01.18.25           O'NEILL (OS)- Yeah.

O'NEILL (CONT)- A bit pretentious, don't you think?

01.22.04           MARTOUF- You must understand when I say...

MARTOUF (OS CONT)- that if Selmak is still alive,...

MARTOUF (CONT)- he has been sent to Hell.

01.28.27           O'NEILL- As in...?

01.30.16           MARTOUF (OS)- A place of eternal suffering...

MARTOUF (CONT)- and damnation from which there is no return.

02.47.14           O'NEILL (OS)- So...

O'NEILL (CONT)- What are we really talking about here?

02.48.00        EPISODE TITLE READS:  
                     JOLINAR’S MEMORIES

02.51.01        MARTOUF- Netu is a moon that orbits Sokar’s home planet.

02.54.08        O’NEILL- A very hot moon, I take it.

02.56.12        MARTOUF- It is indeed a place where fires burn strong.

02.58.24        CARTER- But you know for sure that my father is still alive?

03.03.02        MARTOUF- I am sorry, Samantha. I know this must be difficult. Once captured,  
                     Selmak and Jacob, your father, would have been brutally tortured.  
MARTOUF (OS CONT)- But Sokar would rather see his victims suffer than die.

03.15.00        O’NEILL- So we’re talking about a rescue mission here?

03.17.21        MARTOUF- Unfortunately, to our knowledge, no one has ever escaped from Netu.

03.22.19        O’NEILL- Oh.

03.25.17        MARTOUF- No one except for Jolinar.

03.30.16        CARTER- Oh.

03.32.03 DANIEL (VO)- Of course. It makes sense.

DANIEL (CONT)- A Goa'uld impersonating the devil would naturally create a place like Netu.

DANIEL (OS CONT)- Netu is from the book of Am-Taut, which is kind of a...

DANIEL (CONT)- how-to guide on passing through the ancient Egyptian "Other World" regions. And many of those regions are described as dark places with pits of fire, home to hellish monsters and the damned.

03.49.20 MARTOUF (OS)- What little we know is largely based...

MARTOUF (CONT)- on the legends that have been perpetuated by Sokar himself.

03.55.24 O'NEILL- How did Jolinar get out?

03.57.24 MARTOUF- She never said.

03.59.01 DANIEL (OS)- No one ever asked her how she...

DANIEL (CONT)- escaped from an inescapable prison?

04.03.25 MARTOUF- She was found unconscious and badly injured in a teltac, a cargo ship, floating adrift in space.

MARTOUF (OS CONT)- Her recovery was long and painful.

MARTOUF (CONT)- She was encouraged to remember how she escaped, but she refused to speak of it.

04.15.27 O'NEILL- Anyone curious as to why?

04.18.18 MARTOUF- I implored her, but she would not say.

04.20.25 CARTER (OS)- I only carried Jolinar for a short time.

CARTER (CONT)- I've never had anything more than scattered flashes of her memories, occasionally some dreams. But certainly never anything like this place you're describing.

04.31.18 MARTOUF- The Tok'ra have technology that aids in the recall of memories, but you must be willing to use it.

04.37.08 O'NEILL (OS)- Well... If we're...

O'NEILL (CONT)- going in on this one, sir, we're going to need a couple more units.

04.41.21 MARTOUF (OS)- A full military incursion...

MARTOUF (CONT)- will be impossible, Colonel O'Neill.

04.45.21 O'NEILL- We do covert.

04.48.20           MARTOUF- Selmak's recovery is obviously a high priority. However, and forgive me, Samantha...

MARTOUF (OS CONT)- But there is something larger at stake here.

MARTOUF (CONT)- The Tok'ra believe that Sokar is about to launch a massive attack against the System Lords.

05.03.10           O'NEILL- Isn't that good news?

05.04.26           TEAL'C (OS)- The chaotic and feudal...

TEAL'C (CONT)- disorganization of the System Lords' fragmented rule is a far more vulnerable target than that of one powerful Goa'uld.

05.11.14           MARTOUF- Especially if that Goa'uld is Sokar.

05.13.21           HAMMOND- He's really that much worse than the others?

05.15.21           DANIEL- Of all the gods he picked to impersonate, he chose The Devil.

05.18.27           MARTOUF (OS)- We need to find Selmak and determine what information...

MARTOUF (CONT)- he has gathered about Sokar's planned attack.

MARTOUF (OS CONT)- Without wanting to sound overly dramatic,...

MARTOUF (CONT)- the fate of the Galaxy may be at stake.

05.29.11 O'NEILL (OS)- Sounds a bit...  
O'NEILL (CONT)- overly dramatic.

05.32.04 HAMMOND (OS)- Sounds like we can't refuse.  
HAMMOND (CONT)- Colonel, you have a go.

05.36.21 O'NEILL- Yeah.

05.37.10 CARTER- When do we leave?

05.38.06 MARTOUF (OS)- As soon as you're ready.  
MARTOUF (CONT)- If you all are sure you understand what you are volunteering  
for.

05.45.05 DANIEL- You said Hell, right?

05.47.14 O'NEILL- Well, I'm gonna end up there sooner or later. Might as well check out the  
neighborhood, huh?

06.09.15 MARTOUF- The teltac we will require for the journey awaits us on the planet Vorash.

06.14.07 O'NEILL- Ship?



06.15.18           MARTOUF- There is no Stargate on Netu.  
MARTOUF (OS CONT)- Those banished there are taken by ship.

06.20.14           O'NEILL- Have I mentioned to you that I hate surprises?

06.24.10           MARTOUF- We have a long journey ahead of us. There'll be much time to inform  
you of all the details.

06.28.27           O'NEILL- Now, see... That puts me in a position to be surprised.

06.32.08           TECHNICIAN- Chevron seven is locked.

06.36.04           HAMMOND- Major... You will bring your father back safely.

06.40.13           O'NEILL- Yes, sir. We will.

07.04.00           CARTER- This ship looks familiar.

07.05.11           MARTOUF- This is the same teltac in which Jolinar was found adrift. It was  
extensively damaged when we found it. The essential flight mechanisms have  
been repaired. However, the hyperdrive engines can only be run at forty  
percent without too much risk.

07.28.07           TEAL'C- Is this vessel equipped with stealth capabilities?

07.32.09 CARTER- The ship we were in could make itself invisible.

07.34.25 MARTOUF- Really?

07.35.23 O'NEILL- It was an upgrade. You're obviously dealing with a base model here.

07.42.28 MARTOUF- Are you sure you can fly a ship such as this?

07.45.00 TEAL'C- With great proficiency.

07.46.22 MARTOUF- While we're on the surface, you may have to avoid Sokar's forces.

07.50.27 DANIEL- What, isn't Teal'c coming with us?

07.53.00 MARTOUF- He cannot.

MARTOUF (OS CONT)- The atmosphere around the moon is impenetrable by ship.

MARTOUF (CONT)- The only way to reach the surface is in the descent pods. It is  
how...

MARTOUF (OS CONT)- all the damned are sent to Netu by Sokar, and it is how we  
must also arrive if we're to...

MARTOUF (CONT)- convince other denizens we can be trusted.

08.06.27 CARTER- And there are only four pods?

08.09.06           MARTOUF- Correct.

08.10.22           O'NEILL- This counts as a surprise, you know.

08.15.12           MARTOUF- Shall we embark?

08.17.20           O'NEILL- By all means. To Hell with us.

08.46.16           DANIEL- So what else can you tell us about Netu?

08.49.19           MARTOUF- The moon was once an industrialized...

MARTOUF (OS CONT)- colony of the planet Delmak.

MARTOUF (CONT)- When Sokar conquered Delmak, he made it his home world.

He transformed the moon's environments to suit the myths.

08.58.26           O'NEILL- Sounds like he went to an awful lot of trouble.

09.01.07           MARTOUF- He filled the atmosphere with barely breathable toxins,...

MARTOUF (OS CONT)- then blasted numerous holes in the moon's...

MARTOUF (CONT)- surface, releasing the molten core. (TO CARTER) As I apply  
the memory device, you will feel a sharp pain.

09.13.17           CARTER- We've actually all experienced this technology before.

09.17.03           MARTOUF- Good. Then you wil know what to expect.

09.25.09           DANIEL (OS)- So we're actually gonna see Jolinar's...  
DANIEL (CONT)- memories appear as holographic images?

09.30.09           MARTOUF- There are no specific ways of targeting certain memories. Some of  
Samantha's own personal memories may come out. Out of repsect for her  
privacy, we will not be using this part of the technology.

09.40.27           CARTER- Thank you.

09.42.10           MARTOUF- You can describe what you see.

09.45.17           CARTER- I'm ready.

09.55.18           JACOB (ECHO FX)- Sam?

09.56.10           CARTER AT 15 (ECHO FX)- In here.

10.04.00           CARTER AT 15 (ECHO FX)- Why are you crying?

10.09.08           CARTER AT 15 (ECHO FX)- Where's Mom?

10.15.00           CARTER- Oh God...

10.19.23           MARTOUF- Listen to me, Samantha...

10.22.23           CARTER- I'm sorry. I'm stuck in my own past.

10.24.23           MARTOUF (OS)- Think of Jolinar.

MARTOUF (CONT)- The last night we spent together before she was captured by  
                          Sokar,...

MARTOUF (OS CONT)- we walked along the ridge of Noctana.

MARTOUF (CONT)- There were two moons out that night.

10.47.25           CARTER- I see it.

10.56.24           CARTER- You didn't speak of Jolinar leaving.

CARTER (OS CONT)- You both knew it was dangerous, but she had to go.

11.19.26           CARTER- You stayed up all night together.

11.56.20           CARTER- Martouf...

11.58.10           MARTOUF- Are you okay?

11.59.12           CARTER- I want to try it again.

12.02.02 MARTOUF- I should have said this earlier. I know my personal relationship with Jolinar is a source of discomfort for you.

12.10.09 CARTER- Martouf...

12.11.05 MARTOUF- I, I would just like you to know. It has always been my belief that Jolinar kept her experience on Netu a secret because she believed it might come between us. I don't want you to hold anything back for the same reason. You don't have to protect me.

12.27.17 CARTER- Okay.

12.44.18 JOLINAR/CARTER- (screams)

12.51.00 CARTER- (screams) Shut it off! Shut it off!

12.57.28 O'NEILL- Do it!

13.07.13 CARTER- I... I saw someone. A dark figure. I think it was Sokar. The pain was...

13.18.14 MARTOUF- I am sorry. The memory technology...

MARTOUF (OS CONT)- can provide very realistic sensory recall.

13.25.04 CARTER- She was tortured... so badly.

13.34.20           MARTOUF- I am going to turn it on again...  
MARTOUF (OS CONT)- But at a lower setting.

13.52.20           CARTER- She was on a ship like this one.  
CARTER (OS CONT)- They put her in a descent pod.  
CARTER (CONT)- There was a fire. All around. It was hard to breathe.

14.21.02           CARTER- It’s gone. (beat) I lost it.

14.25.04           MARTOUF- We will arrive soon.

14.26.08           CARTER (OS)- I know, Martouf.  
CARTER (CONT)- I’m sorry.  
CARTER (OS CONT)- Maybe I’m not gonna be able to do this.

14.33.00           MARTOUF- You have to.

14.36.02           O’NEILL (OS)- Hey, Marty...  
O’NEILL (CONT)- A word?

14.52.16           O’NEILL- You’re pushing a little hard, don’t you think?

14.55.00           MARTOUF- There is not much time left.

14.56.19 O'NEILL- It's her father. She knows the stakes.

15.00.08 MARTOUF- If she does not remember Jolinar's method of escape, I will not ask any  
of you to accompany me down to the surface.

15.07.15 O'NEILL- Why?

15.08.07 MARTOUF- Because anyone who goes down there will likely not return.

15.11.14 O'NEILL- But you're gonna go?

15.12.10 MARTOUF- I will attempt to locate Selmak and communicate any relevant  
information to you. You will then return to Vorash and relay it to the Tok'ra.

15.18.14 O'NEILL- And leave you and Jacob down there to – what – rot?

15.22.24 MARTOUF- With no means of escape...

15.25.02 O'NEILL- All right. First of all, Carter's not gonna let you go without her. Secondly, I  
won't let it happen. Thirdly, Jolinar escaped –

15.33.09 MARTOUF- But if Samantha cannot recall how –



15.35.08 O’NEILL- I know. I heard you. And forgive the bravado. But it’s been done before... it can be done again.

15.51.13 DANIEL- You gonna be okay?

15.53.26 CARTER- Yeah. It’s just so confusing, you know. Images and faces. Fragments of thoughts and feelings... There was a Goa’uld on Netu. Not Sokar. He was, uh... Let’s just say he was less than attractive. I know his name, but I just can’t find it. But I get this horrible, sick feeling when I remember him.

16.29.10 DANIEL- Something happened between him and Jolinar.

16.33.09 CARTER- Something worse than the torture and pain. (beat) Something Jolinar never wanted Martouf to find out about.

17.04.19 TEAL’C- We have arrived at the coordinates.

17.11.23 MARTOUF- You must keep the disc concealed from any denizens...

MARTOUF (OS CONT)- we may encounter.

MARTOUF (CONT)- I will leave it on a minimal setting so that you may continue to work...

MARTOUF (OS CONT)- through Jolinar’s memories as we go.

MARTOUF (CONT)- Is that okay?

17.24.00 CARTER- Yeah, of course.

17.25.10 O'NEILL (OS)- Carter?

17.26.08 CARTER- Thank you.

17.29.05 MARTOUF- Sokar would not send someone down to Netu with weapons.

17.32.13 O'NEILL- Yeah, so?

17.34.06 MARTOUF- If they're discovered on you, the denizens will know that we were not  
sent by Sokar.

MARTOUF (OS CONT)- We must attempt to blend, in the hope that we will be  
allowed...

MARTOUF (CONT)- to move about freely as denizens.

17.42.23 O'NEILL- Okay. We'll attempt to blend. But we're not going down there unarmed.  
(beat) So, how do we communicate with Teal'c?

17.51.26 MARTOUF- We believe this device...

MARTOUF (OS CONT)- will penetrate the atmosphere.

17.58.02 O'NEILL- "We believe"?

17.59.20 MARTOUF- We should be able to speak to Teal'c as long as the ship remains in orbit of the moon.

18.20.25 DANIEL (OS)- That's, uh... That's still...

DANIEL (CONT)- a long way down.

18.24.04 MARTOUF- The pods are launched at a great velocity.

18.28.16 DANIEL- And that's supposed to make me feel better...?

18.31.00 MARTOUF (OS)- They are equipped...

MARTOUF (CONT)- with heat dampening shields and antigravity wave generators  
that will slow our descent.

18.37.28 O'NEILL- So... Smooth sailing all the way, right?

18.42.03 TEAL'C- Not exactly, O'Neill.

19.03.10      TEAL'C- Are you prepared?

19.05.02 O'NEILL- Uh, no. Not really.

19.31.07 TEAL'C (INTO RADIO)- O'Neill, can you hear me?

19.33.14 O'NEILL (VO ON RADIO FILTERED)- Read you, Teal'c.

19.40.04 TEAL'C (INTO RADIO)- You are now entering the atmosphere. (beat) Colonel  
O'Neill? (beat) O'Neill, can you hear me?

20.30.10 O'NEILL- CARTER?! DANIEL?!

20.35.00 DANIEL (OS)- Over here!

20.44.04 CARTER- This way!

20.45.18 O'NEILL- Let's move!

21.05.11 DANIEL- My lungs are burning.

21.07.24 O'NEILL- Well, at least it's a dry heat.

21.21.22 TEAL'C (VO ON RADIO FILTERED)- Colonel O'Neill, respond.

21.27.09 O'NEILL (INTO RADIO)- Yeah, Teal'c. We're in one piece.  
O'NEILL (OS CONT INTO RADIO)- Just hang tight and we'll be in touch.

21.35.01 CARTER- We should follow this tunnel.

21.37.12           MARTOUF- You remember.

21.38.18           CARTER- Being here has helped. This should lead us to the...

CARTER (OS CONT)- underground remains of the old colony.

CARTER (CONT)- It’s one of the only inhabitable places left.

22.06.23           DANIEL- Is it me, or is it...

DANIEL (OS CONT)- actually getting hotter in here?

22.09.24           O’NEILL- Uh...

O’NEILL (OS CONT)- A little of both probably.

22.12.24           CARTER- There’s something up ahead. (beat) This way.

22.35.09           O’NEILL- Well. It’s certainly not Emerald City.

23.00.21           O’NEILL- Howdy, folks. We’re, uh, new in these parts. I know that’s hard to tell, but  
it’s true.

23.19.04           O’NEILL- Carter?

23.36.00           CARTER- Bynarr.

23.43.06           DANIEL- What does that mean?

24.39.09 CARTER- I do! (beat) I'm Samantha Carter, host of Jolinar of Malksur.

24.51.21           BYNARR (distorted)- Take their weapons! Throw them in the pit!

25.06.02           O'NEILL (OS)- Of course. The pit.

25.19.20           O'NEILL- Thank you!

25.26.08           O'NEILL- Mmm. The smells keep getting better and better, don't they?

25.35.06           DANIEL- This, uh, doesn't look encouraging.  
DANIEL (OS CONT)- I thought Sokar wouldn't allow any weapons. So far we've  
                          seen a...  
DANIEL (CONT)- staff weapon and a hand device.

25.53.00           MARTOUF- I do not understand it myself.

25.55.02           O'NEILL- Surprise, surprise.

25.57.20           CARTER (OS)- Bynarr is Sokar's appointed leader.  
CARTER (CONT)- He is permitted a hand device and one staff weapon for his First  
                          Prime.

26.04.11           MARTOUF- What made you think Bynarr would be sympathetic to Jolinar?

26.08.19           CARTER- I was sure he was the one that helped her escape.

26.12.07 O'NEILL- Why?

26.15.12 CARTER- She, um... (beat) I'm sorry. (beat) Look, he's the key. Now, Bynarr  
might not have knowingly helped Jolinar, but I'm sure he must know how she  
escaped.

26.37.07 JACOB (OS)- Sam...?  
JACOB (CONT)- Sam...?

26.42.06 CARTER- Dad...? Dad! Dad!

26.52.00 JACOB- Am I dreaming?

26.53.12 CARTER- No. No, we're real.

26.57.17 JACOB- Are you crazy?

27.00.08 O'NEILL- Uh, apparently.

27.03.19 CARTER- Are you okay?

27.05.22 JACOB- I've been better.

27.10.02 MARTOUF- Selmak?



27.12.11 JACOB- He's dying.

27.17.19 MARTOUF- This will help.

27.28.00 CARTER- Hang in there. We're gonna get you out of here.

27.32.17 O'NEILL- Marty...

27.41.17 CARTER- Thank you.

27.45.14 O'NEILL- Is he gonna make it?

27.49.27 MARTOUF- Not here. Unless we get him out of this place soon, he will die.

28.00.26 CARTER- It's okay. I'm here.

28.30.20 BYNARR (distorted)- I am humbled by your presence, my Lord, Sokar.

28.35.12 SOKAR (distorted) (OS)- Bynarr, lord of Netu, I do not have time to hear of the  
sufferings of the damned on this day.

28.43.20 BYNARR (distorted)- Allow me to offer thanks for returning the Tok'ra...  
BYNARR (distorted) (OS CONT)- Jolinar, the one who betrayed me,...  
BYNARR (distorted) (CONT)- so that I may seek my revenge.

- 28.51.16            SOKAR (distorted) (OS)- Of what do you speak?
- 28.53.26            BYNARR (distorted)- She arrived today with three others.
- 29.04.16            SOKAR (distorted)- I did not send her to you.  
SOKAR (distorted) (OS CONT)- They are intruders. Find out what they want...  
SOKAR (distorted) (CONT)- and then kill them.
- 29.15.05            BYNARR (distorted)- I had hoped to take my revenge on Jolinar slowly, my lord. To  
                              see her suffer in the harshest ways of the damned.
- 29.23.22            SOKAR (distorted) (OS)- Go now!  
SOKAR (distorted) (CONT)- Report back to me in one day. (beat) Heed my  
                              command.

31.39.06 CARTER- If I can just get close to Bynarr, talk to him...

31.42.00 NA'ONAK (distorted)- Move!

31.48.14 O'NEILL- Yeah. Okay. Go ahead.

31.53.00 CARTER- Look after my dad.

32.48.00 BYNARR (OS)- (something in another language)

33.24.16 BYNARR (distorted)- Take it. (beat) You have no symbiote within you.

33.43.15 CARTER- No.

33.47.08 BYNARR (distorted)- How then do you know of Jolinar?

33.50.01 CARTER- I once carried her.

33.51.23 BYNARR (distorted) (OS)- I should have known.  
BYNARR (distorted) (CONT)- Jolinar would have died on the surface before she  
showed her face to me again.

34.00.11 CARTER- Because she betrayed you.

34.04.03 BYNARR (distorted)- Look what Sokar took from me because of her. (beat) Where  
is she now?

34.14.11 CARTER- She's dead.

34.16.17 BYNARR (distorted)- You know how she escaped.

34.19.19 CARTER- I don't. I don't remember.

34.22.19           BYNARR (distorted)- Why have you come here?

34.35.09           JACOB- Sam...?

34.38.14           O’NEILL- She’ll be back.

34.40.04           JACOB- Where is she?

34.41.09           DANIEL- She’s with Bynarr.

34.43.01           JACOB- Oh no...

34.44.10           MARTOUF (OS)- Samantha believes...  
MARTOUF (CONT)- Bynarr is the key to our escape.
