O'NEILL (CONT)-don't suck the fun out of this.

- 00.52.17 CARTER-Sorry, sir.
- 00.54.00 LAIRA (OS)-When I was a child,...

LAIRA (CONT)-my father told me that the fire rain was the tears of our ancestors longing to be reunited.

01.05.26 DANIEL (OS)-A falling star.

DANIEL (CONT)-That's what we call fire rain where we come from.

DANIEL (OS CONT)-In our culture you're supposed to, uh...

DANIEL (CONT)-make a wish.

- 01.16.02 TEAL'C-On Chulak we call it *Tal pat ryne*.
- 01.18.08 DANIEL-Which means, uh, falling star.
- 01.24.03 LAIRA-What do you think, Jack? Was it worth the effort?
- 01.26.23 O'NEILL (OS)-Oh yeah.

O'NEILL (CONT)-Yeah, I'm a huge fan of fireworks.

- 01.39.18 Whoa.
- 01.47.01 Carter, how close was that?

- 01.51.07 CARTER-Close, sir.
- 01.52.26 DANIEL-How big?
- 01.54.00 CARTER-Big.
- 01.55.05 DANIEL-Thought so.
- 01.56.14 CARTER-I was rather concerned for a minute there, sir.
- 02.01.24 LAIRA-I don't understand.
- 02.03.06 CARTER (OS)-Laira, that's what we call...

CARTER (CONT)-a near miss. If that meteor had struck the ground instead of bouncing off the atmosphere –

02.11.04 LAIRA (OS)-Yes.

02.25.29 CARTER-I'll make some more observations tonight, sir.

- 02.28.25 DANIEL-I'm gonna check the geological record in the morning.
- 02.32.23 O'NEILL-I'll... make a wish.

02.43.10 FADE TO BLACK. BEGIN OPENING CREDIT SEQUENCE

04.12.10 CARTER-See this bright dot? It represents your world, Edora.

CARTER (OS CONT)-Now, it orbits your sun in a big circle, like this, and it crosses through an asteroid belt up here at its widest point. Now, as you pass...

CARTER (CONT)-through the millions of tiny rocks and particles, some of them burn up in Edora's atmosphere.

04.27.01 LAIRA-As fire rain.

04.27.27 CARTER-Exactly. The problem is, the asteroid belt isn't uniform,... CARTER (OS CONT)-so certain orbits in certain years must pass through a denser debris field.

CARTER (CONT)-Can you ever remember the fire rain striking the ground?

04.39.07 LAIRA-Not in my lifetime – nor in my father's – but there is a tale of the ancestor's, that on the second day of the fire rain,...

LAIRA (OS CONT)-there was a distant thunder,...

LAIRA (CONT)-and the horizon burned as though the sun never set.

- 04.52.19 CARTER-How long ago was that?
- 04.54.02 LAIRA-Many, many years ago.

04.57.07 O'NEILL-Mornin', campers. O'NEILL (OS CONT)-Who's goin' on Daniel's... O'NEILL (CONT)-little geology field trip?

05.02.18 LAIRA (OS)-Garan.

05.08.22 Garan can show you the way to the caves.

LAIRA (CONT)-He and a young girl go there from time to time, though I don't know why.

05.14.02 GARAN (OS)-Mother.

05.17.01 LAIRA (OS)-Fair day, and be well.

05.22.12 CARTER (OS)-Sir, I'd like to go...

CARTER (CONT)-to Earth and input the data I collected from last night's observations into the basis mainframe.

- 05.28.05 O'NEILL-Go ahead.
- 05.30.24 CARTER-Fair day, Laira.
- 05.32.05 LAIRA (OS)-Fair day.
- 05.36.14 LAIRA (CONT)-I'm sure you want to discuss the treaty... between our two worlds.
- 05.43.23 O'NEILL-Sure, we could do that.
- 05.50.09 DANIEL (OS)-I figure the decay rate differential...

TEAL'C (CONT)-since the last impact.

TEAL'C (OS CONT)-I see no...

TEAL'C (CONT)-reason to withhold the truth from these people, Daniel Jackson.

06.52.03 GARAN-Is there anything we can do to stop it?

06.55.02 DANIEL-No.

07.17.09 CARTER (OS)-As far as we know, these are the only...

CARTER (CONT)-descendants of a people brought to Edora by the Goa'uld thousands of years ago. There may be only a small number of strikes locally. If that's the case we can send them home in a few days. If not, we'd be saving the last of a people, sir.

07.49.28 LAIRA-Paynan, this is Jack.

07.55.17 PAYNAN (OS)-They say you've come through the stone ring. Hard thing to ask a man to believe.

08.02.05 O'NEILL-I know what you mean. Any luck?

08.10.14 PAYNAN-There's nothing more than meets the eye here. Our fields, those few buildings,...

PAYNAN (OS CONT)-our children. What we have,...

PAYNAN (CONT)-we need.

08.20.24 O'NEILL-We're only interested in fair trades.

08.36.06 LAIRA-Many of my people are most curious to know what it is we have that you could possibly want.

08.42.16 O'NEILL-Well, you remember how excited Carter got the day we got here?

08.46.08 LAIRA-Something in our soil.

08.47.18 O'NEILL-That's a mineral called naquada. We don't have it on Earth. It's, you know, it's very important to us.

- 08.54.01 LAIRA-Why?
- 08.56.03 O'NEILL-It's powerful.
- 08.54.14 LAIRA-And in return for taking this naquada from our soil?

09.03.28 O'NEILL-Well, there are a lot of things we could help you out with. Medicine, technology, education. We'd become friends.

- 09.12.00 LAIRA-We're already friends.
- 09.14.13 O'NEILL-Closer friends?

09.17.03 LAIRA-My mother taught me to be wary of men wishing to be closer friends.

09.21.12 O'NEILL-Well, if you'd like, I'll negotiate this treaty with your mother. That way there'd be no conflict of interest –

- 09.30.12 LAIRA-I've never seen the fire rain in the light of day.
- 09.40.07 O'NEILL (INTO RADIO)-Anybody else see that?

09.41.22 CARTER (INTO RADIO)-This is Carter, sir. I did. I think it's just the beginning, sir.

09.50.04 DANIEL (OS)-Look at this. DANIEL (CONT)-It's a cooking utensil. Which probably means at some point a number of people spent time here.

10.01.25 TEAL'C-Perhaps this cave provided a means for a small number of Edorans to survive the last meteor bombardment.

10.08.12 GARAN-The ancestors.

10.10.10 O'NEILL (VO THRU RADIO FILTERED)-Teal'c, Daniel – back to the village ASAP.

10.13.07 TEAL'C (INTO RADIO)-Understood, O'Neill.

- 17.26.28 HAMMOND-Shut it down.

17.31.20 HAMMOND (OS)-Until you can provide me...
HAMMOND (CONT)-with answers to this problem, the rescue mission is scrubbed.
HAMMOND (OS CONT)-Inform our visitors they'll be staying with us...
HAMMOND (CONT)-until we can make a proper assessment of our situation.

CARTER (CONT)-the molten naquada hardened just above the event horizon.

- 21.58.10 DANIEL-Like an iris.
- 22.00.09 CARTER-Yeah.
- 22.04.08 HAMMOND-Sergeant, shut it down.
- 22.06.00 TECHNICIAN-Yes, sir.

22.09.09 HAMMOND-That was our last shot, people, and I'm calling this one. As of right now I'm officially declaring him missing in action.

- 22.15.18 TEAL'C-General Hammond, perhaps the door can be reached by another means.
- 22.17.23 DANIEL-That's right. The Tok'ra could send a ship.
- 22.19.12 CARTER (OS)-Or the...

CARTER (CONT)- Tollen.

22.20.13 DANIEL (OS)-Let me at least... DANIEL (CONT)-contact those of our allies that are capable of interstellar travel, see if

they're willing to help.

22.26.29 HAMMOND-Very well, Doctor.

23.09.15 LAIRA-I thought you might like a clean workshirt. My husband never wore it. I made it for him just before he died.

23.18.27 O'NEILL-There's a chance the Stargate is just buried –

23.20.17 LAIRA (OS OVERLAPPING)-We have to rebuild... LAIRA (CONT)-before the harvest, and there are very few of us now.

23.51.07 HAMMOND (OS)-Wormhole physics --...

HAMMOND (CONT)-a field, Major, that you pioneered, -- states that under these conditions ordinary matter won't even re-integrate on the other side. There's no way to overcome that.

- 24.01.11 CARTER-I think there is, sir. And I'm not the one who thought of it. Sokar did.
- 24.05.15 HAMMOND-Sokar?
- 24.06.04 CARTER (OS)-Yes, sir,...

CARTER (CONT)-when he tried to breath the iris by bombarding it with a particle beam. Subatomic particles, barely small enough to re-integrate, produced energy as they decayed. 24.15.19 HAMMOND-Which caused the iris to heat up.

### 24.16.29 CARTER (OS)-Exactly.

CARTER (CONT)-Now, if we could do the same thing, we could melt the hardened naquada barrier just above the event horizon and create a pocket of super heated gas.

24.25.01 HAMMOND-Then what?

24.25.21 CARTER (OS)-Well, then all we have to do is open the gate again, sir.

CARTER (CONT)-The unstable vortex it normally generates would then be allowed to expand into that pocket and create an even larger cavern.

CARTER (OS CONT)-One person...

CARTER (CONT)-might be able to go through, sir, and dig it out.

24.41.09 HAMMOND-I think we can safely assume Teal'c would volunteer. But –

24.45.15 CARTER (INTERRUPTING)-We don't have a particle beam generator, sir. We'd have to build one.
