00.57.15            O'NEILL- Teal'c? What do you think?

10.00.18            TEAL'C- It is an ancient Goa'uld design.

01.38.26            DANIEL (OS)- Jesus..!

01.42.18            O'NEILL- All right. Level A.

01.55.03            TEAL'C (OS)- There's another one here.

01.56.28            O'NEILL (THROUGH MASK)- There's more over there.

- 02.05.28 CARTER (THROUGH MASK)- These aren't quite human. They're Goa'uld.
- 03.17.02 TEAL'C (OS THROUGH MASK)- This mechanism appears to have been damaged by a ribbon device.
- 03.20.18 CARTER (OS THROUGH MASK)- Maybe they were trying to contain...  
CARTER (CONT THROUGH MASK)-...whatever did this.
- 03.23.21 DANIEL (THROUGH MASK)- Teal'c, do you recognize this symbol?
- 03.28.22 TEAL'C (THROUGH MASK)- It is the crest of the Linvris.
- 03.30.24 O'NEILL (THROUGH MASK)- Which is what? Or who?
- 03.33.02 TEAL'C (THROUGH MASK)- A rival league of lesser Goa'ulds who challenge the System Lords.
- 03.36.07 O'NEILL (THROUGH MASK)- A minor league.
- 03.37.10 TEAL'C (OS THROUGH MASK)- Yes.  
TEAL'C (CONT THROUGH MASK)- There are nine.
- 03.40.27 CARTER (OS THROUGH MASK)- ...five... six... seven... eight... nine...  
CARTER (CONT THROUGH MASK)- Found 'em.

- 03.47.07 DANIEL (THROUGH MASK)- It's one of those Goa'uld tablet devices. The kind we found on Argos.
- 03.50.10 CARTER (THROUGH MASK)- Can you translate it?
- 03.51.18 DANIEL (OS THROUGH MASK)- Part of it. It's some sort of battle plan.  
DANIEL (CONT THROUGH MASK)- I need the hand device that makes the screen go to the next page.
- 04.00.18 O'NEILL (THROUGH MASK)- That thing?
- 04.18.26 DANIEL (THROUGH MASK)- Nothing's happening.
- 04.22.26 O'NEILL (THROUGH MASK)- What?
- 04.24.16 DANIEL (THROUGH MASK)- I felt something brush by me.
- 04.30.14 O'NEILL (THROUGH MASK)- Hey, all right... Let's pack it out of here. Leave this to the medical containment unit. It's getting creepy.

- 04.58.23 A WHISPERING VOICE (VO)- Dr. Jackson...?

05.00.20 DANIEL- Out in a minute!

05.06.17 A WHISPERING VOICE (VO)- Dr. Jackson...?

05.38.01 CARTER- Daniel...

05.39.20 DANIEL- Were you calling me just now?

05.41.00 CARTER- No.

05.45.21 DANIEL- You weren't calling my name in the locker room a minute ago?

05.48.24 CARTER- No. It wasn't me. Uh, General Hammond's waiting for us in the briefing room.

06.01.10 DR. FRAISER (OS)- The Goa'ulds died...

DR. FRAISER (CONT)- ...before their hosts. We know this due to a unique protein marker left in Goa'uld bodies or host...

DR. FRAISER (OS CONT)- ...bodies after a Goa'uld dies.

06.09.00 CARTER- The same protein marker that was left in my body after Jolinar was killed.

06.11.19 DR. FRAISER- Yes.

06.12.16 GENERAL HAMMOND- How did they die, Doctor?

06.13.16 DR. FRAISER (OS)- Well, at this point, sir,...

DR. FRAISER (CONT)- I can't really give you an accurate answer, and I may never be able to.

06.17.07 GENERAL HAMMOND- Why not?

06.18.00 DR. FRAISER (OS)- As with Major Carter, when these...

DR. FRAISER (CONT)- ...Goa'uld symbiotes died, they rapidly decayed and were absorbed by the host. There's no Goa'uld host for me to study.

06.25.12 O'NEILL (OS)- What about...

O'NEILL (CONT)- ...bio-warfare? Poison? Disease? That sorta thing.

06.29.23 TEAL'C- The Goa'uld are immune to such things.

06.33.00 DANIEL- What about the hosts?

06.34.02 DR. FRAISER (OS)- The humans were normal.

DR. FRAISER (CONT)- No wounds, no infections.

06.36.13 DANIEL- Okay, then why are they dead?

- 06.38.10 DR. FRAISER- According to Teal'c, the...  
DR. FRAISER (OS CONT)- ...door was disabled from the inside.  
DR. FRAISER (CONT)- Locked in with no food, no water, they probably died of  
starvation.
- 06.44.09 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)- Right now I'm more concerned...  
GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)- ...with who killed the Goa'uld and why.
- 06.47.07 TEAL'C (OS)- The System Lords would be...  
TEAL'C (CONT)- ...the most likely suspects.
- 06.49.20 O'NEILL- But if the door was disabled from the inside, how did the perp – or perps – get  
out?
- 06.54.10 CARTER (OS)- Maybe the assassins weren't visible.  
CARTER (CONT)- And we're the ones who let them out.
- 07.01.03 O'NEILL- Reetou... You think Reetou were in there?
- 07.04.08 TEAL'C (OS)- Reetou would not spare the host. Reetou weaponry...  
TEAL'C (CONT)- ...does much damage to the human body.
- 07.09.17 O'NEILL- Well, there you go.

07.11.13 GENERAL HAMMOND- Dr. Jackson, what about that Goa'uld tablet device?

07.16.04 GATE TECHNICIAN (VO ON ONTERCOM FILTERED)- Incoming traveler.

07.22.14 DANIEL- Um... It's a Goa'uld dialect...

DANIEL (OS CONT)- ...akin to Latin. From what Teal'c and I have made out so far, it's  
some...

DANIEL (CONT)- ...sort of attack plan. I'm still trying to figure out how to scroll to the  
next page... if there is a next page.

07.35.26 GENERAL HAMMOND (OS)- Dr. Jackson,...

GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)- ...I want you to make translating that tablet your top  
priority.

07.39.20 DANIEL- Yes, sir.

07.41.09 GENERAL HAMMOND- Dismissed.

07.53.23 GATE TECHNICIAN (VO ON RADIO FILTERED)- SG-7 returning.

08.31.04 DANIEL- (mumbles words in other language)... To enter by infiltration. Infiltration...

08.50.11 WHISPERED VOICE (VO)- Daniel... Daniel... Daniel...



09.17.07 WHISPERED VOICE (VO)- (UNINTELLIGIBLE)

09.26.20 DANIEL- This isn't real.

09.39.20 DANIEL- Help! Somebody help!!

10.11.08 O'NEILL- Hello.

10.12.25 DANIEL- Hello.

10.14.25 O'NEILL- What happened?

10.20.08 DANIEL- Do you believe in ghosts?

10.22.02 O'NEILL- Uh, no. Unh unh.

10.25.23 DANIEL (OS)- Neither do I.  
DANIEL (CONT)- Which means there has to be a logical explanation.

10.30.19 O'NEILL- For what?

10.38.14 DANIEL- When we were in the Linvris chamber, I felt something brush by me. (beat)  
And I've heard voices. And I keep seeing the dead Goa'uld from the massacre.

10.50.03 O'NEILL- Where?

10.50.27 DANIEL (OS)- Well, last night...

DANIEL (CONT)- ...they were in my closet.

DANIEL (OS CONT)- In like a...

DANIEL (CONT)- Stargate event horizon without the gate.

10.59.25 O'NEILL- In your closet?

11.00.28 DANIEL- Yes. (beat) I don't think they're really dead.

11.07.24 O'NEILL- The stiffs in the morgue?

11.09.14 DANIEL- No, the nine Goa'uld that were using them as hosts.

DANIEL (OS CONT)- I translated a phrase in that tablet that I thought...

DANIEL (CONT)- ...meant “attack”, but when I refined the translation, I realized it  
means “to enter by infiltration”.

11.19.08 O'NEILL (OS)- And you think...

O'NEILL (CONT)- ...that's what they're doing?

11.20.19 DANIEL- Yes.

11.21.17 O'NEILL- Through your closet?

11.22.18 DANIEL (OS)- Teal'c said the...  
DANIEL (CONT)- ....Linvrís were being hunted by the System Lords, right?  
DANIEL (OS CONT)- Now, what if they used some sort of technology to transform their  
bodies...  
DANIEL (CONT)- ...into, I don't know... energy or something?

11.32.04 O'NEILL- Energy?

11.33.09 DANIEL- Or something.  
DANIEL (OS CONT)- I don't know exactly...  
DANIEL (CONT)- ...how. Sam can figure that part out. The point is... they're here.  
(beat) They've entered by infiltration, and now they want me as a host.

11.46.26 O'NEILL- All nine of them?

11.53.06 DANIEL- That sounds crazy, huh?

11.54.08 O'NEILL- Mmmm, yeah. You gotta admit, there are some holes in your theory here.

12.01.12 DANIEL- Well, it's a theory. Not a proof.

12.03.27 O'NEILL (OS)- Why are you the only one who can see them?  
O'NEILL (CONT)- Why didn't they come through my closet? Aside from the fact that  
yours is cleaner.

- 12.11.17 DANIEL (OS)- I don't know.  
DANIEL (CONT)- The only other theory I can come up with is that I'm having some sort of nervous breakdown.
- 12.18.22 O'NEILL- Or something. Yeah.
- 12.19.23 DANIEL (OS) (OVERLAPPING)- Or something.
- 12.27.27 O'NEILL- Dr. Mackenzie.
- 12.28.28 DR. MACKENZIE- Colonel.
- 12.33.00 O'NEILL- I'm not gonna enjoy this, am I?
- 12.37.05 GENERAL HAMMOND- Part of Dr. Mackenzie's...  
GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)- ...work involves analyzing psychological data from SG units. Specifically looking for common side effects to Gate travel.  
GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)- Dr. Jackson's episode yesterday may have uncovered a serious one.
- 12.49.22 DR. MACKENZIE (OS)- Dr. Fraiser's been treating...  
DR. MACKENZIE (CONT)- ...you for headaches lately, hasn't she?
- 12.56.15 O'NEILL- Yes. What's that got to do with Daniel?

- 13.00.25 DR. MACKENZIE (OS)- Well, you're not the only one.  
DR. MACKENZIE (CONT)- Fifty-three percent of SG field personnel also have a history of them.
- 13.05.20 O'NEILL- A lot of people get headaches. What's your point?
- 13.08.00 DR. MACKENZIE (OS)- Dr. Jackson has experienced what I'd characterize...  
DR. MACKENZIE (CONT)- ...as a first break psychotic episode, which may be manifesting full blown hebephrenic schizophrenia.
- 13.18.08 DR. FRAISER- Migraines are often one of the first signs.
- 13.20.03 O'NEILL- Wait a minute. Daniel's a schizophrenic and it was caused by the Stargate?
- 13.27.06 DR. FRAISER (OS)- It's the only logical explanation...  
DR. FRAISER (CONT)- ...we have right now, Colonel.
- 13.29.18 O'NEILL- Well, it sounds fairly theoretical to me. Does anybody think it could be stress?
- 13.35.05 DR. FRAISER (OS)- As much as I'd like to think that's all it is,...  
DR. FRAISER (CONT)- ...the evidence just doesn't point that way. Daniel has paranoid delusions,...  
DR. FRAISER (OS CONT)- ...auditory and visual hallucinations.

- 13.43.07 DR. MACKENZIE (OS)- Dr. Jackson’s dopamine levels...  
DR. MACKENZIE (CONT)- ...have increased in the left hemisphere of his brain. All these symptoms are textbook schizophrenia.
- 13.51.00 CARTER- I don’t understand how this could happen without us noticing signs.
- 13.53.24 DR. FRAISER (OS)- Nobody knows the exact cause of schizophrenia.  
DR. FRAISER (CONT)- Some cases are genetic, but there’s no history of it in...  
DR. FRAISER (OS CONT)- ...Daniel’s family. When it’s not genetic, it’s environmental.  
And the...  
DR. FRAISER (CONT)- ...Stargate is a plausible environmental cause.
- 14.05.05 CARTER- I’ve been through the Gate as many times as Daniel, and I don’t have headaches.
- 14.08.15 DR. FRAISER (OS)- Well, your body may have some kind...  
DR. FRAISER (CONT)- ...of immunity, possibly due to Jolinar.
- 14.11.27 O’NEILL (OS)- All right.  
O’NEILL (CONT)- Let’s say for the sake of argument that it is the Stargate... a theory to which I do not ascribe.  
O’NEILL (OS CONT)- Then why don’t we just...  
O’NEILL (CONT)- ...put a little sign at the base of the ramp that says “Gate travel may be hazardous to your health.” I can live with that.

14.26.25 CARTER- So can I, sir.

14.27.22 GENERAL HAMMOND- The Air Force can't.

GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)- I can't risk any SG...

GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)- ...officer having delusions in the middle of...

GENERAL HAMMOND (OS CONT)- ...a crisis. Therefore as we speak, all  
outstanding...

GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT)- ...SG teams are being recalled for evaluation.

14.38.17 CARTER- You're shutting down the whole program.

14.40.01 GENERAL HAMMOND- Only until Dr. Mackenzie and his team submit their report. If his  
theories prove correct, limits will be placed on the number of missions. Until then,  
the Stargate is closed.

14.49.19 O'NEILL- General...

14.50.19 GENERAL HAMMOND- There is no debate, Colonel.

14.53.08 O'NEILL- Of course not.

14.54.22 CARTER- What about Daniel, sir?

- 14.56.25 DR. MACKENZIE (OS)- For now, we're going to, um, medicate him and...  
DR. MACKENZIE (CONT)- ...let him rest in one of the VIP rooms.
- 15.02.09 DR. FRAISER- But if his symptoms persist or he becomes a threat to himself or anyone  
else, we'll have to commit him to Mental Health.
- 15.24.17 DANIEL (OS)- Check.  
DANIEL (CONT)- Oh.
- 15.34.03 O'NEILL- What? Didn't see that?
- 15.38.02 DANIEL (OS)- Actually, I was, uh,...  
DANIEL (CONT)- ..."Oh-ing" about something else.  
DANIEL (OS CONT)- Checkmate.  
DANIEL (CONT)- I should have done that two moves ago. I don't know what I was  
thinking.
- 15.47.17 O'NEILL- Uh, well... You're a little off.
- 15.50.22 DANIEL (OS)- I don't feel off.  
DANIEL (CONT)- I feel, I feel fine. No headaches, no tension... I mean, I feel... normal.
- 16.00.10 O'NEILL- That's because it was just stress, and I have a very calming effect on  
stressed-out people. How about a game of Gin.



16.11.09 DANIEL- I'm not very good at Gin.

16.12.06 O'NEILL- Good. Get the cards.

16.59.00 DANIEL- Jack...

17.00.01 O'NEILL- Yeah? (beat) What?

17.08.07 DANIEL- It's nothing.

17.13.13 O'NEILL- You all right?

17.18.08 DANIEL- I'm fine. How are you feeling?

17.28.15 O'NEILL- Good. Real good.

17.34.07 DANIEL- There's a Goa'uld in you! I've gotta get it out!

17.35.22 O'NEILL- Get... Daniel, there's no Goa'uld in me!

17.40.12 DANIEL- I'm sorry. I saw it. I saw it...

17.49.12 O'NEILL- You all right...? Come here... Easy, easy... Be careful...

18.23.09 DR. MACKENZIE (OS)- Don't expect much.  
DR. MACKENZIE (CONT)- If he becomes agitated, call the aides.

18.42.14 DANIEL (OS)- Jack...?

18.44.13 CARTER (OS)- It's us, Daniel.  
CARTER (CONT)- Can't you see us?

18.53.22 DANIEL- I was just making sure you weren't figments of my mind. (beat) They took  
away my glasses in case I broke the lenses and, uh,...  
DANIEL (OS CONT)- ...tried to, uh...  
DANIEL (CONT)- ...hurt myself.

19.14.00 O'NEILL- They treatin' you okay?

19.16.06 DANIEL- Yeah. (cries) I'm sorry.

19.37.01 O'NEILL- For what?

19.39.00 DANIEL- For being such a head case.

19.42.12 CARTER- It's not your fault, Daniel.

19.48.00 TEAL'C- Colonel O'Neill believes it has something to do with the Linvris.

19.51.04 O'NEILL- Remember in that chamber, you said you felt something brush by you?

19.54.26 DANIEL- Yes. It was them.

DANIEL (OS CONT)- I know you don't believe me, but I felt them.

DANIEL (CONT)- They heard me. (beat) They're coming. (beat) They're coming.

20.36.10 TEAL'C- Only your friends are here, Daniel Jackson.

20.38.12 DANIEL (OS)- They're coming.

DANIEL (CONT)- I hear footsteps. Footsteps...

20.47.00 O'NEILL- Daniel, there are no footsteps! Stay with us.

20.53.22 DANIEL- Footsteps...

21.20.27 DANIEL- I told you... It's one of them. He's right there.

21.27.28 TEAL'C- There is no one at my side, Daniel Jackson.

21.35.28 DANIEL- Yes there is.

21.41.06 O'NEILL- Want to get the aides?

22.02.08 DANIEL- Something just went inside Teal'c!

22.04.04 O'NEILL- You're hallucinating, Daniel.

22.07.27 DANIEL- Don't just stand there! Get it out of him!

22.13.17 MA'CHELLO (VO)- You have delivered me to the vile Goa'uld so that I may destroy it.

22.18.02 DANIEL (OVERLAPPING)- Ma'chello.

22.20.13 DR. MACKENZIE- Okay, let's raise the...  
DR. MACKENZIE (OS CONT)- ...dose. Five mils at four hour intervals.

22.29.09 DANIEL- Ma'chello.

22.41.05 CARTER- God, I hate seeing him like that.

22.43.12 TEAL'C- Nothing worse than losing your mind and knowing it's happening. (beat)  
Infirmery...!

23.10.02 MA'CHELLO (DISTORTED)- Yes. Inventions to fight the Goa'uld!

23.17.23 DANIEL- Ma'chello...

23.18.27 MA'CHELLO (DISTORTED)- Yes. Yes. Inventions to fight the Goa'uld!

- 23.45.08 DANIEL- Dr. Mackenzie! Dr. Mackenzie!
- 24.00.20 DR. FRAISER- Teal'c's symbiote is dying. I can't explain why.
- 24.08.02 O'NEILL- Teal'c... What about that Kel'noreem thing?
- 24.17.11 GENERAL HAMMOND- Is he having hallucinations like Dr. Jackson?
- 24.20.09 DR. FRAISER- His dopamine levels are normal. Besides, Daniel didn't have the same physical symptoms. They seem to be unrelated.
- 24.28.02 O'NEILL- What are we talking about, time-wise?
- 24.31.09 DR. FRAISER- Without another symbiote... a day, two. Maybe less. Even if we found another larval Goa'uld in time, there's no telling if it would survive either.
- 24.54.08 DR. MACKENZIE (OS)- Dr. Jackson?
- 24.59.15 DANIEL- Sit down... One second.
- 25.04.23 DR. MACKENZIE- Look, Daniel, it's time for your meds.
- 25.06.22 DANIEL- Uh... I don't, uh, need any more drugs. What I need is to get the ones you've got in my system out of my system.

25.17.15 DR. MACKENZIE- No, Daniel. You need rest.

25.20.00 DANIEL- I think I've rested enough.  
DANIEL (OS CONT)- Just tell me one thing.  
DANIEL (CONT)- Is Teal'c sick?

25.28.23 DR. MACKENZIE- Not that I'm aware of. I haven't been to the SGC. (beat) Dr.  
Jackson, I insist you calm yourself.  
DR. MACKENZIE (OS CONT)- Otherwise I'll have to have you restrained and further  
sedated.

25.42.07 DANIEL- Why are you so quick to jump to the conclusion I'm crazy? That I'm  
dangerous and out of control...? (beat) It's 'cause I'm kinda acting tha way,  
aren't I? I just need to get these drugs out of my system.  
DANIEL (OS CONT)- Look...  
DANIEL (CONT)- I know you probably hear this from patients all the time, but I think I'm  
cured.

26.10.17 DR. MACKENZIE (OS)- You're right. I hear it all the time.  
DR. MACKENZIE (CONT)- I'm afraid it doesn't work that way. You don't get well from  
something like this overnight.

26.18.06 DANIEL- You do it there were an alien organism inside of you making you think that you  
were sick when you really weren't.

- 26.25.06 DR. MACKENZIE- Mmm hmm. And you, uh, found this out how?
- 26.29.28 DANIEL- Ma'chello told me.
- 26.31.15 DR. MACKENZIE- Ma'chello?
- 26.33.13 DANIEL- Well, he's an alien old man we met on P3C-599.
- 26.37.00 DR. MACKENZIE (OS)- Dr. Jackson...  
DR. MACKENZIE (CONT)- You haven't had any visitors.
- 26.40.07 DANIEL- No, of course I haven't. You see, Ma'chello is dead.
- 26.44.08 DR. MACKENZIE- Dead? Yet he told you there was someone inside you making you  
appear crazy?
- 26.56.23 DANIEL- That's a good point.  
DANIEL (OS CONT)- I wouldn't, uh, I wouldn't buy...  
DANIEL (CONT)- ...that if I were you either. Just do me one favor, okay? (beat)  
Contact the SGC. Find out if Teal'c is sick. If he is, promise me you'll let me talk  
to Jack O'Neill.
- 27.31.11 GENERAL HAMMOND- Dr. Mackenzie seems to think there's some sort of change with  
Dr. Jackson.

- 27.35.23 DR. FRAISER- A change, sir?
- 27.38.01 GENERAL HAMMOND- He's requesting that you come out there, Colonel.
- 28.03.21 O'NEILL- Hey, Daniel.
- 28.10.13 DANIEL- You don't, uh... You don't need to walk on eggshells any more. I'm, I'm better.
- 28.16.23 O'NEILL (OS)- So I hear.  
O'NEILL (CONT)- Uh, it's... not that I doubt you, but... Uh, why do you think it happened  
all of a sudden?
- 28.27.24 DANIEL- I don't completely understand it myself, but... I saw something come out of me  
and go into Teal'c. (beat) And then I heard Ma'chello's voice.
- 28.36.03 O'NEILL- Uh... Ma'chello?



28.39.20 DANIEL- Just hear me out.  
DANIEL (OS CONT)- I'm guessing it wasn't actually Ma'chello.  
DANIEL (CONT)- It was probably some sort of technological or organic recording. And  
it said something about delivering Ma'chello to the vile Goa'uld.  
DANIEL (OS CONT)- Which made me start thinking...  
DANIEL (CONT)- Maybe I had some sort of Goa'uld-killing invention inside of me.  
DANIEL (OS CONT)- One of...  
DANIEL (CONT)- ...Ma'chello's inventions.

29.03.08 O'NEILL- And that's what made you... nuts?

29.06.21 DANIEL- Well, since I don't have a Goa'uld, the side effect of this invention must make  
normal people act like they're...

29.14.07 O'NEILL- Nuts.

29.05.12 DANIEL- Schizophrenic. Look... Teal'c is sick, right?

29.21.27 O'NEILL- Right.

29.23.11 DANIEL- Well, he does have a Goa'uld.

29.38.23 DR. FRAISER- Your dopamine levels are back to normal.

- 29.40.09 DANIEL- Im back to normal...
- 29.42.27 CARTER (OS)- Okay, let's say...  
CARTER (CONT)- ... your concept about Ma'chello's Goa'uld-killing invention is right.  
Why did it take so long to go into Teal'c?
- 29.50.01 DANIEL- I don't know. Maybe he needed a-a close proximity to sense his Goa'uld  
larvae. (beat) Look, I had a lot of time locked in that little room to think about this.  
It makes sense. Why am I back to normal?  
DANIEL (OS CONT)- And coincidentally, hours after...  
DANIEL (CONT)- ... touching me, Teal'c is sick.
- 30.09.06 O'NEILL- All right. Why didn't I get sick when we were playing cards the other night and  
you were jumping all over me?

O'NEILL (CONT)- Right there... Back it up...

- 31.17.13 DANIEL (OS)- I picked that up in...  
DANIEL (CONT)- ...the Linvris chamber.
- 31.20.17 DR. FRAISER (OS)- Why did he make so many page-turning devices?
- 31.24.05 CARTER- Could be our land mine.
- 31.33.09 DR. FRAISER- On the right is the P.T.D....  
DR. FRAISER (OS CONT)- ...from the Linvris. And the one on the left is from Area 51.
- 31.39.11 CARTER- They look exactly like the ones we found on Argos. The Linvris probably

32.42.19           DANIEL (OS FILTERED)- General Hammond! B Haz Mat...  
DANIEL (CONT FILTERED)-...three Observation right away!

32.50.15           DR. FRAISER- No...!

33.01.24           O'NEILL- Great.

33.08.11           DANIEL (FILTERED)- We have a breach.

GENERAL HAMMOND (CONT FILTERED)-...of further contamination to the Base?

34.20.22 DANIEL (FILTERED)- Sam, you've got four of those things in you.

34.22.25 CARTER- Well, I-I-I know that, but I feel fine.

                          DR. FRAISER (CONT)- Just need to separate red blood cells...
