- 01.03.30 I care.
- 01.03.33 DANIEL (OS)-I also think it might be relevant to investigate how these men... DANIEL (CONT)-got Goa'uld weapons and from where.

- 01.03.39 O'NEILL-Now see, <u>that</u> I really care about.

- 01.08.15 DANIEL-Yes, it means he's our head trader.
- 01.08.19 O'NEILL-Head trader?

01.08.21 BURROCK (OS)-I like that. BURROCK (CONT)-And you can call me Colonel Burrock. BURROCK (OS CONT)-It is our custom to welcome visitors with a drink. BURROCK (CONT)-Will you join me?

- 01.08.31 O'NEILL-It is our custom to drink. Of course.
- 01.08.43 Honesty, huh?

01.08.44 DANIEL-We're traders. We've traded. We trade. We're trading.

- 01.09.11 BURROCK-You thank a beast?
- 01.09.13 DANIEL-Yes. Uh, positive reinforcement. We find it a successful method of training.
- 01.09.20 BURROCK (OS)-I'm curious to learn more about your methods. BURROCK (CONT)-And to learn more about where you came from.

- 01.09.28 DANIEL-So, no one else has actually come through the Chappa-ai?
- 01.09.32 BURROCK-I have often wondered why there are so many symbols on the pedestal.
 BURROCK (OS CONT)-I have stood for hours on end pressing different combinations, but nothing happened. The fact that you have come here...
 BURROCK (CONT)-from a place we do not know proves that I am right. The Chappa-ai goes many places, does it not?

- 01.09.49BURROCK-I have been to one other place. Just one time, so far.BURROCK (OS CONT)-I had to press seven different symbols to get the Chappa-ai to

- 01.10.01 BURROCK-I paid dearly for them. They have been passed down through the lineage of certain families since the Beast Wars.
- 01.10.08 O'NEILL-Beast Wars?
- 01.10.09 BURROCK (OS)-Generations ago,...
 BURROCK (CONT)-the beasts enslaved our forefathers through terror and oppression. They served the *one with the glowing eyes*.

01.10.17 DANIEL-And what happened to him, her?

01.10.20 BURROCK-No one knows. One day he went away and did not return. BURROCK (OS CONT)-Our forefathers, they learned how the beast weapons worked and lead an uprising. The war was bloody,...

BURROCK (CONT)-waged for many years. But eventually, the slaves triumphed and the masters became the slaves. Since then, the beasts have served us.

01.10.54 Like the one at the auction that got away,...

BURROCK (OS CONT)-this one comes...

BURROCK (CONT)-from our local stock. I believe him to be untrainable.

BURROCK (OS CONT)-His head is not right.

BURROCK (CONT)-Even for a beast.

01.11.05 O'NEILL-Maybe he's just pissed because you keep torturing him.

01.11.09 BURROCK-(CHUCKLES) The unfortunate result of generations of inbreeding. I'm afraid he'll have to be put down. Do you not have this problem where you come from?

01.11.20 O'NEILL-Uh, we've made some progress, actually.

01.11.23 BURROCK-Interesting. The only choice we had was to introduce new blood. Fortunately, I was able to find some.

01.11.51 BURROCK (CONT)-This one will make me the...

BURROCK (OS CONT)- wealthiest beastmaster in the land.

- 01.12.04 CHAKA (GRAVELLY VOICED)-Dan...el.
- 01.12.07 BURROCK-He speaks?
- 01.12.09 DANIEL (OS)-Yes.
- 01.12.11 BURROCK-Your name.
- 01.12.11 DANIEL (OS)-Yes. DANIEL (CONT)-That's because he's mine.
- 01.12.16 BURROCK-You deceived me. You said you came here to trade for an Unas...not to claim one of your own.
- 01.12.23 DANIEL (OS)-We just wanted to make sure he was... DANIEL (CONT)-here before we made an issue out of it.

- 01.13.23 DANIEL (OVERLAPPING)-No, you don't understand. This one, his name is Chaka and he is coming with me.
- 01.13.32 O'NEILL-Uh, Daniel...
- 01.13.34 DANIEL-Jack?

- 01.13.35 O'NEILL-Why don't we discuss what we can offer the man in return.
- 01.13.43 Shall we? Outside.
- 01.14.01 CHAKA-(ROARS)
- 01.14.05 O'NEILL (OS)-Daniel, I am not gonna get into a fire-... O'NEILL (CONT)-fight over this right now.

01.14.09 BURROCK (OS)-If you expect... BURROCK (CONT)-to trade for that Unas, do not think it will come cheap.

- 01.14.17 O'NEILL-So, what's your price?
- 01.14.20 BURROCK-Two Unas of equally pure lineage.
- 01.14.24 O'NEILL-Two for one, ey?

01.14.26 BURROCK-Your Unas is worth it or you would not have traveled all this way. Besides, you obviously have more sophisticated methods for capturing and training them.

01.14.36 O'NEILL-We'll...think about it. O'NEILL (OS CONT) (Under breath)-Come on. 01.14.55 DANIEL (OS)-Excuse me. You, uh,...

DANIEL (CONT)-have some sort of plan to do something about this?

- 01.15.04 O'NEILL-Well, right now I'm not sure I'm gonna do anything.
- 01.15.10 DANIEL-How can you say that?

- 01.18.40 O'NEILL-/ could have said that.
- 01.18.42 DANIEL-Keka...keka. Danger!
- 01.18.49 THE UNAS (OS)-(GROWL, ROAR)
 - THE UNAS (CONT)-(ROARS)
- 01.18.54 O'NEILL-Crap! O'NEILL (OS CONT)-Come on! We gotta go!
- 01.18.57 DANIEL (loud whisper) (OS)-Come on! Come on! DANIEL (CONT)-No, it's okay. It's okay.

- 01.19.45 CARTER (VO CONT THRU RADIO FILTERED)-At least ten men heading your way. CARTER (CONT INTO RADIO)-We're laying down cover fire.

- 01.20.16 CARTER (VO THRU RADIO FILTERED)-Colonel, come in. Over.
- 01.20.24 Colonel, do you read? Come in. Over.
- 01.20.36 DANIEL (OS)-Chaka must have grabbed...
 - DANIEL (CONT)-that from my vest before it was taken away.
- 01.20.40 O'NEILL-Why would he do that?
- 01.20.42 DANIEL-He's seen me use it. He knows what it's for. (to Chaka)-Chaka... give...
- 01.20.49 CHAKA-Ko.
- 01.20.51 DANIEL-Ko... I don't know that word. Ko...it's give... Yes. Yes, Chaka, ko, ko, ko.

- 01.21.08 DANIEL (CONT)-Thank you.

- 01.21.12 DANIEL-Aka. Thank you.
- 01.21.14 O'NEILL-Daniel...
- 01.21.16 DANIEL-Right. (into radio)-Sam, it's Daniel. Do you read?
- 01.21.21 CARTER (INTO RADIO)-Daniel, are you okay?
- 01.21.23 DANIEL (VO THRU RADIO FILTERED)-Uh, been better.
- 01.21.25 CARTER (INTO RADIO)-Colonel O'Neill?
- 01.21.27 DANIEL (INTO RADIO)-Uh, physically, fine. But I...but I'm not expecting a birthday present any time soon.
- 01.21.33 O'NEILL-Ko! (in whisper)-Ko.
- 01.21.38 DANIEL-Chaka. DANIEL (OS CONT)-Ko.

01.22.03 O'NEILL-Thank you. (into radio)-Carter, report.

01.22.09 CARTER (VO THRU RADIO FILTERED)-There were too many of them, sir. You ordered us not to shoot to kill. We couldn't stop them.

- 01.22.14 O'NEILL (INTO RADIO)-Yeah, I know.
- 01.22.16 CARTER (VO THRU RADIO FILTERED)-We're currently being pursued by search parties.

CARTER (CONT INTO RADIO)-Attempting to make it to the gate to get reinforcements.

- 01.22.22 O'NEILL (INTO RADIO)-Roger that. Out.
- 01.22.28 CHAKA (OS)-Danel? CHAKA (CONT)-A Cha 'aka.
- 01.22.32 DANIEL-A Cha 'aka.
- 01.22.38 CHAKA-Aka na.
- 01.22.40 DANIEL-Ma. Ma. Kan. (It's okay.)

- 01.22.49 DANIEL-Ma! Kan.
- 01.22.51 CHAKA-Aka na.
- 01.22.52 DANIEL-Kan. Cha. Na.
- 01.23.04 CHAKA-Cha'aka. Cha'aka.
- 01.23.13 O'NEILL-What's he saying?
- 01.23.17 DANIEL-Well, actually, it means a lot of different things.

DANIEL (OS CONT)-In this particular case, I'd say,...

DANIEL (CONT)-'Thank you for trying to free me. Sorry for getting you into this mess.'

- 01.23.29 CHAKA-Cha'aka.
- 01.23.32 O'NEILL-Chaka full of Nuts. Whatever.
- 01.23.36 DANIEL-Jack, it's not his fault.

- 01.23.37 O'NEILL-Daniel, I'm chained up in a madman's barn with a bunch of Unas. Who's to blame is not at the top of my list of concerns...just yet.
- 01.23.51 CHAKA-Cha'aka. Cha'aka.
- 01.24.02 SHY ONE-...cha'aka...
- 01.24.07 DANIEL-Oh, that's amazing.
- 01.24.09 O'NEILL-What?
- 01.24.10 DANIEL (more to himself)-Language is a learned behavior. Chaka must have taught this Unas his word.
- 01.24.22 (to Shy One)-Cha'aka.
- 01.24.23 SHY ONE-Cha'aka. Cha'aka Zo.
- 01.24.29 BIG ONE-Cha'aka Zo.
- 01.24.37 GROUP OF UNAS-(THROATY GUTTURAL SOUND)
- 01.24.50 DANIEL-They're saying Chaka is their leader. They, they must recognize that he wouldn't leave without them.

- 01.24.55 O'NEILL-Daniel, dogs sniff each other's butts and they're friends for life. We still keep them as pets.
- 01.25.02 DANIEL-No, this is different. Chaka made a choice. Choice is freedom. These Unas have pledged their allegiance to him because... DANIEL (OS CONT)-of that.
- 01.25.13 O'NEILL (in whisper)-What are you saying?
- 01.25.14 DANIEL-I'm saying that they want to be free. They, they recognize what that means.
- 01.25.17 O'NEILL-All they said was Chaka Zo.
- 01.25.19 SHY ONE-Chaka Zo.
- 01.25.21 BIG ONE-Chaka Zo.
- 01.25.24 DANIEL (OS)-I was wrong. Chaka, Chaka isn't different. DANIEL (CONT)-These Unas may have been born into domestication, but they still know what freedom means. They know it enough to want it.
- 01.25.32 O'NEILL-You said yourself, this is their way of life here.
- 01.25.35 DANIEL-Well, it has to change.

- 01.25.36 O'NEILL-How?
- 01.25.39 DANIEL-Well, we've meddled in other planet's cultures before.
- 01.25.41 O'NEILL-Well, now you're talking about moving in an army.
- 01.25.44 DANIEL-I'd like to think that there was another way.
- 01.25.48 O'NEILL-Look, in principal, I agree with you...
- 01.26.07 BOY-You injured my father.
- 01.26.16 O'NEILL-I'm sorry. I really am.
- 01.26.25 DANIEL-We were just trying to take back an Unas that is rightfully ours.
- 01.26.31 BOY-Stealing is wrong.
- 01.26.34 O'NEILL-Yes, it is.
- 01.26.48 CHAKA-A cha'ka.
- 01.26.56 A cha'ka.

01.27.10 O'NEILL-Trust me, Daniel. A whole lot of people are gonna have to die around here before one Unas goes free.

- 01.27.33 CARTER (INTO RADIO)-Colonel, do you read?
- 01.27.37 O'NEILL (INTO RADIO)-Yeah. Carter, what's your situation?

01.27.39 CARTER (INTO RADIO)-We're at the gate, sir, but it's heavily guarded. CARTER (VO CONT THRU RADIO FILTERED)-We can attempt to get through, but it's gonna get ugly.

- 01.27.43 O'NEILL (INTO RADIO)-Alright, hold your position. Radio silence. I gotta go.
- 01.28.06 BURROCK-Beast stealing is punishable by death. But it is my hope that that will not be necessary. But that will be up to you. I also know there were others with you...

BURROCK (OS CONT)-and that they may try to rescue you.

BURROCK (CONT)-That would not be wise. I will not hesitate to kill you.

- 01.28.29 DANIEL-What do you want?
- 01.28.39 BURROCK-Tell me of the places where the Chappa'ai can go. I do not understand why you take such risks for this beast. He is very valuable to me but, certainly, you can replace him with one of equal lineage?

- 01.29.03 BURROCK-They used our forefathers as slaves and treated them much worse than we treat our Unas.
- 01.29.07 DANIEL-And that makes you right?

01.29.22 BURROCK-Our forefathers could have slaughtered them all. Wiped them form the face of the planet.

BURROCK (OS CONT)-But instead, they saw a way to use their strength to our advantage.

BURROCK (CONT)-A way to co-exist. For that, we thank them.

- 01.29.33 DANIEL-You don't co-exist, you use them as slaves.
- 01.29.37 O'NEILL-Look, we're not gonna tell you anything, so...

O'NEILL (OS CONT)-you might as well just let us go. We'll go back to where we came from, you can go on doing what you do so well.

01.29.46 BURROCK (OS)-Because... BURROCK (CONT)-now I know for certain there is more out there.

01.29.50 O'NEILL-Yeah, I know the grass always looks cleaner. The fact is,...

O'NEILL (OS CONT)-there's a whole bunch of bad guys with glowing eyes out there and you...

O'NEILL (CONT)-really don't want to mess with them.
