- 00.23.02 HAMMOND- Open the iris. Have Teal'c come to the gate room.
- 00.49.11 SHAN'AUC- I mean you no harm.
- 00.51.12 O'NEILL- Bra'tac. You've done something with your hair.
- 00.56.28 HAMMOND- Identify yourself.

00.58.018 SHAN'AUC- I am Shan'auc of the Red Hills. Master Bra'tac opened the Chapa'ai, but was unable to accompany me.

01.06.16 O'NEILL- Why's that?

01.08.28 SHAN'AUC- There is much unrest. He took great risk in sending me here.

- 01.18.29 TEAL'C- Shan'auc...
- 01.22.08 O'NEILL- Friend of yours?
- 01.22.26 TEAL'C- Indeed.
- 01.32.12 SHAN'AUC- Tal ma'te, Teal'c.
- 01.36.23 TEAL'C- Tal ma'te.
- 01.44.23 O'NEILL- Uh, hm. Teal'c, how about a little introduction of some kind?

01.51.26 SHAN'AUC- There is no need. Bra'tac has told me much of the Tauri. You are O'Neill. Teal'c's apprentice.

- 02.08.01 O'NEILL- Apprentice?
- 02.10.17 SHAN'AUC (OS)- Also, a warrior of great skill and cunning.
- 02.13.15 O'NEILL- Apprentice?

02.16.23 SHAN'AUC- Hammond of Texas.

SHAN'AUC (OS CONT)- A great and strong leader among humans.

02.25.10 HAMMOND- What can we do for you?

02.26.20 SHAN'AUC- You must take me to the Tok'ra immediately. I have information that could destroy the Goa'uld.

ACT ONE

- 03.52.00 SHAN'AUC- I have found a way to communicate with my symbiote.
- 03.56.14 O'NEILL- Is that possible?
- 03.59.15 TEAL'C- It is not.

04.01.18 SHAN'AUC- That is what we were trained to believe Teal'c. The Goa'uld have no wish for the Jaffa to influence their young.

04.08.01 DANIEL- That makes sense.

04.10.00 TEAL'C- How then was this communion achieved?

04.12.01 SHAN'AUC- Within a deep state of Kelnoreem.

04.14.29 CARTER (OS)- We know that the symbiote is completely isolated... CARTER (CONT)- from the Jaffa who carries it. How can there be communication?

04.20.29 DR. FRASIER- Medically speaking the symbiote acts almost like an internal organ. DR. FRASIER (OS CONT)- There's an exchange of hormones and electrical impulses, but it's at a completely unconscious level.

04.29.19 HAMMOND- As a function of their immune system.

04.31.18 SHAN'AUC (OS)- It has taken many years, but I have raised that... SHAN'AUC (CONT)- primal communication to the conscious level.

04.36.24 DANIEL (OS)- Oh, ok... DANIEL (CONT)- assuming that you um...what do you talk about?

04.42.23 SHAN'AUC (OS)- I have convinced... SHAN'AUC (CONT)- it that the Goa'uld are evil. That it's own desires for power and domination are wrong. It is willing to join the Tok'ra and reveal all Goa'uld's secrets to them.

04.55.08 O'NEILL (OS)- Um, I...

O'NEILL (CONT)- know I'm just the apprentice at this table, but...

04.58.18 TEAL'C (OS)- Why then, not instruct this...

TEAL'C (CONT)- symbiote to deliver these secrets directly?

05.03.00 O'NEILL- Exactly.

05.03.27 SHAN'AUC (OS)- We do not communicate in words. SHAN'AUC (CONT)- It is more feelings, images, memories. It'll only be able to communicate the knowledge it was born with, once it takes a host.

05.15.24 CARTER (OS)- And, since you've convinced it...

CARTER (CONT)- that the Goa'uld are evil, it will only take a willing host.

05.21.10 SHAN'AUC- It is most urgent.

05.23.23 TEAL'C- Your symbiote is ready to take a host, even now.

05.26.23 SHAN'AUC- It is already past its time. You have my word that it will harm no one. SHAN'AUC (OS CONT)- I have convinced it to wait.

05.34.11 DR. FRASIER (OS)- Once a Goa'uld...

DR. FRASIER (CONT)- larva leaves the body, the Jaffa's immune system stops functioning. You're putting yourself at great risk.

05.40.23 SHAN'AUC- I believe that risk is worth taking. If you will take me to the Tokra... SHAN'AUC (OS CONT)- Immediately.

- 05.46.01 HAMMOND- We can't do that, I'm sorry.
- 05.51.15 SHAN'AUC- You do not believe I speak the truth.
- 05.54.03 DANIEL- No, it's not that we don't believe you.

05.55.12 TEAL'C (OS)- We do not. TEAL'C (CONT)- What you say cannot be proven.

- 05.59.26 O'NEILL- I think what Teal'c's trying to say is that...
- 06.02.05 TEAL'C- I have said precisely what I intended, O'Neill.

06.08.17 O'NEILL- Ok, I guess what I'm trying to say is, we'd like to believe you; we really would.

06.13.05 SHAN'AUC- You have my word. But, that is not enough. Then, the secrets of the Goa'uld will die with me.

06.26.06 HAMMOND- Shan'auc, please understand...

06.31.04 SHAN'AUC- I do understand, General Hammond. Bra'tac was wrong about the wisdom of the Tauri.

- 06.54.22 HAMMOND (OS)- Airmen!
- 06.56.00 TEAL'C- Do not!

07.00.08 SHAN'AUC- Tal, mak Kalma. Shel tai... shel tai...

- 07.10.23 TEAL'C- Dr. Frasier, you may now approach.
- 07.18.12 DR. FRASIER (OS)- We need to get her to the infirmary.
- 07.28.11 DR. FRASIER- She wasn't exaggerating, the symbiote is fully adult.
- 07.33.09 O'NEILL- Yeah, saw that.
- 07.34.29 HAMMOND- So her immune system is breaking down?

07.37.09 DR. FRASIER- Yes. I'm not sure how much longer this symbiote will remain before it has no choice but to seek out a new host.

DR. FRASIER (OS CONT)- That is it's primal, instinctual behavior.

DR. FRASIER (CONT)- I may have to recommend quarantine, sir.

- 07.48.29 HAMMOND- If you think so.
- 07.53.03 O'NEILL- Absolutely, sir.
- 07.56.11 SHAN'AUC- No.
- 08.03.10 DR. FRASIER- I gave you a sedative, you should be asleep.
- 08.07.00 SHAN'AUC- Kal'ma has neutralized the sedative.
- 08.10.00 DR. FRASIER- Kal'ma?
- 08.11.23 TEAL'C- It means child. The demon you carry within you, is no child.

08.18.18 SHAN'AUC- Do I not carry it within me as I would my own? SHAN'AUC (OS CONT)– Have I not taught it right from wrong as any mother would? SHAN'AUC (CONT)- You have closed your mind Teal'c. I expected more.

08.38.00 TEAL'C- May we speak privately?

08.40.21 SHAN'AUC- My symbiote has assured me that this will not happen again.

08.45.10 O'NEILL- Oh, well if the snake says so, then... who are we?

08.50.02 FREYA (OS)- I'll be right outside.

09.00.15 SHAN'AUC- The others I can understand. SHAN'AUC (OS CONT)- But, you've known me since before I went to the temple. How come you doubt me?

SHAN'AUC (CONT)- This is my life's work.

- 09.08.11 TEAL'C- A life lived in worship of the Goa'uld.
- 09.10.22 SHAN'AUC- No. I believe now, as you do, that they are false gods.

09.15.11 TEAL'C- Words from one who became a priestess of the temple.

09.18.18 SHAN'AUC- One day, as I meditated in the temple with the others, I heard the thoughts of my symbiote. Dreams that were not my own. I reached out to it with my mind and I heard it answer. Not in words, but in grotesque images...

- SHAN'AUC (OS CONT)- and pain. I realized then that the being I carried was no god. A powerful mind, yes.
- SHAN'AUC (CONT)- But, not that of a god. I dedicated my life that day, to showing it the way of peace. It understands now that the Goa'uld are an abomination. Can you not see what it is that I offer?

10.06.05 TEAL'C- Bra'tac is wise. I do not know why he would have sent you here... TEAL'C (OS CONT)-unless...

- 10.11.19 SHAN'AUC- He believes, Teal'c. How can I make you believe too?
- 10.24.26 TEAL'C- There is a way.
- 10.34.09 CARTER- How is she?

10.36.13 O'NEILL- Uh, Frasier says she has maybe a, couple of days tops. Find anything?

- 10.44.20 DANIEL- No, but Teal'c knows more on the subject than I ever will.
- 10.47.19 CARTER- He sure doesn't believe her.

10.51.11 O'NEILL- Yeah, well; there may be more than meets the eye here. I'm thinking they got history.

10.58.22 CARTER- History?

- 10.59.18 O'NEILL- Oh yeah.
- 11.02.09 DANIEL- She's a temple priestess.
- 11.04.21 O'NEILL- So?
- 11.06.27 DANIEL- So, they don't do a lot of dating.
- 11.10.00 O'NEILL- Maybe not, but there was some serious sparkage when she arrived.
- 11.15.01 CARTER- Ok, the question is, what if she's telling the truth?
- 11.19.16 O'NEILL- So what? She can't tell the Tok'ra any more than they already know... O'NEILL (OS CONT)- Can she?
- 11.24.01 CARTER- Actually sir, she can. The Tok'ra...
- 11.26.04O'NEILL (OS)- Consider themselves different...O'NEILL (CONT)- than the Goa'uld, I know. But let's call a snake a snake, shall we?

11.31.21 CARTER (OS)- Physiologically...

CARTER (CONT)- they are both parasitical and pass on their knowledge through genetic memory, yes. But, the majority of the Tok'ra left the Goa'uld gene pool over two thousand years ago.

11.41.23 DANIEL- Yeah, they probably learned a thing or two in that time.

11.44.20 CARTER- Which makes Shan'auc's symbiote very valuable, sir. To us, and to the Tok'ra.

11.50.07 O'NEILL- If Teal'c doesn't buy it, I don't buy it and there's no way to prove it ... O'NEILL (OS CONT)- so...what are you gonna do?

11.54.09 TEAL'C- O'Neill?

11.57.25 O'NEILL- Master Teal'c.

12.01.01 TEAL'C- I am in need of your assistance.

12.02.22 O'NEILL- I'm here to serve.

12.05.22 TEAL'C- Daniel Jackson. TEAL'C (OS CONT)- Major Carter. TEAL'C (CONT)- I am in need of your assistance also. 12.23.10 TEAL'C (OS)- in the deepest levels of Kelnoreem...

TEAL'C (CONT)- the heart beats at extremely long intervals. It is even possible to meditate so deeply that one may stop the heart altogether. The practice is forbidden.

- 12.27.04 CARTER- But, wouldn't your symbiote try to start it up again?
- 12.40.13 TEAL'C- That is correct. According to Shan'auc, it is only at this time communion between Jaffa and Symbiote is possible.
- 12.49.16 CARTER- Like a, uh, near death experience.
- 12.52.21 TEAL'C- That is correct.
- 12.55.00 O'NEILL- Is it dangerous?
- 12.55.28 DANIEL- Jack, he's stopping his heart.
- 12.59.04 O'NEILL- I mean, for us!

13.02.08 TEAL'C (OS)- I am unsure what will occur if...

TEAL'C (CONT)- and when commune with my symbiote is achieved. It may be necessary to restrain me.

- 13.14.03 O'NEILL- Well, knock yourself out.
- 13.43.03 TEAL'C- I believe I saw a vision of my father.
- 13.46.25 DANIEL- It's working?
- 13.51.28 TEAL'C- I will begin again.
- 14.46.06 CARTER- Medical emergency, Teal'c's quarters!
- 14.50.06 TEAL'C- That will not be necessary, Major Carter.
- 14.52.20 CARTER- Belay that last order, and stand by.
- 14.56.26 O'NEILL- Get up. What happened?
- 15.03.11 TEAL'C- I received a vision from my symbiote. It was a memory it chose to share. Its hatred for me is great.
- 15.14.06 CARTER- Then it is possible. Shan'auc is telling the truth.
- 15.22.12 TEAL'C- Yes. Yes.

ACT TWO

- 15.37.11 ANISE- The great queen, Egeria. She broke from the Goa'uld over two thousand years ago. Her offspring became the Tok'ra.
- 15.47.09 DANIEL- Egeria, Roman goddess of fountains.
- 15.50.04 O'NEILL- Fountains?
- 15.51.06 DANIEL- Also, childbirth.
- 15.54.21 O'NEILL- How do those two go together?
- 15.56.00 DANIEL- It doesn't matter. Um, she was also advisor to Numa Pompilius, a legendary ruler.
- 16.02.20 ANISE (OS)- Correct...

ANISE (CONT)- Doctor Jackson. Egeria came to Tauri to stop the Goa'uld from taking humans through the Stargate as slaves. Ra found her and killed her, but not before she spawned our movement.

- 16.13.12 CARTER- Literally.
- 16.14.14 ANISE- Yes.

- 16.15.16 O'NEILL- Thanks for the image.
- 16.17.09 HAMMOND- Then the original number of Tok'ra is all you have?
- 16.20.01 ANISE- Very few Goa'uld came over to our side, but none in the past few hundred years.
 - ANISE (OS CONT)- Our numbers have diminished as symbiotes unable to find new hosts died or fell in battle.

ANISE (CONT)- That is why Shan'auc's offer is so provocative. Until the symbiote is blended with a host, we cannot be sure of the outcome. But, if what she claims is correct, we could one day increase our numbers.

- 16.43.25 HAMMOND- So, you've decided to accept her offer?
- 16.46.06 ANISE- I will make the proposal to the council with my recommendation.
- 16.49.22 O'NEILL- How long will that take?
- 16.50.27 ANISE- It will not be an easy decision. There are great risks involved.
- 16.55.22 CARTER- She doesn't have a lot of time.
- 16.57.26 TEAL'C- Shan'auc's symbiote is fully mature. It must take a host within a day. Two at most.

- 17.05.10 ANISE- Then I will leave immediately.
- 17.11.29 TEAL'C- I will make a personal request.
- 17.14.07 FREYA- What is it Teal'c?
- 17.19.22 TEAL'C- Shan'auc came to this world expecting not to survive.
- 17.23.00 FREYA- She needs a symbiote to replace that which she now carries.
- 17.26.02 TEAL'C- By the time you return it may be too late.
- 17.28.15 FREYA- There are no Jaffa within the Tok'ra ranks.
- 17.35.05 TEAL'C- I do not wish her to die.
- 17.38.05 FREYA- I cannot promise Teal'c. But, we will try.
- 18.10.10 TEAL'C- The Tok'ra council is considering your offer.
- 18.13.04 SHAN'AUC- My symbiote is eager to meet them. I hope they can reach their decision in time.
- 18.24.02 TEAL'C- The pain grows worse?

- 18.27.07 SHAN'AUC- Yes.
- 18.31.14 TEAL'C- For what reason did you wait so long?
- 18.34.09 SHAN'AUC- I was afraid you would not believe. Since word came to the temple that you had betrayed Apophis, I have thought of you every day.
- 18.44.21 TEAL'C- As a sho'va.
- 18.46.21 SHAN'AUC- No, Teal'c. Because of you, my doubts became certainties. When we were children, you were always the strongest, the bravest. That you would one day be first prime, was never doubted. But, then you did what no Jaffa before you had ever done. You challenged the gods themselves, and won.
 - SHAN'AUC (OS CONT)- Among many on Chulak, you are as revered as the gods once were.

SHAN'AUC (CONT)- And yet, you walk away.

- 19.17.13 TEAL'C- My place is here.
- 19.20.06 SHAN'AUC- Is it?

SHAN'AUC (OS CONT)- Bra'tac cannot be expected to bear the burden alone. It was you who first began walking this path. Do not abandon those who have followed you this far.

19.33.00 TEAL'C- I have abandoned no one.

19.45.01 SHAN'AUC- When I die, and you are the only one capable of teaching others what I have learned... what will you do then?

- 19.52.28 TEAL'C- Do not concern yourself, with me.
- 19.54.22 SHAN'AUC- I have all but given my life for a cause that you inspired!
- 19.57.11 TEAL'C- Tak Shal kree! I will advise you when there is news.
- 20.07.18 SHAN'AUC- When you touched the mind of your symbiote, what did it show you?
- 20.17.12 TEAL'C- The murder of my father. A most slow and painful death.
- 20.22.23 SHAN'AUC- At the hand of Cronus.
- 20.25.24 TEAL'C- Yes.
- 20.27.02 SHAN'AUC- It wanted you to know fear.
- 20.30.25 TEAL'C- Yes.

20.33.01 SHAN'AUC- You are stronger than that. Why does it appear to have succeeded? My first communion was the same. It took many days before I tried again. But one day the images it chose to share with me began to change. They became sorrowful, as though my Kal'ma were awakening to it's own shame. In time the images became beautiful, even caring. If that is all...

- 21.13.13 TEAL'C- There is more. I fear losing you a second time.
- 21.28.14 SHAN'AUC- No. Never again.

ACT THREE

- 22.05.22 DANIEL (OS)-Teal'c!
- 22.07.16 TEAL'C- Kel sha, Daniel Jackson.
- 22.09.06 DANIEL- Morning, how's uh, Shan'auc?

22.13.15 TEAL'C- The pain of carrying a symbiotic past its time is extreme. Shan'auc bears it well.

22.18.14 DANIEL- I can't imagine. Listen, I was just headed off to breakfast...

- 22.21.05 TEAL'C- I am not.
- 22.23.03 DANIEL- Uh, could you stop walking? Is everything all right?
- 22.35.25 TEAL'C- Yes.
- 22.37.09 DANIEL- You see, because I've just noticed that you've been, you know preoccupied lately obviously, and uh...

DANIEL- (OS CONT)- um, I'm kind of going out on a limb here asking, but I just thought, if you wanted to talk, that...

DANIEL (CONT)- I was here to talk.

- 22.49.19 TEAL'C- Daniel Jackson, if all Jaffa can be taught to commune with their symbiotes, then the days of the Goa'uld are truly numbered.
- 22.59.17 DANIEL- And Shan'auc can teach them?
- 23.01.14 TEAL'C- If Shan'auc survives, I intend to be by her side. If she does not, I will not allow her sacrifice to be in vain.

23.09.08 CARTER (OS)- Teal'c! CARTER (CONT)- We've just got word from the Tok'ra, they've accepted Shan'auc's offer.

23.15.20 TEAL'C- When may we depart?

23.16.23 CARTER- Now. Colonel O'Neill's waiting for us in the gear up room.

23.45.13 ANISE- Shan'auc of the Red Hills...Welcome to... ANISE (OS CONT)- Vorash.

23.50.03 SHAN'AUC- It is a great honor to meet the Tok'ra.

23.53.00 O'NEILL- They're all right, if you like the type.

23.56.19 ANISE- It is an equal pleasure to see you, Colonel O'Neill. Your father asked that I shake your hand and give Colonel O'Neill a big kiss from him.

24.07.29 CARTER- Um, that might have been the other way around.

24.10.15 O'NEILL- Maybe, is Freya in there?

24.14.16 FREYA- Of Course, Colonel.

24.16.11 SHAN'AUC (OS)- Then it is true.

SHAN'AUC (CONT)- Host and symbiote share the body equally.

24.20.25 FREYA- And, we are both pleased to tell you good news. As you requested Teal'c, one of our operatives...

FREYA (OS CONT) has retrieved a newly spawned symbiote to replace that which Shan'auc offers.

- 24.30.25 SHAN'AUC- You have done this for me?
- 24.32.16 FREYA- Not only for you, if you truly have turned your symbiote to the Tokra cause, then your life is more valuable than any of ours.
- 24.41.13 SHAN'AUC- Kel'ma. It will not be long now.
- 24.46.15 TEAL'C- She has carried her symbiote far past it's time.
- 24.48.24 FREYA- Then, come. This way...
- 25.00.24 FREYA- We were able to find a host both willing and eager.
- 25.05.18 O'NEILL- Eager too, huh?

25.10.01 FREYA (OS)- This is the volunteer host. FREYA (CONT)- Hebron of Paraval.

25.13.25 O'NEILL- Jack O'Neill, earth.

O'NEILL (OS CONT)- Um...

O'NEILL (CONT)- Forgive my bluntness, here. But, do you have any idea here what you're getting into?

- 25.24.09 ANISE- We have told him everything.
- 25.26.04 O'NEILL- Yeah, well I notice the Tok'ra have a tendency to leave out minor details... O'NEILL (OS)- along the way sometimes.

O'NEILL (CONT)- You do know that this thing is going to be in your head right? You only get your body part time?

- 25.38.23 HEBRON- My own people were enslaved by the Goa'uld; a generation ago. I understand what benefit may come of this.
- 25.45.18 O'NEILL- All right.
- 25.47.18 TEAL'C- This is Shan'auc.

25.55.00 HEBRON- What can you tell me of the one with whom I will spend the rest of my days?

25.58.16 SHAN'AUC- That he wishes to foreswear his birthright, and desires to stop the Goa'uld from causing any more harm.

26.05.19 HEBRON- Then we will have that in common.

26.07.04 SHAN'AUC- You will share with him much, much more than I... Uh, I have waited too long.

29.12.01 O'NEILL- I think now is appropriate.

29.16.15 ANISE (OS)-Tanith has...

ANISE (CONT)- asked to join the Tok'ra, not the SGC.

29.20.16 O'NEILL- Are you kidding me?

29.22.06 ANISE (OS)- We will gladly share...

29.38.18 ANISE- I have told you.

- 30.19.27 TANITH- Teal'c? I sense that she is still very weak.
- 30.24.24 TEAL'C (OS)- Her new symbiote...

TEAL'C (CONT)- is extremely young for the task of healing her.

30.28.04 TANITH- I hope that your indecision did not put her at more risk than necessary.

30.42.21 O'NEILL- (OS)- I guess that we should just...

O'NEILL- (CONT)- mosey on back to earth, and tell general Hammond how the Tok'ra boned us again.

30.52.16 FREYA- Colonel! Please take no offense.

30.58.29 O'NEILL- Hey, I'm getting used to it.

O'NEILL (OS)- Teal'c...

O'NEILL (CONT)- you can come back and visit Shan'auc after we debrief. That is if...

O'NEILL (OS CONT)- it's all right with our good friends and allies.

- 31.16.07 ANISE- He is welcome of course.
- 31.17.29 O'NEILL- Swell. Let's go.
- 31.27.04 TEAL'C- O'Neill. I would like to stay a moment.
- 31.32.17 O'NEILL- We'll wait at the gate.
- 31.50.12 TEAL'C- I must inform the Tauri of my intention to leave their service.
- 31.56.26 SHAN'AUC- I will await your return.

31.58.22 TEAL'C- We will return to Chulak, and tell every Jaffa in every village of your achievement.

32.05.21 SHAN'AUC- Together.

- 32.08.16 TEAL'C- Tal Mate, Shan'auc.
- 32.10.07 SHAN'AUC- Tal mate, my love.
- 32.35.06 SHAN'AUC- Have I disturbed you?
- 32.38.01 TANITH- The hour is late, you should be resting.
- 32.43.04 SHAN'AUC- I could not wait to speak with you.
- 32.53.01 TANITH- Yes. We must speak of your audacity.
- 33.05.02 SHAN'AUC- I do not understand?
- 33.07.12TANITH- How dare a priestess touch the mind of one who would be her god?
- 33.13.14 SHAN'AUC- You despise the Goa'uld.
- 33.16.09 TANITH- I am the Goa'uld.
- 33.18.27 SHAN'AUC- But I showed you the-
- 33.19.25 TANITH- You showed me the means to destroy the Tok'ra. Now, accept your reward.

33.38.24 TEAL'C- It is with much sadness that I must take my leave of the SGC.

- 33.47.24 HAMMOND- Are you certain Teal'c?
- 33.51.05 O'NEILL- He means, leave of absence.

33.53.23 TEAL'C- No, I have said what I mean O'Neill. I intend to live the remainder of my life on Chulak.

- 34.03.14 TEAL'C- Do you not recognize the greatness of Shan'auc's achievement?

34.35.13 TECHNICIAN (OS)- Off world activation.

TECHNICIAN (CONT)- Incoming traveler, sir. It's the Tok'ra.

- 34.50.01 O'NEILL- Here to share squat O'NEILL (OS CONT)- with us, no doubt.
- 34.51.21 HAMMOND- Open the iris.
- 34.29.26 FREYA- Teal'c. It is with great sorrow that I return.
- 35.35.10 TEAL'C- Shan'auc!

35.36.05 FREYA (OS)- We found the body just outside her chamber. FREYA (CONT)– The symbiote she carried is also dead. FREYA (OS CONT)- If we had found a more mature larva...

- 35.47.10 TEAL'C- She appeared well.
- 35.50.12 FREYA- Shan'auc's death is simply the unfortunate result of waiting too long.
- 36.17.16 TEAL'C- Shan'auc, tal met. Pal tiem shree, tal ma.
- 36.33.26 DANIEL- Our love does not end in death.

36.53.09 FREYA- I wanted Teal'c to have the body for whatever spiritual ritual he may wish to perform.

- 37.43.10 O'NEILL- Teal'c! Teal'c! What's happened?
- 37.56.13 TEAL'C- Shan'auc was murdered.

38.16.04 ANISE- We have not yet obtained any information of any value from Tanith. Your return is premature.

- 38.22.04 O'NEILL- You folks should invest in some doors.
- 38.25.01 ANISE- We have no secrets from each other.
- 38.27.05 O'NEILL- Beg to differ with you.

38.28.24 TEAL'C- I have reason to believe that the Goa'uld Shan'auc carried was not truly convinced...

TEAL'C (OS CONT)- to become a Tok'ra.

TEAL'C (CONT)- I believe that the Goa'uld will use this opportunity to become a spy among you.

- 38.37.28 ANISE- What evidence have you for this?
- 38.40.00 TEAL'C- The murder of Shan'auc.

TEAL'C (OS CONT)- The system Lord Cronus murdered my father

TEAL'C (CONT)- by crushing his symbiote in a way that allowed the symbiotes blood

to mix with that of my father. The method is slow and immensely painful.

38.53.06 ANISE- How do you know this?

38.54.22 TEAL'C- In communion with my own symbiote. It is a vision my symbiote chose to share.

38.29.26 ANISE- Why?

39.01.25 TEAL'C- To demonstrate Goa'uld's hatred and superiority.

39.03.27 ANISE- Still, if that is your proof.

39.06.04 TEAL'C- We found Goa'uld blood in Shan'auc's bloodstream and trace amounts on her hands. Confirming my vision.

39.12.15 ANISE- And so, you have come to exact revenge?

- 39.16.05 TEAL'C- I have.
- 39.18.27 ANISE- I'm sorry. We cannot allow you. Stop him!
- 39.46.19 TEAL'C- Kreton Tok'ra! To keem, kree!

39.51.23 O'NEILL- Teal'c let them take the Goa'uld out of the host.

39.54.14 ANISE (OS)- No.

ANISE (CONT)- You will be infinitely more valuable to us, if you do not.

- 40.05.11 O'NEILL- You knew?
- 40.09.08 FREYA- We suspected. Only after her death.

FREYA (OS CONT)- Teal'c we truly had hoped Shan'auc had succeeded.

FREYA (CONT)- But, if we allowed Tanith to believe he has deceived us, we will be able to use that against the Goa'uld.

40.22.14 TEAL'C- Disinformation.

40.23.28 FREYA (OS)- Yes. If we control what he sees and hears, the Goa'uld will never know our true intentions.

FREYA (CONT)- We will be able to use that advantage for months. When Tanith no longer serves a useful purpose...

FREYA (OS CONT)- we will extract what Goa'uld secrets we can, in other ways.

- 40.43.23 O'NEILL- What about the host?
- 40.48.03 ANISE- He knew well the risks.
 - ANISE (OS CONT)- When we have learned all that we can, we will try to remove the Goa'uld.
 - ANISE (CONT)- We are fighting a war for our very existence. I make no apologies for the means. Release him.

41.51.16 TANITH- Hello, Teal'c. You must feel the pain of Shan'auc's death as deeply as I do.
TANITH (OS CONT)- It is a terrible loss to both of us.
TANITH (CONT)- It has been difficult. Why have you come to see me?

42.16.12 TEAL'C- To look upon you. And, know Shan'auc's sacrifice will not be in vain.

42.23.24 TANITH- You have my promise. I hope one day we will meet again, Teal'c. And together remember she who meant so much to both of us.

42.39.21- TEAL'C- We will meet again. You have my promise.
