06.11.08 FRAISER/CARTER/DANIEL- To General Hammond.

06.19.10 CARTER- I miss him. Especially today.

06.21.20 DANIEL- Yeah, how long has it been anyway?

- 06.23.19           TEAL'C- It has been six years.
- 06.25.23           DANIEL- Which reminds me, what was Jack's excuse? I expected to see him here.
- 06.28.12           TEAL'C- O'Neill has made his feelings very clear concerning the Aschen alliance.

have noting to do, so I'd be more than happy to...  
FRAISER (OS CONT)- give you a check up.

08.11.09 CARTER- No, they said I was fine really.

08.12.22 FRAISER- Sam, the medicine I practiced may seem like the dark ages now, but I was  
your doctor for a...  
FRAISER (OS CONT)- long time.  
FRAISER (CONT)- How long have you been trying?

08.23.29 CARTER- Almost three years.

08.25.18 FRAISER- Yes.

08.30.00 CARTER- When can we do this?

08.39.13 FRAISER- Hey, sorry to keep you waiting, but I just wanted to double check my  
results.

08.43.11 CARTER (OS)- And I'm fine, right?

08.46.06            FRAISER- Sam, I don't know how your Aschen doctor could have missed it and  
                                frankly...

FRAISER (OS CONT)- I just don't think it's possible he could have.

08.51.27            CARTER- What?

08.54.24            FRAISER- You can't have children.

09.00.02            CARTER- They said everything was normal.

09.01.16            FRAISER- In every other way it is.

09.03.10            CARTER- Then this is a mistake.

09.07.16            FRAISER- Here.

FRAISER (OS CONT)- Let me show you the scan. (beat)

FRAISER (CONT)- There's no room for interpretation. I mean, clearly your ovaries  
                                are damaged.

09.24.11            CARTER- Why?

09.26.05            FRAISER- I don't know. I don't know what may have caused it...

FRAISER (OS CONT)- or when it may have happened. Buy obviously it was  
                                sometime --

09.30.13 CARTER- No. (beat) I want to know why the Aschen doctors looked me in the eye and told me that I was okay. Why did they lie to me?

09.39.07 FRAISER- I don't know. But I'm willing to help you find out.

09.54.09 MOLLEM- I've been waiting.

09.56.19 CARTER- Sorry.

09.58.03 MOLLEM- Is there something wrong?

09.59.25 CARTER- No.

10.04.04 MOLLEM- All right. (beat) We're still not finding the necessary material to initiate the conversion.

10.14.15 CARTER- Well, we'll just have to find some way to collapse it faster, revise the calculations.

10.19.22 MOLLEM- Interesting.

10.22.04 CARTER- Am I wrong?

- 10.23.08            MOLLEM- Oh, no, no, you're absolutely correct, it's just that a year or so ago you never thought this project was possible and now you seem so (pause) determined.
- 10.35.23            CARTER- You've convinced me.
- 10.44.03            MOLLEM- Did your people ever imagine converting a planet into a star?
- 10.49.17            CARTER- No. I doubt it.
- 10.51.03            MOLLEM- I should think you would have at least considered it given the rapid growth of your population, the viability of the planet.
- 10.56.21            CARTER- Well humans just don't think quite as far ahead as the Aschen seem to.
- 11.03.04            MOLLEM- All right. Since you're so determined, revise the calculations.
- 11.08.25            CARTER (OS)- If I use our computers it will take weeks.  
CARTER (CONT)- On the other hand, if I interface with the Aschen computer core.
- 11.18.10            MOLLEM- You know that's strictly for Aschen personnel.
- 11.24.04            CARTER- It's not like you haven't given me access before.

11.27.15            MOLLEM- Samantha... Why do I let you talk me into this. (beat)  
MOLLEM (OS CONT)- There.  
MOLLEM (CONT)- You have core access.

11.42.13            CARTER- Thank you, Mollem.

11.58.07            FRAISER- Are you in?

11.58.25            CARTER- Not yet.

12.00.15            FRAISER- The medical subcore has its own code, you're not going to be able to  
                         access --

12.03.27            CARTER- I'm in. I'm in. Now what? Okay, it's calling for search parameters.

12.10.16            FRAISER- Right, try medical records.

12.16.16            CARTER- I don't think I'm going to be able to find anything specific to me in here.

12.19.15            FRAISER- So maybe this has happened to some other people. Do a general search.  
                         Human reproductive statistics.

12.28.20            CARTER- That's it.

- 12.31.10            FRAISER- You can read this?
- 12.34.11            CARTER- Oh that can't be right. (beat) Well, if I'm reading this properly, the world wide birth rate has dropped almost ninety one percent in the last two years.
- 12.42.20            FRAISER- What?
- 12.44.00            CARTER- Well, that's what it says right here. These are the Aschen numbers.
- 12.46.00            FRAISER- Yeah, but we would know.
- 12.47.18            CARTER- It's happening everywhere the anti-aging vaccine has gone.
- 12.51.22            FRAISER- Turn it off.
- 12.52.17            CARTER- They're doing it systematically --
- 12.53.13            FRAISER- Just turn it off please. (beat) Okay. We can't let them know we know.
- 13.00.09            CARTER- But Mollem leaves me alone for hours at a time.
- 13.02.07            FRAISER- Sam, you're on the inside, you don't see them the same way I do.
- 13.04.26            CARTER- Janet, they have done this to us deliberately. We have to do something.

- 13.07.20            FRAISER- I know. We can't talk about it here. We'll talk tonight at the restaurant,  
                              okay? (beat) I have to go.
- 13.19.21            DANIEL- You guys, I think it would be public knowledge if something this catastrophic  
                              was happening to the entire population.
- 13.24.20            CARTER- Would it? I mean, the Aschen can convert planets into stars. You don't  
                              think they could control the media if they wanted to?
- 13.31.08            DANIEL (OS)- Ah, assuming...  
                              DANIEL (CONT)- the Aschen could keep something this big a secret, it's been ten  
                              years. Why now?
- 13.37.26            CARTER- We were completely taken in. This way they didn't have to fire a shot. It's  
                              slow, methodical, painless.
- 13.45.20            DANIEL- Okay, then why provide a vaccine that almost doubles the human life span.  
                              That doesn't make any sense.
- 13.49.28            FRAISER- Unless that's the mechanism they use to sterilize the population.
- 13.53.15            CARTER- They're certainly patient enough. All they have to do is wait.



- 13.56.19           TEAL'C- Then within two hundred years, there will be very few, if any, humans remaining. (beat) The Aschen will have this world to themselves.
- 14.09.00           DANIEL- Well, we have to do something. I, I, I don't know. I mean, tell...  
DANIEL (OS CONT)- somebody.
- 14.15.00           FRAISER- The night before General Hammond died he called me and he said that he needed to speak to me about something very important. Something that he couldn't discuss over the phone. (beat) The next day I told the Aschen doctors, I said this is impossible he could not have died of a heart attack. He was in perfect health. But they said their diagnostic machines were infallible.
- 14.36.20           TEAL'C- You believe he was murdered.
- 14.39.23           FRAISER- At the time, no. I believed like everyone else the Aschen were our saviors.
- 14.48.00           DANIEL- So we can't tell anyone. We have to keep this to ourselves.
- 14.51.08           CARTER- Well I have to tell Joe.
- 14.53.15           DANIEL- Maybe you shouldn't.
- 14.56.27           CARTER- Daniel, if you're even suggesting that he knows.

14.58.24 DANIEL- You're saying that it's all of our lives are at stake here.

15.01.12 CARTER- Yes! He can help us.

15.03.16 DANIEL- How?

DANIEL (OS CONT)- Say he goes to the President. The President goes to the rest of the world.

DANIEL (CONT)- Even if what's left of every army on Earth mobilizes, what are they gonna do?

15.11.13 FRAISER- Fight back.

15.12.08 TEAL'C- They would be defeated as were the Goa'uld.

15.18.07 DANIEL- We have to think of something else.

15.20.03 CARTER- Like what?

15.21.03 DANIEL- I don't know. Contact, ah, the Tollen. Ah, find the survivors of the Tok'ra, I mean there have to be some out there. Ah, Teal'c, what about the Jaffa?

15.29.20 TEAL'C- Very few remain loyal to the Tauri since the war's end. There are a few symbiotes available for implantation.

15.38.00           CARTER- We don't even control the Stargate. (beat) Oh, God, what have we done?!  
CARTER (OS CONT)- This morning we were celebrating.

15.45.22           DANIEL- Now I wish we could take it all back.

15.49.00           WAITRESS #2- Will there be anything else?

15.50.22           DANIEL- Apparently not.

15.53.07           WAITRESS #2- Thanks very much.

15.54.00           FRAISER- Thank you.

15.56.27           CARTER- Maybe we can. Take it back.

16.00.27           DANIEL- How?

16.03.04           CARTER- General Hammond showed us.

16.08.00           DANIEL- He left us a note.

16.11.00           FRAISER- What, what are you talking about?

- 16.13.02 CARTER (OS)- A number of years ago, a freak accident...  
CARTER (CONT)- sent us back to 1969.  
CARTER (OS CONT)- We knew, by dialing coordinates...  
CARTER (CONT)- that are precisely on the opposite side of the sun at the exact  
moment of a solar flare, it causes the wormhole to turn towards Earth on itself  
and it creates a time distortion. (beat)  
CARTER (OS CONT)- Now theoretically...  
CARTER (CONT)- we could send ourselves a message.
- 16.32.15 DANIEL- Wait a second, I thought you said it was impossible to predict the exact  
moment of a solar flare.
- 16.35.23 CARTER- For us, yes, it was. But with access to the Aschen computer.
- 16.39.22 FRAISER (OS)- Oh, oh, okay, wait a second here. (beat)  
FRAISER (CONT)- Were considering changing the lives of the entire human race on  
Earth, do we have that right?
- 13.47.06 CARTER (OS)- If we don't...  
CARTER (CONT)- then we will live to see the end of the entire human race on Earth.
- 17.18.24 CARTER (OS CONT)- Hi!
- 17.21.27 O'NEILL- Hi!

17.25.21 CARTER- So this is the place you kept threatening to take me. (beat) It's good to see you sir.

17.36.24 O'NEILL- I'm retired Carter. Lose the sir.

17.42.17 CARTER- Right. (beat) Jack.

17.50.06 O'NEILL- What are you doing here?

17.52.05 CARTER- It turns out we made a mistake. A big one.

17.55.17 O'NEILL- Which one? We made a few.

17.58.15 CARTER- Our alliance with the Aschen.

18.02.09 O'NEILL- Oh that. Not working out is it?

O'NEILL (OS CONT)- Gosh I wish I'd seen that coming.

O'NEILL (CONT)- Oh wait, I did see that coming.

18.14.06 CARTER- It isn't what you thought. (beat) A couple of days ago I found out that I can't ever have children.

18.26.12 O'NEILL- I'm sorry to hear that.

- 18.28.20            CARTER- So was I. (beat) According to the Aschen doctors I was fine. But not according to Dr. Fraiser. We got into the Aschen computer network. They keep statistics on everything. In the last couple of years, without our even knowing it, they have managed to sterilize over ninety percent of the world's population.
- CARTER (OS CONT)- The other ten percent are probably just a matter of time.
- CARTER (CONT)- Now, we don't know how they've done it, or how they've even managed to keep it a secret...
- CARTER (OS CONT)- this long –
- 19.00.14            O'NEILL (OVERLAPPING)- So what do you want me to do about it?
- 19.02.16            CARTER- Help us.
- 19.04.14            O'NEILL- Do what?
- 19.05.18            CARTER- We can undo this.
- 19.09.18            O'NEILL- Oh here we go.
- 19.12.01            CARTER (OS)- We send a message...
- CARTER (CONT)- through the stargate to ourselves ten years ago. We stop this...
- CARTER (OS CONT)- from ever happening.
- 19.20.05            O'NEILL- Stop this from happening?!

- 19.23.08 CARTER- We know it's possible.
- 19.26.04 O'NEILL- Why am I having this conversation?
- 19.30.00 CARTER- We know what we have to do. I am almost positive that with the Aschen computer and solar observatory, I can predict the flare within a few hours of its happening. And we should be able to get our hands on a G.D.O. (beat) So it'll come down to accessing the gate within that window, dialing the right address, and sending the message.
- 19.49.09 O'NEILL- Well if it just comes down to that, do it.
- 19.50.23 CARTER- Look, if I thought it was going to be easy, I wouldn't be standing here asking for your help.
- 19.58.12 O'NEILL- Just out of curiosity, say we do this, what happens to everything that's happened the past ten years?
- 20.08.24 CARTER- It won't happen.
- 20.10.07 O'NEILL- So we don't go to P4C970, we don't meet the Aschen, then (pause) what?
- 20.19.03 CARTER- I don't know.

- 20.22.12 O'NEILL- Let me tell you something Carter. (beat) You wanta erase your mistakes, that's your business. My conscience is clear. I warned everybody. I threw up the red flag and everybody, including you, shut me down.
- 20.38.24 CARTER- I'm asking you to put that behind us.
- 20.40.14 O'NEILL- You're not happy with the way things turned out, I'm sorry to hear that.  
(beat) Personally, I like things the way they are. No more saving the world. Just a nice pond with no pesky fish in it. And the single most pressing issue in my life is whether or not to get a dog. (beat) There are a lot of pros and cons to consider.
- 21.12.19 CARTER- Jack, I'm talking about the future of the human race.
- 21.19.22 O'NEILL- So was I.
- 21.22.26 CARTER- We're doing this.
- 21.25.04 O'NEILL- Let me know how it turns out.
- 21.27.24 CARTER (OS)- Our chances...  
CARTER (CONT)- are a lot better with you then without you.



21.35.06 O'NEILL- Let me ask you something. What does your dearly beloved ambassador say about this?

21.46.04 CARTER- I haven't had a chance to tell him.

21.48.28 O'NEILL- Maybe he can help you.

21.51.17 CARTER- Yeah. (beat) We're on our own.

22.05.05 DANIEL- You're kidding me, he said no.

22.07.13 TEAL'C- That is unfortunate.

22.08.27 CARTER- We can still do this. Did you track down the G.D.O's?

22.12.00 DANIEL (OS)- Ah...  
DANIEL (CONT)- yes and no. From what I could gather from the museum of records there's only one original remote left on display at...  
DANIEL (CONT)- the SGC.

22.19.11 CARTER- Okay well, that's our next stop. (beat) Teal'c, you should return to Chulak.  
We don't want to arouse anymore...  
CARTER (OS CONT)- suspicion than we already have. It'll take at least...  
CARTER (CONT)- two days, but we'll contact you when it's time.

22.27.16           TEAL'C- I will be prepared.

22.37.18           GUIDE- All righty everyone, everyone please step all the way out.

GUIDE (OS CONT)- We've arrived at level 28.

GUIDE (CONT)- Can anyone guess at what special room is on this floor?

22.48.08           KID- The Gate room?

22.49.10           GUIDE- That's very, very close.

GUIDE (OS CONT)- Anyone else?

22.53.24           DANIEL- Um, he's right. It's the Gate room.

22.56.17           GUIDE (OS)- Well, what I'm sure many of you don't know is that officially...

GUIDE (CONT)- it was known as the “embarkation” room...

GUIDE (OS CONT)- because that's where...

GUIDE (CONT)- the SG teams “embarked” from. Okay, now we're walking. This way.

(beat) And these people comprise the famous SG-1...

GUIDE (OS CONT)- arguably the most important...

GUIDE (CONT)- although not my personal favorite team...

GUIDE (OS CONT)- in the entire command.

GUIDE (CONT)- And we're walking.

GUIDE (OS CONT)- While, of course the real...

GUIDE (CONT)- stargate is in Washington...

GUIDE (OS CONT)- at the J.R. Reed Space Terminal, this one is a...

GUIDE (CONT)- perfect replica of the original. Should you want photos, they are  
twenty seven dollars each and please do not touch the stargate itself as you'll  
leave fingerprints. (beat) “See you on the other side”!

23.51.24 DANIEL- This is ridiculous.

23.53.06 CARTER- We couldn't break away until there were more people around. Once we're  
in the control room –

23.57.04 DANIEL- Not her personal favorite SG team?

24.00.03 CARTER- Just don't ask for the photo.

24.05.02 O'NEILL- And we're walking... (beat) Hey, thanks for showing.

24.23.16 CARTER- We decided to wait until the last tour of the day. (beat) So, when id you  
decide against getting a dog?

24.32.14 O'NEILL- I'm still thinking about it. (beat) In the meantime I did a little shopping on  
your behalf. The Zats are completely operational. This, however,...

O'NEILL (OS CONT)- presents a problem.

- 24.48.13           CARTER- It's a replica. (beat) Daniel...  
CARTER (OS CONT)- was this the only one?
- 24.56.19           TECHNICIAN- Excuse me, you people are supposed to be – (beat) Colonel O'Neill?
- 25.10.04           O'NEILL- Sergeant...what are you doing here?
- 25.11.26           TECHNICIAN- I work here now. I'm sort of the operations tech...  
TECHNICIAN (OS CONT)- advisor.
- 25.21.09           O'NEILL- Oh!
- 25.21.11           DANIEL- Well, you're, you're doing a great job.
- 25.25.28           TECHNICIAN- Ah, this section's closed off. (beat) You here for old times sake?
- 25.33.23           O'NEILL- That's it exactly.
- 25.36.00           TECHNICIAN- Where did you get those?
- 25.38.05           O'NEILL- The Zats? (beat) Armory. We're taking them.
- 25.42.28           TECHNICIAN- Oh, no, no, I ah –

- 25.44.28 CARTER (OS)- Sergeant...  
CARTER (CONT)- please. This is really important. (beat) Do you know where the  
real G.D.O's went?
- 25.53.10 TECHNICIAN- I'm not a Sergeant anymore, and you're not Colonels, and you're not  
supposed to have that remote either.
- 25.58.02 DANIEL- That's good, because actually, we don't want that one. We want the real  
one.
- 26.02.07 TECHNICIAN- It's in the White House. In the Oval Office, on the President's desk.
- 26.07.20 O'NEILL- Kinsey grab a souvenir on the way down?!
