTER-So he's in the infirmary now?
- 11.09.28 DANIEL-Yes, but before we took him there, he just picked
up a piece of chalk and did this in about thirty
seconds flat.
DANIEL (OS CONT)-Do you have any idea what this means?
- 11.20.08 CARTER-No. I mean, even the simple equations don't make
any sense. No, this is like no math I've ever seen.

- 11.30.13 DR. FRAISER (OS)-A normal human brain operates at about five to...
- DR. FRAISER (CONT)-ten percent of its functional capacity at any given time.
- DR. FRAISER (OS CONT)-Colonel O'Neill's brain is operating at over ninety percent capacity.
- 11.41.22 CARTER-Well, how is that possible?
- 11.42.26 DR. FRAISER-I don't know.
- 11.46.02 TEAL'C-Where is Colonel O'Neill?
- 11.48.10 DR. FRAISER-Well, he should be in the infirmary.
- 11.49.28 TEAL'C-He is not there.
- 11.54.06 CARTER-Teal'c, you take the gate room.
- 11.55.17 DANIEL-I'll check the locker room.
- 11.56.09 CARTER-Right.
- 12.01.03 CARTER-Colonel... What are you doing?
- 12.08.05 O'NEILL-I need this.

- 12.10.27 CARTER-What for?
- 12.19.17 O'NEILL-I have no idea.
- 12.24.00 GENERAL HAMMOND-Where is he now?
- 12.24.26 CARTER-He's with Teal'c.
- 12.26.22 GENERAL HAMMOND-Do you think his current condition poses
any threat?
- 12.29.04 DR. FRAISER-Sir, I don't even know what's wrong with him.
All I can tell you is that his brain function has
increased ten-fold.
- 12.34.24 DANIEL-Jack was able to read the alien language. Both
the inscription from the wall of the meeting place
on Ernest's planet, and the circle of symbols from
272 where this happened to him.
- 12.43.22 GENERAL HAMMOND-What does it mean?
- 12.46.24 DANIEL-Well, my translation's a little bit vague. Uh, I
think the circle means "the place of our legacy".
(beat) Or it could be "a piece of our leg". But
the first seems to make more sense.

- 13.00.18 CARTER-The point is, Colonel O'Neill is unwillingly speaking an alien language.
- 13.04.15 DANIEL (OS)-We know the Asguard oppose the Goa'uld, so it's possible...
DANIEL (CONT)-all the members of this four-race alliance felt the same.
- 13.10.12 CARTER-Which might explain why the viewer locked out Teal'c.
- 13.12.05 GENERAL HAMMOND-What are you saying?
- 13.13.14 DANIEL-What if this device somehow downloaded an alien language into Jack's brain?
- 13.19.01 TEAL'C-Your presence is required in the control room.
- 13.26.19 GENERAL HAMMOND-What's he doing?
- 13.27.17 TEAL'C-I do not know.
- 13.38.09 CARTER-The main system's down, sir. I'm locked out.
- 13.41.07 GENERAL HAMMOND-Colonel?

13.41.27 O'NEILL-Yes, sir?

13.42.25 GENERAL HAMMOND-What are you doing?

13.43.26 O'NEILL-I don't know, sir. You know me and computers.

13.48.03 GENERAL HAMMOND-Colonel, I'm ordering you to stop.

13.50.06 O'NEILL-I'd love to, sir, but I can't.

13.53.02 GENERAL HAMMOND-Stop him.

13.54.10 O'NEILL-No. Not, not yet!
O'NEILL (OS CONT)-I'm not FARGUS!

13.56.16 DANIEL-Sir, I think he wants to finish...
DANIEL (OS CONT)-what he's doing.

14.00.10 CARTER-I can't reboot, sir. (beat) Uh oh.

14.04.23 GENERAL HAMMOND-Captain...?

14.07.14 CARTER (OS)-Sir, this is machine code.
 CARTER (CONT)-The numbers the Colonel was entering must
 have been some sort of program. (beat) What did
 you do?
 CARTER (OS CONT)-It's a destination map.
 CARTER (CONT)-These are all the Stargates we've been to.

14.27.26 DANIEL-Sam... are those new Gates popping up?

14.34.00 CARTER-It's not possible. It-it takes days to
 calculate...
 CARTER (OS CONT)-the planetary shift of each new
 location.
 CARTER (CONT)-Well, wait a second.

14.48.26 SCREEN READS:
 NO MATCH

14.52.08 CARTER-Sir... The new Stargates did not come from the
 Abydos...
 CARTER (OS CONT)-Cartouche data that we put in.

14.58.06 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-But that's the only reference we
 have, isn't it?

- 15.01.06 CARTER-The Colonel must've input new Stargate locations into the computer.
- 15.04.06 DANIEL-Well, I guess that thing must've put more than just a language into your brain. (beat) That circular inscription read "The place of our Legacy."
DANIEL (OS CONT)-What if that thing...
DANIEL (CONT)-you looked into was some sort of alien database...
DANIEL (OS CONT)-like the one we found on Ernest's planet?
DANIEL (CONT)-All the knowledge that these particular aliens possessed.
- 15.27.01 GENERAL HAMMOND-Colonel...
GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-You're not under arrest. But you're also not to touch anything else on this base without permission. Understood?
- 15.39.00 O'NEILL-EETIUM, sir.
- 15.46.11 CARTER (OS)-Well, you can only stare at a computer screen for so long.
CARTER (CONT)-Colonel, that program you entered rewrote massive amounts of the machine code.

- 15.56.08 DANIEL (OS)-Jack seems to have...
DANIEL (CONT)-completely lost the ability to speak
anything but the alien language.
- 16.00.18 CARTER-Really? Wow.
- 16.04.27 DANIEL-But the good news is we seem to have more of the
alien inscription translated. Noo ani aqueetas. We
are the Ancients.
- 16.13.13 CARTER-Who are the Ancients?
- 16.15.15 DANIEL-Well, I think they could be the teachers of roads.
(beat) See, the Romans were the first real road
builders. They spoke Latin, and they learned to
build roads from gods known as the Ancient ones.
- 16.26.04 CARTER-I'm still not following you.
- 16.27.16 DANIEL-Roads. Stargates.
DANIEL (OS CONT)-The gate builders.
DANIEL (CONT)-What if these Ancients were the alien race
who invented the Stargate?
- 16.39.08 CARTER-You're still just speculating, right?

- 16.41.06 DANIEL-Well, that would certainly explain why Jack knew about Stargates the Goa'uld haven't even discovered yet.
- 16.46.09 CARTER-I don't know, Daniel. Why would they invent a device that would do this?
- 16.50.11 DANIEL-"The place of our Legacy". To pass on their knowledge.
DANIEL (OS CONT)-Jack may have knowledge of the original gate builders...
DANIEL (CONT)-downloaded into his brain.
- 16.58.04 O'NEILL-EEGO INDEEO NAVO LOCHUS.
- 17.02.12 DANIEL-Okay. Ego means "I".
- 17.07.22 O'NEILL-INDEEO.
- 17.08.28 DANIEL-Need.
- 17.10.03 O'NEILL-NAVO.
- 17.10.28 DANIEL-New.
- 17.12.00 O'NEILL-LOCHUS.

- 17.13.14 DANIEL-Lochus.
DANIEL (OS CONT)-Lochus, lochus...
DANIEL (CONT)-Locatia, location, you need a new location!
You need a new location!
- 17.25.28 CARTER-Where do you want to go? (beat) Okay. Good
luck, you guys. I have to get back to the computer.
Sir, I really wish you could explain this.
(reading) Ten equals eight. Ten equals eight...
Ten equals eight. Sir, this is base eight math.
- 18.07.17 DR. FRAISER (OS)-The problem may only be...
DR. FRAISER (CONT)-affecting the verbal language center
of your brain. It's a different function than
writing.
DR. FRAISER (OS CONT)-But it looks like the problem is
advancing.
DR. FRAISER (CONT)-Since you lost the ability to speak
gradually, I think whatever's affected them may be
taking over incrementally.
- 18.22.08 DANIEL-Well, what's the worst case scenario?

- 18.24.23 DR. FRAISER-Well, your computer analogy's pretty good.
Colonel, your hard...
- DR. FRAISER (OS CONT)-drive has been filled with
information that has been written in a language your
computer doesn't understand.
- DR. FRAISER (CONT)-If it continues to progress the way it
has thus far, you may eventually lose the ability to
write or even comprehend us. Or worse, the computer
could shut down altogether.
- 18.52.15 CARTER-Sir, we've been sending probes to the addresses
Colonel O'Neill entered into the computer, hoping
that one would lead us to the race that affected his
mind.
- CARTER (OS CONT)-And we think we may have found
something.
- 19.02.04 DANIEL-P9Q-281 has a pedestal near the gate with symbols
on it that match the alien language that Jack is
speaking.
- 19.08.03 GENERAL HAMMOND-Then I suggest we check it out. You're
authorized to go, Captain. (beat) Major Castleman
will be...
- GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-joining SG-1 on this mission.

19.18.19 DANIEL-Well, if Jack's not going, then I have to stay.

19.20.27 GENERAL HAMMOND-Why is that, Doctor?

19.22.17 DANIEL-Well, if Sam and Teal'c make contact with the Ancients and they can report back and, and, then Jack and I will go, but until then, I mean, translating this language may be...

DANIEL (OS CONT)-the most important thing we've done since we opened the Stargate. (beat) You see, I'm pretty sure that Jack is speaking...

DANIEL (CONT)-the language of the original gate builders. At the very least, I'm positive that it's one of the races who created the repository of information on Ernest's planet -- the, uh, meaning of life stuff...

19.49.23 CARTER-And, sir, I believe that the equation Colonel O'Neill wrote on the blackboard is a revolutionary formula for...

CARTER (OS CONT)-calculating the distance between planetary bodies.

19.57.05 DANIEL (OS)-And the bottom line, sir... What about Jack?
I mean,...

DANIEL (CONT)-right now I'm possibly his only hope for
communicating on any kind of serious level. I can't
leave him like this, and I won't.

20.09.10 GENERAL HAMMOND-All right. The rest of you will leave at
1600 hours.

20.17.25 GENERAL HAMMOND (ON INTERCOM FILTERED)-SG-1, your mission
is a go.

20.41.12 DANIEL-Okay. I think we're getting hung up on the
grammar.

21.05.00 SCREEN READS:
I HAVE TO GO THROUGH
THE STARGATE!

21.10.02 DANIEL (OS)-Okay. You have to go through the Stargate.
Where?
DANIEL (CONT)-Where to?
DANIEL (OS CONT)-Back to the planet where this happened?
DANIEL (CONT)-You have to go back there?

21.22.24 GENERAL HAMMOND-Come!

21.24.19 SIMMONS-Sir? SG-1 did not return the probe on schedule.

21.27.26 GENERAL HAMMOND-Let's open the Gate and try to make
contact.

21.29.28 SIMMONS-Yes, sir.

21.35.22 SIMMONS (INTO HEADPHONE)-SG-1, this is Stargate Command.
Do you read? Over. (TO HAMMOND) They're
responding, sir. Video and audio.

21.46.08 CARTER (ON MONITOR FILTERED)-Do not send rescue team.
Repeat, do not send rescue team.

21.51.21 GENERAL HAMMOND-This is General Hammond. We copy,
Captain. Where is Major Castleman?

- 21.56.00 CARTER (ON MONITOR FILTERED)-He's looking for shelter, sir. We're in a little trouble here. We can't dial out. The DHD seized up...
- CARTER (OS CONT ON MONITOR FILTERED)-when we tried to send the probe back.
- CARTER (CONT ON MONITOR FILTERED)-The temperature here is increasing rapidly, which probably explains why we haven't found any indigenous life forms. The probe's data did not reveal a second sun, which rose about a half an hour ago.
- CARTER (OS CONT ON MONITOR FILTERED)-General, we're gonna get one heck of a sunburn if we stay here much longer.
- 22.21.05 GENERAL HAMMOND-Can you dial in manually?
- 22.23.13 CARTER (ON MONITOR FILTERED)-Teal'c's attempting a manual dial now, sir, but we can't do it with the wormhole open from your end.
- 22.28.20 GENERAL HAMMOND-I copy that, Captain. If you're not back in one hour, we will open the wormhole again for further communication. Good luck.
- GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-SGC out.
- 22.51.18 DANIEL-What's he doing now?

22.53.03 DR. FRAISER-Building something. I've been taking notes,
but I'm finding it a little hard to follow.

23.06.07 DANIEL-I have to go downstairs. Sam and Teal'c are in
trouble.

23.08.06 DR. FRAISER-What?

23.10.01 DANIEL-Just don't tell Jack.
DANIEL (OS CONT)-I think he's got enough on his mind.

23.26.14 EXPERT ONE-Sir, this Mylar material added to a standard-
issue field tent should provide ten to twenty
degrees worth of protection.

23.31.27 SILER-We've augmented some air coolers to work with
portable generators.

23.35.04 DANIEL-But how are they gonna get home?

23.37.01 EXPERT ONE (OS)-Well, based on Captain Carter's
description of the...
EXPERT ONE (CONT)-problem, we've been running probability
tests using the function data...
EXPERT ONE (OS CONT)-we correlated so far from the DHD
found in Antarctica.

23.47.01 GENERAL HAMMOND-Do you understand what he said?

23.48.17 DANIEL-It sounds like they have no idea.

23.50.21 EXPERT ONE-Well, actually, it's not no idea sir... just
not much of one yet.

23.54.03 SILER-But we're working on it.

23.59.22 CARTER (ON MONITOR FILTERED)-Manual dial in failed, sir.
CARTER (OS CONT ON MONITOR FILTERED)-DHD is stuck mid-
dial, and...
CARTER (CONT ON MONITOR FILTERED)-seems to be locking the
Gate in place.

24.06.25 DANIEL-Are we recording this?

24.07.28 SIMMONS-Yes, sir.

24.08.07 CARTER (OS ON MONITOR FILTERED) (overlapping)-By my
calculations, we could be facing a temperature of
over 200 degrees fahrenheit in less than four hours.

24.15.16 GENERAL HAMMOND-Captain, we're sending through a package
of heat-resistant tents and portable air coolers.

- 24.20.26 CARTER (ON MONITOR FILTERED)-General, I don't think you understand how hot it's gonna get. Nothing you send us will provide enough protection. We'll be dead before the end of the day, sir.
- 24.50.28 DR. FRAISER-I think he's finished.
- 24.55.03 DANIEL-What is it? (beat) That's it? (beat) Okay... Well, let's, let's just leave this thing for now. Believe it or not, I have something a little more important to discuss.
- 25.29.00 DANIEL-I didn't want to tell you this before, because I thought you had enough on your mind. Sam, Teal'c, and the rest of SG-1 are in trouble. The DHD on P9Q-281 isn't working, and they can't get home. To make matters worse, there is a very hot sun rising. They don't have much time.
- 25.47.11 CARTER (OS ON MONITOR FILTERED)-The rest of the symbols won't engage. The DHD...
CARTER (CONT ON MONITOR FILTERED)-is locking the gate in place so we can't dial in manually.
CARTER (OS CONT ON MONITOR FILTERED)-I've tried everything I know about these things.

26.03.00 DANIEL-Look, no one else believes that you have the knowledge of the original gate builders in your head right now except me.

26.36.28 DR. FRAISER-What, what's he doing?

26.38.01 DANIEL-I don't know.

26.40.06 DR. FRAISER-Well, do you think this is going to help?

26.41.22 DANIEL-I, I don't... I really don't know. (reads) "Shut up and go away..."

27.04.25 SILER (OS)-The problem we're having is powering out the DHD and getting it to recharge it's capacitors.

27.08.25 EXPERT ONE (OS)-Removing the power source and reinstalling...
EXPERT ONE (CONT)-always rebooted the system in the tests.

27.13.13 SILER-But we never simulated a mid-dial lock-up.

27.14.27 DANIEL-We have to dial in right now.

27.16.02 GENERAL HAMMOND-What is it?

27.16.26 DR. FRAISER-The Colonel has a solution.
