	means "advanced", and "tar"which I believe is a sort of slang.

01.20.12	TEAL'C-Human.
01.20.14	DANIEL-So essentially it's Advanced Human. "Hok tauri."
	DANIEL (OS CONT)-Anyway,
	DANIEL (CONT)-Nirrti was studying the children on Hanka because she believed they
	were evolving into Hok'tar.
01.20.24	HAMMOND (OS)-You're
	HAMMOND (CONT)-saying Cassandra is becoming some form of advanced
	HAMMOND (OS CONT)-human?
01.20.28	DR. FRAISER-And the retrovirus is the catalyst.
01.20.31	TEAL'C (OS)-Such an advanced
	TEAL'C (CONT)-human would represent a powerful host for the Goa'uld.

01.20.34	CARTER-Which explains why Nirrti was performing the experiments.
01.20.36	DANIEL-And it also explains why she exterminated the entire population when we
	came on the scene. She didn't want her experiment exposed.
01.20.43	DR. FRAISER-Prior to our arrival on P8X 987 – and for as long as SG-7 was there –
	none of the villagers exhibited advanced intelligence or the ability to manipulate the e-m fields.
