03.31.02 MA'CHELLO-Yes. Yes, that's right. I am Daniel Jackson  
from the planet Earth. Pleased to meet you.

03.45.08 DANIEL-No. I'm, I'm, I'm Daniel Jackson.

03.47.27 MA'CHELLO-No. I'm Daniel Jackson.

03.53.11 CARTER-Uh, these are very interesting machines.  
CARTER (OS CONT)-Are they inventions to fight the  
Goa'uld?

04.00.00 MA'CHELLO (OS)-Yes! Inventions..  
MA'CHELLO (CONT)-...to fight the Goa'uld!

04.04.24 DANIEL-Well, do you, do you, do you think that you could  
show us how they work?

04.13.10 MA'CHELLO-Are we sure we are not Goa'uld? (beat) You!  
You! You! Here... quickly! Inventions to fight  
the Goa'uld!

04.49.16 CARTER-Daniel...?

04.51.26 DANIEL-I'm fine. I think. (beat) Are you all right,  
sir?

05.08.02 CARTER-He's got a faint pulse.

05.09.21 O'NEILL-All right, Carter, why don't you dial us out of  
here. Teal'c...

O'NEILL (OS CONT)-Grab the gentleman.

O'NEILL (CONT)-Let's take him back to the base.

05.16.28 CARTER-Yes, sir.

06.28.14 DR. FRAISER-Well, everything seems fine. Yep. All your  
numbers are normal.

06.35.05 DANIEL (OS)-Good.

DANIEL (CONT)-I feel fine.

06.37.24 DR. FRAISER-Yeah? You just, you seem a little out of it,  
Daniel. Is there something bothering you?

06.42.11 DANIEL-No. I'm just... exhausted.

06.48.03 DR. FRAISER-Well, that's not unusual for someone who just received a high voltage electric shock. Any idea what that machine was supposed to do? (beat) Okay. Well, if you're not back to normal in a couple of days, you let me know. (beat) Uh, wait a minute... I don't want you driving for a couple of days.

07.09.13 DANIEL-All right.

07.10.12 DR. FRAISER-Okay...

07.19.25 DANIEL-How is he?

07.22.07 DR. FRAISER-Not good. He has severe scar tissue all over his body. Looks like he was burned or electrocuted. My guess is he was tortured.

07.37.01 DANIEL-He's not gonna live much longer, is he?

07.40.08 DR. FRAISER-I don't think so.

07.46.00 GENERAL HAMMOND-Let's continue without Dr. Jackson.  
Captain Carter, you were about to brief us about the device...

07.51.00 CARTER-Yes, sir. I believe it's some sort of database for all of Ma'chello's inventions. These symbols are like icons on a computer. When I press one of them,...

CARTER (OS CONT)-a schematic diagram appears with notes on the side.

08.03.15 GENERAL HAMMOND-Any idea what any of it is?

08.05.25 CARTER-Well, sir, that's the problem. It's not in any dialect...

CARTER (OS CONT)-...that I understand. I was hoping that Daniel or...

CARTER (CONT)-...maybe Teal'c could shed some light on these symbols.

08.31.03 DANIEL (OS)-I apologize.

08.39.00 GENERAL HAMMOND-How are you, Dr. Jackson?

08.41.23 DANIEL-Tired. Dr. Fraiser says it'll wear off in a few days. (beat) I'll be fine.

08.48.11 CARTER-Daniel, do you recognize...  
CARTER (OS CONT)-...any of these symbols?

08.55.07 DANIEL-No.

09.00.05 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-Keep trying, people. This could be  
some valuable...  
GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-...technology. Dismissed.

09.04.28 DANIEL (OS)-General?  
DANIEL (CONT)-Dr. Fraiser thought I should go home...  
DANIEL (OS CONT)-...and get some rest.

09.12.02 GENERAL HAMMOND-Take a day.

09.14.12 DANIEL-Thank you.

09.27.22 DANIEL-Thank you. I'll be fine from here.

09.29.15 DRIVER (OS)-Yes, sir.

09.58.00 O'NEILL-You called, sir?

09.59.19 MA'CHELLO (OS)-Jack, Sam, Tealc...  
MA'CHELLO (CONT)-Finally...

10.33.19 DR. FRAISER-He, uh, knows a lot about Daniel.

10.36.16 MA'CHELLO (OS)-Ask me anything.  
MA'CHELLO (CONT)-Something only Daniel would know.

10.43.00 CARTER-Okay. Who's Cassandra?

10.46.15 MA'CHELLO-She's a 12-year-old girl we found abandoned on  
P8X-987.

10.57.03 O'NEILL-P8X...

10.58.09 CARTER-...987. Yeah.

11.01.23 O'NEILL-All right. Lucky guess.

11.04.20 GENERAL HAMMOND-Where was the Stargate found?

11.07.07 MA'CHELLO-At a dig in Giza.

11.11.07 O'NEILL (OS)-All right...  
O'NEILL (CONT)-Describe for me the dress your sister wore  
last week when I took her out.

11.20.07 MA'CHELLO-I don't have a sister, Jack. And if I did, I  
wouldn't let you near her.

11.30.19 GENERAL HAMMOND-Okay. Let's assume for a moment that you  
are Daniel Jackson. Then who the hell did we just  
send home?

11.45.03 DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-Hello, friend! I'm new to this area.  
I would like to learn about your culture and  
customs. Will you teach me? Can you not understand  
me?

11.56.27 FRED-Spare any change, please?

11.58.11 DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-Why does no one answer me?

12.01.23 FRED-'Cause you're strange.

12.07.08 DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-Am I? Tell me how I am strange.

12.12.13 FRED-Man, you can't be just walking up to people you  
don't know on the street and talkin' all weird like  
that, askin' for stuff.

12.21.11 DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-Isn't that what you were doing?

12.23.03 FRED-Well... Yeah, but...

12.25.26 DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-Then you must be strange as well.

12.29.13 FRED-I've been called worse. Sure. I'm strange, too.

12.33.23 DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-I am called...  
DANIEL (MA'CHELLO) (OS CONT)-...Ma'chello.

12.35.25 FRED-I'm Fred.

12.41.17 DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-Let us feast together, Fred, and  
celebrate our strangeness and newfound friendship.

12.48.19 FRED-On you?

12.50.11 DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-If that is the custom. We will  
feast... on me.

12.55.25 GENERAL HAMMOND-Dr. Fraiser...

12.57.12 DR. FRAISER-Well, sir, medically speaking, he's an elderly gentleman suffering...

DR. FRAISER (OS CONT)-...from acute pulmonary damage, with the conscious awareness and memory of Dr. Daniel Jackson.

13.07.03 GENERAL HAMMOND-How?

13.08.00 DR. FRAISER-Well, I can't tell you the method used to do it, General, but I can tell you that our personality, our memory, our conscious selves, are derived from unique networks of neurons in the cerebral cortex. Somehow, Daniel's...

DR. FRAISER (OS CONT)-...networks were remapped onto the old man's by that alien device.

13.23.14 O'NEILL-So this could be a one-way deal, right?

13.26.01 DR. FRAISER-I'm not following you, sir.

13.27.11 O'NEILL-We don't know that it went both ways. Daniel could still be Daniel.

13.32.19 GENERAL HAMMOND-His doorman said he never came into the building after he was dropped off.

13.36.13 O'NEILL-There you go. Let's find him.

13.38.07 CARTER-And what if he isn't Daniel?

13.40.19 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-We're going to have to prepare for that possibility.  
GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-Dr. Fraiser...?

13.47.04 DR. FRAISER-Sir, this, uh, problem is beyond my expertise.  
DR. FRAISER (OS CONT)-I'm, uh, gonna have to consult with some neurospecialists, sir.

13.54.11 GENERAL HAMMOND-Do it.

13.55.06 O'NEILL (OS)-General...  
O'NEILL (CONT)-Wouldn't it be a little easier if we just went back, got this machine, tried to slam it into reverse...

14.04.27 GENERAL HAMMOND-All right, Colonel. Retrieve it. But consider that device hazardous material. Prepare yourself accordingly.

14.10.23 O'NEILL-Yes, sir.

14.21.23 CARTER (THROUGH MASK)-I'm gonna check out Ma'chello's room. Maybe he has some electronic notebooks I can actually read.

14.26.00 O'NEILL (THROUGH MASK)-All right. Uh, Captain... maybe you shouldn't touch anything in there.

14.32.14 CARTER (THROUGH MASK)-I'll be careful, sir.

14.41.27 O'NEILL (THROUGH MASK)-All right. Let me get mine on first here. (beat) All right.  
O'NEILL (OS CONT THROUGH MASK)-On three. One... two...

14.55.09 CARTER (THROUGH MASK)-Colonel...

15.00.28 O'NEILL (THROUGH MASK)-Captain?

15.02.00 CARTER (THROUGH MASK)-Sorry. Uh, I think I know how Ma'chello has lived so long. I think this is some sort of medical device. There's all sorts of tubes and thermal units that look like they're for life support.

15.12.19 TEAL'C (THROUGH MASK)-But Ma'chello was conscious when we  
found him.

15.15.04 CARTER (THROUGH MASK)-Well, maybe it's triggered to  
automatically deactivate when someone comes through  
the gate.

15.19.12 TEAL'C (OS THROUGH MASK)-Then we can place Daniel Jackson  
in the...  
TEAL'C (CONT THROUGH MASK)-...hibernation chamber so his  
body can be maintained.

15.23.20 CARTER (THROUGH MASK)-Yeah, possibly. If I can figure  
out how to get it to work again.

15.27.17 O'NEILL (THROUGH MASK)-How long, Captain?

15.29.28 CARTER (THROUGH MASK)-I don't know, sir. I might not be  
able to figure it out at all.

15.33.08 O'NEILL (THROUGH MASK)-Well, then, let's just get this  
thing back to Earth. Might be all we need. (beat)  
On three...  
O'NEILL (OS CONT THROUGH MASK)-One... two...  
O'NEILL (CONT THROUGH MASK)-Three...

- 16.05.20 GENERAL HAMMOND-How did it go, Colonel?
- 16.07.15 O'NEILL (TEAL'C (O'NEILL))-It did not go well, General  
Hammond.
- 16.12.03 TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-You think?
- 16.21.14 O'NEILL (TEAL'C)-This is indeed uncomfortable.
- 16.25.27 TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-How do you think I feel, Teal'c? I've  
got a snake in my gut. You've got a comfortable,  
normal body.
- 16.33.02 O'NEILL (TEAL'C)-It is normal to you, O'Neill. Having a  
symbiote within is normal to me.
- 16.38.17 TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-Yeah, well, whatever. It's bad, okay?
- 16.44.04 CARTER-Hey...

18.41.14 TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-I'm not feeling so hot.

18.46.02 O'NEILL (TEAL'C)-What are you feeling, O'Neill?

18.51.03 TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-All of a sudden, Junior's moving around  
a lot in there.

18.55.22 O'NEILL (TEAL'C) (OS)-This likely means my...  
O'NEILL (TEAL'C) (CONT)-...body has contracted an illness  
my symbiote must repair.

19.01.12 CARTER-Illness? Great.

19.05.13 O'NEILL (TEAL'C)-It is common. The symbiote will remedy  
the problem.

19.10.06 TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-Okay. When?

19.12.21 O'NEILL (TEAL'C)-It can only accomplish its work if you  
put your body into a state of kelno'reem.

- 19.19.01           TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-Translation, Teal'c?
- 19.21.01           O'NEILL (TEAL'C)-Similar to a state of hibernation.
- 19.23.24           CARTER-Meditation?
- 19.25.06           O'NEILL (TEAL'C) (OS)-Perhaps.  
O'NEILL (TEAL'C) (CONT)-But I sense much deeper than that  
                  of any human meditation. It is imperative that you  
                  do this, O'Neill, or my body will be as if it has no  
                  immune system.
- 19.40.23           TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-Okay. Tell me what to do.
- 19.51.21           TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-You don't look so good. I mean I don't  
                  look so good.
- 20.02.21           O'NEILL (TEAL'C)-You will become increasingly ill as long  
                  as my symbiote does not have the opportunity to make  
                  the necessary repair.
- 20.19.01           TEAL'C (O'NEILL) (OS)-So you're telling me this is just  
                  gonna get worse?
- 20.22.28           O'NEILL (TEAL'C)-If you do not perform kelno'reem, it  
                  could lead to my death. Rather, your death.

20.38.05           TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-What do I do?

20.40.23           O'NEILL (TEAL'C)-Please be seated.

20.57.28           WAITRESS-Can I help you?

20.59.01           DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-Hello. This is Fred. I am Ma'chello.  
                  We wish to feast on me. In fact, let everyone here  
                  feast on me!

21.10.03           WAITRESS-You celebrating something?

21.12.01           DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-Indeed we are. Life.

21.17.00           WAITRESS-Okay. But I'm going to need a credit card.

21.21.18           DANIEL (MA'CHELLO) (OS)-A credit card...  
                  DANIEL (MA'CHELLO) (CONT)-Where would I find such a card?

21.27.05           WAITRESS-Usually in your wallet.

21.38.21           DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-Will one of these cards do?

21.43.26           WAITRESS-Absolutely.

- 21.49.14 DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-You are one of the most enchanting women I have seen in my lifetime. I would be honored by a kiss.
- 21.57.23 WAITRESS-Yeah, I bet you would.
- 22.03.12 O'NEILL (TEAL'C)-Very good, O'Neill.
- 22.05.27 TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-It is? I'm not feeling any better.
- 22.11.13 O'NEILL (TEAL'C)-You have not yet reached kelno'reem.
- 22.15.07 TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-So how do I do it?
- 22.19.15 O'NEILL (TEAL'C)-Relax. Concentrate. You must imagine the center of your mind and focus. Allow it to take you into a waking sleep. There you will dream. When you do so, it will be in harmony with the symbiote.

- 24.40.18 FRED-Dig in, Ma'chello. Before the hot fudge melts all the ice cream. (beat) So, uh... I get the feeling you fought in the Gulf. Am I right?

25.04.25 DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-No. But I was a soldier. I fought many battles. I was captured and tortured.

25.16.10 FRED-That explains a lot.

25.19.19 DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-I continued to fight, and lost all that I loved and cared for.  
DANIEL (MA'CHELLO) (OS CONT)-But I knew I could not surrender.  
DANIEL (MA'CHELLO) (CONT)-For you...  
DANIEL (MA'CHELLO) (OS CONT)-If it were not for me,...  
DANIEL (MA'CHELLO) (CONT)-...you would all be conquered by now.

25.36.18 FRED-By who? Saddam?

25.43.04 DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-He is not a System Lord I am familiar with. But several others would have wiped you out.

25.51.04 FRED-Whatever you say, man.

26.00.11 DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-But I do not wish to fight any longer. From now on, I only want to eat hamburgers and french fries and ice cream sundaes, and I want to be with good people like you, Fred.

26.12.26 FRED-All good things come to an end, Ma'chello.

26.15.13 DANIEL (MA'CHELLO) (OS)-Oh no, my friend.  
DANIEL (MA'CHELLO) (CONT)-Only evil things must come to  
an end.  
DANIEL (MA'CHELLO) (OS CONT)-For good things, such as  
ourselves, ...  
DANIEL (MA'CHELLO) (CONT)-...it is possible to go on  
forever.

26.35.17 TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-Whoa! Sweet. Teal'c...? What are you  
doing?

27.01.15 O'NEILL (TEAL'C)-If I am to remain in this body, I must

27.07.01 TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-You're making a joke, right?

27.09.07 O'NEILL (TEAL'C)-I am not joking.

27.10.21 TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-Teal'c, you will not shave my head!

27.13.21 O'NEILL (TEAL'C)-It is presently my head, O'Neill.



- 27.16.16           TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-Teal'c, this is temporary.
- 27.18.24           O'NEILL (TEAL'C)-And if it is not?
- 27.21.25           TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-Just give them a chance to find Daniel,  
                  okay? Teal'c, I'm going to see General Hammond.  
                  Promise me you won't touch the head until I get  
                  back.
- 27.53.10           TEAL'C (O'NEILL)-Sir, I feel like I need to be involved  
                  in finding Daniel.

30.34.05 CARTER-Hey... (TO DR. FRAISER) Janet...

30.48.04 DR. FRAISER-Well, it is good to have you back, Dr.  
Jackson.  
DR. FRAISER (OS CONT)-You have impeccable timing.  
DR. FRAISER (CONT)-Sam...  
DR. FRAISER (OS CONT)-They're on their way in. We should  
get...  
DR. FRAISER (CONT)-...that machine of his in here.

31.25.11 GENERAL HAMMOND-Reverse what you've done to my people.

31.32.02 DANIEL (MA'CHELLO)-I cannot do what is impossible.
