- 12.54.18 MALE VOICE (OS)-Yeah?
- 12.59.12 MAYBOURNE (INTO PHONE)-Maybourne.

- 13.01.12 CARTER (INTO PHONE)-This is Major Samantha Carter. We have a foothold situation.
- 13.04.19 MAYBOURNE (INTO PHONE)-Major Carter? Where are you?
- 13.08.14 CARTER (INTO PHONE)-I can't tell you that, sir. If memory serves there's an outdoor café...

CARTER (VO THRU PHONE FILTERED)-outside N.I.D headquarters.

- 13.15.11 MAYBOURNE (INTO PHONE)-In D.C?
- 13.16.22 CARTER (INTO PHONE)-Four o'clock.
- 13.18.06 MAYBOURNE (INTO PHONE)-Uh, I'm gonna need a little more than that.
- 13.21.17 CARTER (INTO PHONE)-I repeat, we have a foothold situation.

 MAYBOURNE (OS CONT)-Major. Calm down. He's concerned for you,...
 MAYBOURNE (CONT)-that's all.

16.12.20 CARTER-I told you we had a foothold situation.

16.15.08MAYBOURNE-Major, a chemical spill causing paranoid delusion...MAYBOURNE (OS CONT)-is infinitely more plausible to me than...MAYBOURNE (CONT)-aliens taking over the SGC.

CARTER (OS CONT)-thinking.
