- 05.13.05 GENERAL HAMMOND-Colonel...?
- O'NEILL-General Hammond, Apophis.

 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-Apophis,...

 O'NEILL (CONT)-General Hammond.

- 05.22.16 GENERAL HAMMOND-We've met.
- 05.24.21 APOPHIS (DISTORTED)-I demand Cal mah.
- 05.28.22 DANIEL-I'm not really sure, but I think what he's asking for is --
- 05.30.24 TEAL'C-Sanctuary.
- 05.33.07 DANIEL-Right.
- 05.37.11 GENERAL HAMMOND-Why?
- 05.39.04 O'NEILL-I think some rival Goa'uld just kicked his ass.
- O5.42.06 CARTER-There were several other death gliders in pursuit when we took him prisoner, sir.
- O5.46.25 APOPHIS (DISTORTED) (OS)-I demand...

 APOPHIS (DISTORTED) (CONT)-Cal mah!
- 05.48.01 GENERAL HAMMOND-You're not in a position to demand anything, sir. Lock him up.

- DR. FRAISER-Sir, with all due respect, he is badly injured. He is not going to be any good to you at all unless we get him into the O.R. right now.
- O5.59.05 GENERAL HAMMOND-Do what you need to keep him alive,

 Doctor. We've got a lot of questions that need answers.
- O6.03.04 DR. FRAISER-Yes, sir. Okay, let's move him. I'm gonna start him on two I.V.'s and run Ringer's Lactate wide open. Let's go.
- GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)-I want four...

 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-SF's posted at all times.

 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-If he attempts to escape,...

 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-you're authorized to do whatever is necessary to stop him.
- 06.16.19 SF-Yes, sir. Let's go!
- 06.23.13 GENERAL HAMMOND-We'll debrief at eleven hundred hours.
- 06.28.03 O'NEILL-Yes, sir.

- DR. FRAISER (OS FROM OBSERVATION ROOM FILTERED)-Both femurs were smashed, and there was internal bleeding. Surgeries and transfusions...
 - DR. FRAISER (FROM OBSERVATION ROOM CONT FILTERED)-have stabilized him for now.
- 06.44.14 TEAL'C (FROM OBSERVATION ROOM FILTERED)-The Goa'uld symbiote within him will repair those injuries.
- DR. FRAISER (FROM OBSERVATION ROOM FILTERED)-Well, I think it's kept him alive so far, Teal'c. But take a look at this monitor.
 - DR. FRAISER (OS CONT)-See, what you're looking at is the actual symbiote attached to the host's brain stem.

 Now, do you see all these lesions? I mean, there's dozens of them. I can treat the human part, but as for the symbiote itself...

- 07.12.13 O'NEILL-Sam...?

- O7.14.12 CARTER-I, I just had a memory of Jolinar. Pain... when she was killed by the Ashrak. (beat) The Ashrak had this device. He used it on us. It was meant to cause incredible pain. Apophis was tortured by the same thing.
- 07.41.12 GENERAL HAMMOND-So he's dying?
- 07.42.12 DR. FRAISER-Yes.
- 07.44.00 GENERAL HAMMOND-You're sure about that?
- 07.45.17 DR. FRAISER-As sure as I can be, sir, considering what we know of Goa'uld physiology.
- 07.50.07 O'NEILL-Good. When?
- DR. FRAISER-Without access to a sarcophagus, the Goa'uld body will continue to deteriorate. So we're looking at days... weeks, certainly...
- 08.02.08 CARTER-This kind of torture wasn't designed to extract information. It's a method of execution.
- 08.09.03 O'NEILL-So what does he really want?

- DANIEL (OS)-You heard him yourself.

 DANIEL (CONT)-He wants sanctuary.
- 08.14.05 O'NEILL-I'm not buying that.
- DANIEL-He gambled we would show compassion even to our worst enemy. He was right.
- O'NEILL-You think he orchestrated this?

 O'NEILL (OS CONT)-Let me tell you something.

 O'NEILL (CONT)-The only compassion I showed was by not blowing his head off.

- O8.54.25 DANIEL-So his blood is in the water, and all the other sharks are having a feeding frenzy.
- 08.58.13 TEAL'C-And he has come here seeking refuge.
- 09.00.15 O'NEILL-Well, that's tough. I say we beat whatever information we can out of ol' snake boy, open that gate, and toss him back to the sharks.

 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-I've informed my superiors of our situation. My orders are to extract whatever information we can...

GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-in the short time we will have.

12.30.23 APOPHIS (DISTORTED)-So that I may live. In exchange for all the knowledge of the Goa'uld.

APOPHIS (DISTORTED) (OS CONT)-The secrets of star travel...

APOPHIS (DISTORTED) (CONT)-our weapons... our power...

- 12.44.00 O'NEILL-All that...
- 12.45.13 APOPHIS (DISTORTED)-In time, more.
- 12.53.00 O'NEILL-Go to hell.
- 12.55.18 APOPHIS (DISTORTED)-A single human life is worth so much you would risk a world?
- 12.59.25 O'NEILL-That's right. That's why they call us the good guys. (beat) Doc, let me know when he dies.
- 13.14.01 APOPHIS (DISTORTED)-Sokar...!
- 13.16.15 O'NEILL-What?

- 13.18.09 APOPHIS (DISTORTED)-An ancient and powerful Goa'uld. You have helped him to become strong.
 - APOPHIS (DISTORTED) (OS CONT)-The last of my loyal Jaffa died stealing me from his grasp.
 - APOPHIS (DISTORTED) (CONT)-He will not rest until I am found. That is why I chose to come here. So that in death, I will be assured you will die with me.
- TEAL'C (OS)-Sokar is a Goa'uld of ancient...

 TEAL'C (CONT)-times. He was once ruler of the system lords, but was defeated by an alliance of...

 TEAL'C (OS CONT)-Goa'uld many centuries ago. Apophis and Ra were among his conquerors.
- 14.00.27 CARTER-Where did he go?
- 14.02.05 TEAL'C-Apophis himself believed him destroyed.

 Obviously, he was mistaken.
- 14.06.20 O'NEILL-Well, if he was almost wiped out, how bad could he be now? (beat) It's rhetorical, Teal'c.
- DANIEL (OS)-His name is also very old in Earth mythology.

 DANIEL (CONT)-He was the most feared deity in ancient

 Egypt, the original god of death.

- 14.21.07 O'NEILL-Got anything a little more up to date?
- DANIEL-Well, I don't know what he's been up to lately,
 but according to the Book of the Dead, there was a
 time he ruled all of Earth. His lands around
 Memphis were covered by darkness...

 DANIEL (OS CONT)-and inhabited by serpents.
- 14.34.23 TEAL'C-Unas. The first host of the Goa'uld.
- DANIEL (OS)-Well, that makes sense.

 DANIEL (CONT)-I mean, if the Unas were the first ones,
 there had to be a time when both forms of Goa'uld
 hosts co-existed --

DANIEL (OS CONT)-Unas and human.

DANIEL (CONT)-Kind of like Neanderthal and --

 APOPHIS (DISTORTED) (OS CONT)-so much more...

- 18.00.08 APOPHIS (DISTORTED)-My son?
- 18.02.04 DANIEL (OS)-Yes.

DANIEL (CONT)-I brought him into the world with my own hands...

DANIEL (OS CONT)-on Abydos.

- 18.08.06 APOPHIS (DISTORTED)-He was taken by Heru-ur.
- 18.09.21 DANIEL-No. By me.

 (beat) Amaunet... (beat) I knew the moment I laid eyes on her she was the vessel for a queen...
- 18.37.01 DANIEL-If you don't tell me where she is, I'll kill you right here.
- 18.44.27 APOPHIS (DISTORTED)-You have neither the strength or the will.
- 18.49.28 CARTER-Daniel...
- 19.11.14 CARTER-We, we think that thud we heard hitting the iris was a Sagan Box. It's radioactive signature matches the one we gave the Tok'ra. They're coming here.
- 19.25.26 TECHNICIAN-Incoming traveler!
- 19.27.20 O'NEILL-Decision time, sir.
- 19.29.24 GENERAL HAMMOND-Captain Carter, are you one hundred percent certain?

- 19.32.25 CARTER-That the signature matches the one we gave the Tok'ra? Yes, sir. But that it came from them?

 There's no way to be sure.
- 19.37.24 GENERAL HAMMOND-Well, what if one...

 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)-or more of the Tok'ra have been captured by Sokar and tortured?
- 19.41.22 CARTER-I don't think that they would give us up.
- 19.44.00 O'NEILL-I'm with Carter, General. I say we keep the door open.
- 19.48.06 GENERAL HAMMOND-Very well.
- 20.02.22 MARTOUF-Samantha...
- 20.04.03 CARTER-Martouf...
- 20.07.08 GENERAL HAMMOND (OVER INTERCOM FILTERED)-Defense team, you may stand down.
- 20.11.02 MARTOUF-I offer you greetings from the high council of the Tok'ra.
- 20.15.11 CARTER-Why didn't my father come?

- 20.16.23 MARTOUF-He's dealing with more urgent matters. We come only to offer you a word of warning.
- 20.21.02 O'NEILL-Which is...?
- 20.23.05 MARTOUF-We know you have Apophis as your prisoner. You must return him to the planet you retrieved him from immediately.
- 20.51.01 MARTOUF (VO)-Since Jacob has...

 MARTOUF (CONT)-joined the Tok'ra, I have come to a deeper

understanding of your people, your purpose, and your extraordinary gifts.

- 21.53.20 CARTER-We don't consider what we did a sign of weakness.
- 21.56.02 MARTOUF (GOA'ULD)-Then you are fools. (beat) Turn him over to Sokar now,...

MARTOUF (OS CONT) (GOA'ULD)-and he may spare you.

- 22.02.21 GENERAL HAMMOND-I'm afraid we can't do that just yet.
- MARTOUF (GOA'ULD)-If he remains here, you will all die.

 MARTOUF (OS CONT) (GOA'ULD)-If not by the hand of Sokar,

 then by the many Goa'uld who would wish to destroy

 Apophis themselves.
 - MARTOUF (CONT) (GOA'ULD)-You do not see what you have done. You've answered a battle in which you are ill-equipped to fight, tipped the balance of power among the Goa'uld, and in so doing, worsened the fortune of your entire race.

 GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)-what would happen to him if we turned him over.
- 22.31.25 MARTOUF (GOA'ULD)-I am certain he would be executed...

- 22.36.10 GENERAL HAMMOND-I see.
- 22.37.08 MARTOUF (GOA'ULD)-Surely you welcome this. His guilt is clear. He cannot be allowed to escape punishment.

- 25.10.06 DANIEL-I don't know what to say...
- 25.24.19 DANIEL-Thousands of years, trapped inside your own body... It's like a nightmare... It's unimaginable.

- 25.30.06 DR. FRAISER-He won't be conscious again for a while.
- 25.33.06 MARTOUF-Then we will take our leave of him. I will tell you the coordinates to send us.
