CARTER (OS CONT)-For some reason...

- CARTER (CONT)-the warping of our space/time seems to be an advance of the gravitational field, rather than as a result of it. It's probably a lensing effect, generated by the Stargate itself, but I can't be sure.

CARTER (OS CONT)-beyond the gate room.

- 24.41.20 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-I just came from there myself,...
 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-Captain. Colonel Cromwell, I
 believe.
- 24.46.08 CROMWELL-General Hammond.
- 24.48.09 O'NEILL-You just came from Washington, sir?

- 24.50.01 GENERAL HAMMOND-There and back again. After someone upstairs managed to explain...
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-what was going on to me, we called an all-night session with the President and the Joint Chiefs.
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-I've been gone nearly eighteen hours.
- 25.03.03 O'NEILL-I thought you were on the phone.
- 25.05.17 CARTER-That means the time dilation is getting worse as the field expands.
- 25.08.15 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-That's the consensus. We've set up a command post...
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-directly above, right on top of the mountain, to monitor the expansion.
- 25.15.01 CARTER-Well, I have to get up there.
- 25.16.24 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-The experts we consulted believe we're going to...
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-have to commence an autodestruct sequence to destroy the Stargate itself.
- 25.23.12 O'NEILL-Sweet...

- 25.24.19 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-They assure me that the gravity field now...
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-present around the gate will help to contain the blast within the mountain, and pose no threat to the civilian population.
- 25.34.12 CARTER-With all due respect, sir, I don't think so.
- 25.37.04 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-If we don't...

 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-try, we lose the planet. Right through that...
- 25.42.12 CARTER-We may well succeed in destroying the base, sir, but leave the gate and the wormhole intact. What happens to the planet then?
- 25.48.20 GENERAL HAMMOND-Orders have been given at the highest level, Captain. It is our duty to carry out those orders.
- 25.53.09 CARTER-But, sir...

- 25.54.05 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-The decision has been made, Captain.

 Don't...
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-forget, those people up there have been working on this a lot longer than you have.

 It's what they came up with.
- 26.01.08 CARTER-Yes, sir.
- 26.02.17 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-I'm ordering the complete evacuation of the SGC, effective as of...
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-right now. I'll need two volunteers to stay behind in order to give our personnel a head start.
- 26.12.07 O'NEILL-I'll stay, sir.
- 26.13.10 CROMWELL-Me too, sir.
- 26.17.25 O'NEILL-Anyone else?
- 26.22.01 CROMWELL-Looks like you're stuck with me, Jack.

- 26.25.14 GENERAL HAMMOND-Done. It takes two officers to initiate the countdown. (INTO MIC FILTERED) Attention!

 This is General Hammond. All personnel are ordered to evacuate this...
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT INTO MIC FILTERED)-facility immediately.
 - GENERAL HAMMOND (VO CONT OVER INTERCOM FILTERED) Repeat... All personnel report to the main level
 immediately. That is all.
- DR. FRAISER-Okay... Let's do this. On my count... three, two, one! Easy. Watch his chest. Move him out.

 Let's go.
- 27.00.03 GENERAL HAMMOND-Wait five minutes, then start the countdown. Good luck.
- 27.03.17 O'NEILL-Thank you, sir.
- 27.04.12 CARTER-Make sure you give yourself enough time to get out, sir.
- 27.07.28 O'NEILL-Time... right.
- 27.28.11 SF (OS)-Stand by.

- 27.30.05 SOLDIER (OS)-Yes, sir.
- 27.30.26 SF (OS)-General...
 - SF (CONT)-We were getting worried.
- 27.33.16 GENERAL HAMMOND-How long have I been gone?
- 27.34.22 SF-Twenty two hours, sir. General Cohen's waiting for you in the command post.
- 27.37.17 GENERAL HAMMOND-Thank you, Sergeant. (TO CARTER) By my reckoning, I was gone twenty minutes.
- 27.41.06 CARTER-Well, sir, accounting for time spent coming and going, I would guess time within the SGC facility has slowed to an everage of about 600 percent below normal. When you ordered Colonel O'Neill to wait five minutes, you were really telling him to wait six hours, maybe more.
- 27.55.05 GENERAL HAMMOND-Captain, relativity gives me a headache.
- 28.06.07 CROMWELL-Who's this?

- 28.08.07 O'NEILL-Henry Boyd.
 - O'NEILL (OS CONT)-A good officer. Smart. (beat) Kind of reminds me of Carter a little. This was their mission as a team.
- 28.24.07 CROMWELL-He looks scared to death.
- 28.26.16 O'NEILL-He's on a planet that's about to be swallowed up by a black hole. And he knows it.
- 28.44.18 CARTER-Thank you. (beat) Uh... no. Thank you.
- 29.04.07 TEAL'C-Perhaps with rest the answers will come.
- 29.06.10 CARTER-Hey, Teal'c. You know anything about quantum gravity?
- 29.15.08 TEAL'C-Nothing.
- 29.17.16 CARTER-Apparently, neither do I.
- 29.21.04 TEAL'C (OS)-What do these equations represent?
- 29.22.24 CARTER (OS)-Probably a life's work.

 CARTER (CONT)-I don't have that much time, unfortunately.

- 29.35.27 TEAL'C-How may I be of assistance?
- 29.40.23 CARTER-We're experiencing a time dilation in a radius...

 CARTER (OS CONT)-wider than the gate room itself.

 CARTER (CONT)-Most of the SGC, in fact, and it's expanding...
 - CARTER (OS CONT)-But it's all happening in advance of the gravity field that's causing it.
 - CARTER (CONT)-Now, according to everything I thought I knew about relativity, that is just not possible.
- 29.57.19 TEAL'C-Yet it is so.
- 29.58.20 CARTER (OS)-Right.
 - CARTER (CONT)-If it wasn't, we'd all be pulled apart by now. You know, they're proceeding with a plan that makes assumptions about gravity and space/time with absolutely no regard for the fact that it completely contradicts our observations.
- 30.15.01 TEAL'C-I see.
- 30.16.16 CARTER-in other words, Teal'c, they don't really know what the hell is going on, so they're just gonna blow it up. (beat) There doesn't seem to be a damn thing we can do about it.

- 30.36.19 O'NEILL-Let's get set up. (beat) The computer needs your authorization code before it'll accept the command. Go ahead and enter it.
- 30.58.02 CROMWELL-Maybe now you know how it feels.
- 31.01.10 O'NEILL-You done?
- 31.04.09 CROMWELL-Roger that.
- 31.06.02 O'NEILL-When the time comes, hit the enter key on my mark, and then run like hell.
- 31.15.02 CROMWELL-Got it.
- 31.22.25 O'NEILL-Two minutes.
- 31.37.14 CARTER-The gravity field extends to the blast doors of the control room now, sir. That's not good.
- 31.42.12 GENERAL HAMMOND-I take it you still believe our plan isn't going to work.

- 31.47.07 CARTER-To be honest, sir, I'm afraid that the gravity field will dampen the effects of the explosion.
 - CARTER (OS CONT)-We'll lose the SGC, but the wormhole will be intact.
 - CARTER (CONT)-What's left of the mountain will collapse into the wormhole, and six months after that the state of Colorado... Six months after that... At least Daniel will live out there...
- 32.06.09 GENERAL HAMMOND-If you're wrong -- and for once I hope you are -- we can restart the SGC with the second Stargate at Nellis, and in time, we --
- 32.12.19 CARTER-Wait a minute.

CARTER (OS CONT)-Sir, that's it.

- CARTER (CONT)-We <u>do</u> use a bomb. But we focus the energy of the blast.
- CARTER (OS CONT)-When Colonel O'Neill and I were sent to the...
- CARTER (CONT)-Antarctic gate, it was because we were under enemy fire.
- 32.26.20 GENERAL HAMMOND-It caused an energy surge.

- 32.28.07 CARTER-Yes, and that surge caused the wormhole to jump from one destination to another. (beat) If we can channel enough energy in the direction of our Stargate, it should cut the connection to the black hole, and cause the matter stream to jump to any gate along the way.
- 32.14.03 GENERAL HAMMOND-Leaving our Stargate connected to some other world?
- 32.46.27 CARTER-Yes, sir. But then all we have to do is shut it down.

CARTER (OS CONT)-Sir, we have to stop...

CARTER (CONT)-Colonel O'Neill.

- 33.03.15 O'NEILL-One minute...
- 33.10.13 CROMWELL-Maybe the last one. (beat) We used to be friends, Jack.
- 33.28.07 O'NEILL-Yep.
- 33.30.01 CROMWELL (OS)-I was sick to my stomach when I found out you were still alive.

 CROMWELL (CONT)-I wanted to go back for you.

- 33.37.27 O'NEILL-Why don't we just do this and get the hell out of here, all right?
- CROMWELL-Somebody dropped a dime on the incursion.

 CROMWELL (OS CONT)-You got hit. You went down.

 CROMWELL (CONT)-I made a judgement call to save the rest of the team...
- 33.47.25 O'NEILL-And I saw you take off. And then I saw four months of my life disappear in some stinkin' Iraqi prison!
- 33.54.16 CROMWELL-I thought you were dead!
- 33.55.18 O'NEILL-You thought wrong!! (beat) What do you want?!

 You want me to forgive you?! Is that it?!
- 34.07.15 CROMWELL-Yeah. I guess I do.
- 34.12.15 O'NEILL-Well, that's tough. What happened to "Nobody gets left behind"?
- 34.17.22 CROMWELL-Well, what about him?
- 34.21.02 O'NEILL-That is a totally different scenario.

- 34.23.04 CROMWELL-That is the same damn thing, Jack!
- 34.40.08 CARTER-Don't activate the autodestruct, sir. It won't work. I have another idea...
- 35.03.15 CARTER-The G suits should help you withstand the higher gravity on the way down.
- 35.08.02 CROMWELL-What's this bomb we're delivering?
- CARTER-It's a shaped charge. We want to focus the explosive force toward the wormhole, hopefully with enough energy to cause it to jump. Like what happened to us in Antarctica.

- 35.18.15 CROMWELL-Where is it?

 SILER (OS CONT)-I don't know how much longer that Iris...

 SILER (CONT)-is gonna hold.
- 35.40.22 CARTER-We have to wait for the bomb.
- 35.54.12 O'NEILL-You got better quick.
- 35.56.05 TEAL'C-It has in fact been several days.
- 35.59.00 O'NEILL-Yeah. I knew that.

- 36.14.05 TEAL'C-Cannot the bomb be detonated by remote?
