09.43.16 ARIS BOCH- Well, contrary to popular human belief, the Earth is not the center of  
the Galaxy.

09.52.13            ARIS BOCH- Have you met every Goa'uld?  
ARIS BOCH (OS CONT)- I haven't. The only thing I know...

TEAL'C (CONT)- Crystals. There should be three crystals.

DANIEL (CONT)- The middle one's missing.

18.12.03           O'NEILL- We're missing one!

18.16.23           TEAL'C- Then there is no way to override the self-destruct.

18.25.03            ELECTRONIC VOICE (VO FILTERED)- (UNINTELLIGIBLE)

18.25.28            DANIEL- We just lost another digit! (beat) Aris must have the other crystal.

18.31.03            O'NEILL- Go.

18.38.08            ARIS BOCH- Hey! What were you guys thinking? Only I can fire that.

18.46.00            ARIS BOCH- Put the weapon down.

18.47.23            O'NEILL- You put the crystal back.

18.51.00            ARIS BOCH- What if I don't?

18.53.23            O'NEILL- You won't blow up your ship.

18.56.21            ARIS BOCH- Maybe I will.

18.58.03            O'NEILL- While you're in it?

19.06.28            ELECTRONIC VOICE (VO FILTERED)- (UNINTELLIGIBLE)

19.19.23            ARIS BOCH- Now it's set.

19.21..25            O'NEILL- Put the gun down.

19.23.00            ARIS BOCH- Colonel, you think I'd give you a weapon that would work on me?

Ooo... tickles...

19.38.01            DANIEL- Then why did you pretend to be knocked out?

19.40.16            ARIS BOCH (OS)- Well, let's just say...

ARIS BOCH (CONT)- ...I wanted to see you guys sweat a little. (beat) Now, did we  
learn something here? (beat) Ouch...

ARIS BOCH (OS CONT)- Let's go.

ARIS BOCH (CONT)- You know, I'm very disappointed. I thought we had something  
good going.

20.16.06            O'NEILL- Ah, come on. What'd you expect?

20.17.25            ARIS BOCH- Well, I offered a fair deal. I...

ARIS BOCH (OS CONT)- ...trusted you.

20.21.22            O'NEILL- Oh, please...

20.23.10            DANIEL- We're sorry. Is the deal still on the table?

20.27.13            ARIS BOCH- How could I trust you now?

20.29.04 O'NEILL- Look, your plan sucks.

20.31.18 ARIS BOCH (OS)- Okay...

ARIS BOCH (CONT)- We all go together this time.

20.38.12 O'NEILL- Yeah. You know, we're gonna need our stuff.

20.40.20 ARIS BOCH- Well, some of that shouldn't be a problem.

20.52.01 DANIEL- So you don't seem to have much a problem trading human lives like  
commodities.

20.56.00 ARIS BOCH- Oh, you earthlings and your morality. Has it ever occurred to you that  
someone outside your solar system might not see things the way you do?

21.04.02 CARTER- Well, why don't the Goa'uld just take what they want from you and kill  
you?

21.06.25 ARIS BOCH- They don't kill me because I deliver. As long as I'm alive, there'll  
always be a next time.

21.11.24 CARTER- Well, why don't they just make you a host?

21.13.15 ARIS BOCH- Because they can't. They tried a long time ago when they first came to my home planet. But there's something about my race's physical makeup that rejected the Goa'uld blending. I don't know why.

21.24.10 CARTER- That's incredible.

21.25.08 ARIS BOCH- Oh yes. So incredible they wiped out most of my people because of it.

21.30.01 DANIEL- But not you.

21.31.09 ARIS BOCH (OS)- I managed to impress them. My people have always been strong and skilled.

ARIS BOCH (CONT)- That's why the Goa'uld kept the youngest as slaves and killed the rest.

21.41.11 DANIEL- Well, you could have your freedom. I mean, there must be lots of planets where the Goa'uld wouldn't find you.

**21.45.13**      **ARIS BOCH (OS)- What freedom?**

**ARIS BOCH (CONT)-** They killed my wife, but my son still lives.

**ARIS BOCH (OS CONT)-** He's a slave in one of Sokar's Naquadah mines.

ARIS BOCH (CONT)- One day I hope to capture a prize valuable enough to trade for his freedom, as well as mine.

23.53.11 O'NEILL- Yeah? (beat) Heat seeking?

24.03.12 TEAL'C- So it would seem.

24.56.10 TEAL'C- Surrender!

25.01.02 O'NEILL- Put your hand down!

25.20.14 KORRA- You are Teal'c.

KORRA (OS CONT)- The sholva.

25.24.07 O'NEILL- Is that a host?

25.26.07 KORRA (OS)- You are SG-1.

KORRA (CONT)- From Earth.

25.30.00 O'NEILL- Yeah, apparently we're well-known.

25.33.26 KORRA- My name is Korra.

25.38.09 DANIEL- We were told it was Kel'tar.

25.40.17 KORRA- No. Please help me.

25.44.24 O'NEILL- Help you?

25.45.16 KORRA- I am not Goa'uld. I am Tok'ra.

25.58.16 ARIS BOCH- I don't have to tie you to a tree or anything unpleasant like that, do I?

26.01.23        CARTER- No. (beat) What is that?

26.08.15        ARIS BOCH- Watching your friends.

26.10.18        CARTER- How?

26.12.05        ARIS BOCH- Magic.

26.15.13        CARTER- Naquadah. The, the Zat guns. That's how you track the Goa'uld. You  
                         use their own technology against them. (beat) You know, the fact that your  
                         race rejects the Goa'uld symbiote could be very valuable to us. To all  
                         humans, all over the galaxy.

CARTER (OS CONT)- It could be the key to defeating the Goa'uld.

26.36.08        ARIS BOCH- I doubt it.

26.37.20        CARTER- If-if they couldn't use us as hosts...

26.40.14        ARIS BOCH- I told you before I don't understand this immunity.

27.11.25            ARIS BOCH- That's impossible.

27.25.16            TEAL'C- His injuries are severe.

27.27.19            DANIEL- What now?

27.30.03            O'NEILL- Can you talk?

27.31.13            KORRA- Yes.

27.41.12            O'NEILL- All right. Here's what's happening. There's a guy out there –

27.45.26            KORRA- Aris Boch.

27.49.03            O'NEILL- Yeah. He's got us trapped on this planet, and he's holding a member of  
our team hostage –

27.53.26            KORRA (OS)- Samantha Carter.  
KORRA (CONT)- The daughter of Jacob, host to Selmak.

27.59.10 O'NEILL- So you're got good information.

O'NEILL (OS CONT)- Here's the deal.

O'NEILL (CONT)- He said if we can catch you, he'd let us go home.

28.06.23 KORRA- I will not allow myself to be turned over to Sokar.

28.11.07 O'NEILL- Can you prove you're a Tok'ra?

28.13.03 KORRA (OS)- I only have my word.

KORRA (CONT)- If Samantha Carter were here, she would recognize me.

28.18.26 DANIEL- Aris must have known Sam...

DANIEL (OS CONT)- ...would be able to verify whether Korra or Kel'tar or whatever  
his name is...

DANIEL (CONT)- ...is telling the truth about being a Tok'ra.

28.25.07 O'NEILL- Well, as far as I'm concerned, you could be a Goa'uld using the old "I'm a  
Tok'ra" thing to get us to help you.

28.33.11 KORRA- What did he tell you about me?

28.35.10 DANIEL- Just that your name was Kel'tar and that you were an enemy of Sokar.

- 28.38.09 KORRA (OS)- I was working in Sokar's ranks as a spy.  
KORRA (CONT)- I came to believe Sokar had learned my true identity.  
KORRA (OS CONT)- I managed to escape by stealing the cargo ship. It took me  
several weeks to travel here. The closest...  
KORRA (CONT)- ...planet with a Stargate not under Goa'uld control. Aris was  
already here guarding the Gate. He had anticipated my plan.
- 29.00.10 TEAL'C- Aris Boch claimed the vessel was his.
- 29.02.11 KORRA- It belongs to Sokar, and Aris likely plans to trade it back to him, along with  
us. All of us.
- 29.16.18 ARIS BOCH (OS)- So what's it like to have...  
ARIS BOCH (CONT)- ...one of those things bore itself in your brain and possess  
you?
- 29.22.28 CARTER (OS)- I couldn't tell you.
- 29.25.04 ARIS BOCH- Oh, come on. What are you saying?
- 29.28.07 CARTER- You wouldn't understand.
- 29.31.05 ARIS BOCH- What's the difference? They're all the same. Tok'ra... Goa'uld...

29.34.12 CARTER- Is that really what you think?

29.35.18 ARIS BOCH- They all have different stories, but the same bad blood.

29.39.10 CARTER- No. It's not true. And if you really hate the Goa'uld, you'd try and learn more about the Tok'ra.

29.46.08 ARIS BOCH- Well, I wasn't much good at school.

29.50.05 CARTER- Well, trying to defeat the Goa'uld is better than the alternative.

CARTER (OS CONT)- What?

CARTER (CONT)- What is so funny?

29.57.18 ARIS BOCH- Oh, the whole thing is amusing when you know just how insurmountable the task is. Defeating the Goa'uld.

ARIS BOCH (OS CONT)- Yeah. Ooo, admirable, mmm...

ARIS BOCH (CONT)- But amusing.

30.10.00 CARTER (OS)- If enough of the...

CARTER (CONT)- ...right allies worked together, the task might not be so insurmountable.

30.14.13 ARIS BOCH- You mean me. Well, I couldn't help you as much as you think.



30.18.15 CARTER- You mean you won't. (beat) You know what I think? I think you care.

CARTER (OS CONT)- And I don't think you like...

CARTER (CONT)- ...what you do nearly as much as you pretend to.

30.34.00 ARIS BOCH- I think you should shut up.

30.54.00 CARTER- What is that?

30.58.16 ARIS BOCH- Water.

31.00.07 CARTER- What you put in it.

31.04.16 ARIS BOCH- Flavor.

31.10.08 KORRA- Aris told you about his wife and son?

31.12.07 O'NEILL- Oh yeah.

31.13.09 KORRA- It's a lie. He has none. Never did.

31.18.00 DANIEL- So why does he do this?

31.19.20 O'NEILL- Greed.

31.20.19 KORRA- Not exactly. It is true that his race cannot be used as hosts. And most  
were slaughtered by the Goa'uld.

KORRA (OS CONT)- Those that were kept alive were addicted to a substance...

KORRA (CONT)- ...called Roshna. It was given to them in their water.

31.36.21 O'NEILL- That blue stuff?

31.38.14 KORRA- Now after many generations, Aris Boch.s race cannot live without the  
Roshna. They depend on it.

KORRA (OS CONT)- It keeps them subservient.

KORRA (CONT)- If he stops taking the Roshna, he will die.

31.55.14 DANIEL- So whatever the reason, he has no choice?

31.57.16 KORRA (OS)- I do not defend him.

KORRA (CONT)- Aris Boch has endeared himself to the Goa'uld by being  
unscrupulous.

KORRA (OS CONT)- He indiscriminately hunts both guilty and innocent,...

KORRA (CONT)- ...only caring about whether they have any trading value.

32.11.11 O'NEILL- Well, we have to get Carter away from him.

32.14.24 KORRA- Does this mean you believe me?

- 32.16.25 O'NEILL- Not just yet. But I'm starting to get that choiceless feeling all over again.
- 32.23.05 KORRA- I cannot be turned over to Sokar. He has methods of extracting  
information.  
KORRA (OS CONT)- There are other Tok'ra operatives in his midst who I will not  
betray.
- 32.35.01 O'NEILL- I understand. Can you walk?
- 32.44.11 KORRA (OS)- I will not burden you.
- 32.46.11 TEAL'C (OS)- It is no burden.
- 32.47.10 KORRA- You must leave your weapons.
- 32.49.01 O'NEILL- Why?
- 32.49.22 KORRA- Aris can track them. As long as you carry Goa'uld technology, he will know  
our position.
- 33.01.16 O'NEILL- Great.
- 33.13.24 CARTER (OS)- What's wrong?

33.14.19            ARIS BOCH- I don't see them, and they're not moving. Either the Goa'uld got them,  
                         or they're not playing by the rules.

33.20.17            CARTER- So what does that mean?

33.48.07            O'NEILL- It's a trap.

33.50.24            TEAL'C- I will go.

33.51.16            O'NEILL- No, no... I will.

33.55.26            DANIEL- What are we supposed to do?

33.58.06            O'NEILL- Well, he's gonna have to show himself eventually. Can you take him?

34.05.01            TEAL'C- I can.

34.09.02            O'NEILL- All right...

34.26.11            O'NEILL- Carter... Carter... Where is he?

35.15.22            O'NEILL- Carter... Car...

O'NEILL (OS CONT)- Carter... Come on... You passed out again.

O'NEILL (CONT)- You all right?

35.30.21 CARTER- Yeah. What'd I miss?

35.32.06 O'NEILL- Oh, not too much. Oh, by the way... The Goa'uld Aris wanted us to catch,

- CARTER (CONT)- ...the Tok'ra are not the same.
- 37.08.16 ARIS BOCH- Well, Sokar's on his way.
- 37.11.05 O'NEILL- Are you having second thoughts here...?

- 37.14.12            ARIS BOCH- I have to give him something.
- 37.17.02            TEAL'C- Take me.
- 37.23.10            O'NEILL- Forget it.
- 37.24.08            TEAL'C (OS)- I am the most...  
TEAL'C (CONT)- ...valuable in trade, next to the Tok'ra.
- 37.26.20            O'NEILL- I don't care.
- 37.30.08            TEAL'C- I will go. Take me.
- 37.39.07            ARIS BOCH- That will be Sokar.
- 37.49.16            ARIS BOCH- Okay. Brief moment of weakness. Teal'c comes with me.
- 37.54.17            O'NEILL (OS)- That just...  
O'NEILL (CONT)- ...is not gonna happen.
- 37.57.02            ARIS BOCH (OS)- No other way. Last chance...  
ARIS BOCH (CONT)- ...to take that Tok'ra and get the hell out. You might need  
this.

38.08.01            CARTER- The missing piece of the DHD. Teal'c...

38.13.28            TEAL'C- We are choiceless.

38.16.12            O'NEILL- We'll find you.

38.18.28            ARIS BOCH- Oh, this is so beautiful. Really, I'm starting to tear up here, you know?  
                         But we gotta go. Now.

38.54.05            ARIS BOCH- Here we go.

39.12.10            KORRA- What happened?

39.15.02            DANIEL- Teal'c went in your place.

39.24.03            O'NEILL- Come on. Let's get outta here.

39.35.09            ARIS BOCH- It's a pretty noble thing you're doing.

39.37.24            TEAL'C- You have made a sacrifice as well.

39.40.25            ARIS BOCH- I guess I never knew the Tok'ra were different, you know? (beat) So  
                         what made you betray Apophis?



39.50.00           TEAL'C- The Goa'ulds are enslavers of worlds. The humans value freedom.

39.53.28           ARIS BOCH (OS)- Well, you don't really think...

ARIS BOCH (CONT)- ...the Tok'ra and the humans have a chance a overthrowing  
the Goa'uld, do you?

39.59.00           TEAL'C- I do.

40.02.00           ARIS BOCH- I don't think so.

40.03.23           TEAL'C- I would rather serve with those willing to die trying.

40.13.13           ARIS BOCH- I really don't want to do this. I hate the Goa'uld as much as you do.

40.35.11           CARTER- Oh my God...

40.37.25           O'NEILL- What the hell...?

40.43.17           KORRA- Escape pods!

40.56.26           O'NEILL- Where's Teal'c?

40.58.08           TEAL'C- I am here, O'Neill.

41.00.24 O'NEILL- Yes!

41.02.06 DANIEL- You okay?

41.03.17 TEAL'C- I will be fine.
