02.47.11 SATTERFIELD- (GROANING IN PAIN)

02.48.04 HAILEY- (GROANING IN PAIN)

02.48.20 ELLIOT- (GROANING IN PAIN)

02.52.10 DANIEL (BLOWING ON GUN)- Ow.

02.59.08 O'NEILL- Okay! So, we're all dead and there's an armed Goa'uld on the loose. I got a problem with that. Anybody else got a problem with that? Think it over. Report to the ready line in twenty minutes. Dismissed. Move!

03.37.23 O'NEILL- Would you turn that thing off?

04.59.27 O'NEILL- And that wasn't even your first mistake! What's your excuse?

05.06.16 SATTERFIELD- I didn't believe Dr. Jackson was the Goa'uld.

05.09.29 CARTER- Why not, Satterfield?

05.11.21 SATTERFIELD- I don't know, ma'am. That was just my instinct.

- 05.14.01 HAILEY- She thinks he's cute.
- 05.16.27 ELLIOT- (STIFLING LAUGHING)
- 05.18.20 CARTER- You let your personal feelings for the host – in this case Dr. Jackson and myself – get in the way of what needed to be done.

O'NEILL (OS CONT)- When you're dealing with what we deal with...
O'NEILL (CONT)- you've got to think on your feet and think fast! These and other
clichés will be available to you all for one more day of training with me.
O'NEILL (OS CONT)- After that...
O'NEILL (CONT)- you'll either be assigned to an SG team – or not. Dismissed.

07.09.28 O'NEILL- Yeah, we'll have to fix that for next time. See you at the garage.

07.14.14 CARTER- Yessir. Good luck with them.

07.22.11 ELLIOT (OS)- Colonel!

07.25.01 O'NEILL- Something on your mind, Lieutenant?

07.26.16 ELLIOT- I wanted to apologize for the attitude I gave you back there.

07.29.16 O'NEILL- I like people with attitude. In fact, I might prefer them to people who suck up.

07.33.20 ELLIOT- That's not what I was...
ELLIOT (OS CONT)- doing, sir.

07.37.18 O'NEILL- You want my approval? You're a fine officer. The Air Force has already decided that or you wouldn't be here. But not everyone is cut out to go off world.

07.49.10 ELLIOT- I am.

07.50.06 O'NEILL- You don't decide that.

07.53.03 ELLIOT- What I'm trying to say, sir, is that I feel like I've trained for this program my whole life. I don't intend to let it slip by.

08.01.06 O'NEILL- Then see that you don't.

08.10.15 GROGAN- Maybe he's not on our side. Either that or he just doesn't like you.

08.15.06 HAILEY- Oh, but he loves you.

08.16.23 GROGAN- I don't think he likes anybody.

08.18.23 HAILEY (OS)- You're wrong about that. He'd do anything for his team.

08.21.21 SATTERFIELD- How do you know?

08.23.03 HAILEY- I saw him in action. He put his life on the line for us.

- 08.25.15 GROGAN- Yeah, tell us again, Hailey. There may be some detail you left out the last ten times.
- 08.30.12 HAILEY- Hey, nobody gets assigned to an SG team without the recommendation of an SG team commander. It just so happened to be Colonel O'Neill's turn, and I for one don't have a problem with that.

10.35.00 O'NEILL- I gave her high marks for her high marks, but I'd never go into combat with her.

10.41.24 CARTER- Then there's Hailey.

10.42.27 O'NEILL- Oh, yeah. Four foot nine fightin' machine.

10.46.03 CARTER (LAUGHING)- Colonel...

10.48.04 O'NEILL- All right, fine.
O'NEILL (OS CONT)- They're the...
O'NEILL (CONT)- future of the Air Force, the program, the entire planet – God help us.

10.54.12 CARTER- Well, try to remember when you were in their shoes.

10.56.17 O'NEILL- I wore boots.

10.59.03 CARTER- Think back to when you were their age.

11.01.27 O'NEILL- I was never their age.

11.07.22 CARTER- Goodnight, sir.

11.10.22 O'NEILL- What?

O'NEILL (OS CONT)- Inside...

O'NEILL (CONT)- that building is a valuable piece of alien technology. Two things stand in your way – opposing fire and time. The Stargate will only be open for another twelve minutes and it's a half a mile away. Is that clear?

14.49.20 SATTERFIELD- It's counting down in Goa'uld.

14.52.20 SATTERFIELD- 90 seconds.

14.54.04 HAILEY- I can try to disarm it.

14.55.24 ELLIOT- There's not enough time.

15.01.06 HAILEY- Well, what do you want me to do?

15.27.06 O'NEILL (OS)- Where is it?

15.28.15 ELLIOT- We couldn't get the device, sir. It was booby-trapped.

15.32.04 O'NEILL- Really?

15.34.23 HAILEY- Five seconds...

15.43.15 O'NEILL- Did you try to disarm the device?

15.45.22 ELLIOT- Negative, sir. We only had 90 seconds.

15.47.15 O'NEILL- 90 seconds. Could you have disabled the device in 90 seconds?

15.53.11 HAILEY- I supported Lieutenant Elliot's decision to pull out, sir.

15.55.13 O'NEILL- I don't care if you support him or not! Could you have disarmed the device?

16.00.13 HAILEY- Possibly.

16.01.14 ELLIOT- I put the lives of my team members first, sir.

16.04.13 O'NEILL- Really? Where's Grogan?

16.10.10 ELLIOT- I ordered him to get out.

16.11.12 O'NEILL- Did you see him get out?

16.12.22 ELLIOT- No, sir.

16.35.17 GROGAN- Sorry. The Colonel shot me again. How we do?

16.39.08 SATTERFIELD- You were killed in the explosion.

16.41.16 ELLIOT- And I washed out.

16.43.08 SATTERFIELD- You don't know that.

16.44.18 HAILEY- Guys, something's going on.

16.46.10 O'NEILL- Sierra Gulf Niner...Code foxtrot, alpha six.

- 18.10.14 ELLIOT- Everybody set their int’ars to maximum.
- 18.12.13 GROGAN- Those are our guys!
- 18.13.06 ELLIOT- Do it, Grogan.
- 18.18.05 GROGAN- We have to help him!
- 18.18.27 ELLIOT- Hold your position.
- 18.29.20 O’NEILL (OS)- You’re all dismissed!
- 18.30.16 ELLIOT- Colonel, you’re injured. Satterfield!

- 18.32.14 O'NEILL- Stay together as long as you can. Don't trust anybody until I contact you.
- 18.35.25 ELLIOT (OS)- You're injured.
ELLIOT (CONT)- You're gonna need help.
- 18.37.13 O'NEILL (OS)- This is...

19.39.11 O'NEILL- Tear gas.

19.55.02 ELLIOT- Clear.

19.56.03 O'NEILL- Lieutenant, take point. Carter's lab's on sublevel 19.

20.57.02 GROGAN- Sir, I thought we weren't authorized to use lethal force?

20.59.09 O'NEILL (OS)- I want you all to have...

O'NEILL (CONT)- backup. Just in case.

21.10.20 TEAL’C (OS)- Major Carter has escaped custody. You will search sublevels 14 through 20 until she is located.

23.26.04 SATTERFIELD- I can't make out the writing.

23.28.16 ELLIOT- Maybe Dr. Jackson took photos.
 ELLIOT (OS CONT)- Check out his office, one level up. Grogan...
 ELLIOT (CONT)- make sure she gets there. Report when you've got something.

23.36.03 GROGAN- Yessir.

23.37.04 ELLIOT- Hailey, you and I'll shut down the gate.

23.41.27 O'NEILL- Let's move out.
 O'NEILL (CONT)- (GROANING IN PAIN)

23.43.28 ELLIOT (OS)- Sir...
 ELLIOT (CONT)- you're in no shape to do this.

23.48.23 O'NEILL- I've been worse.

23.51.11 ELLIOT (OS)- We can handle this, sir.
 ELLIOT (CONT)- You're no good to us if you're dead.

24.06.23 O'NEILL- Stay on channel 12. This gets you anywhere on the base. Remember –

26.20.10 SATTERFIELD- I've got it. Lieutenant, Satterfield.

26.23.26 ELLIOT- What've you got?

26.24.28 SATTERFIELD (OS FILTERED THROUGH RADIO)- I found photos of the device

SATTERFIELD (CONT)- reveal an obscure dialect SG-1 found on the planet Argos

SATTERFIELD (OS CONT FILTERED THROUGH RADIO)- Rough translation, “gift
from on high.”

SATTERFIELD (CONT)- I think we're looking at a Goa'uld Trojan horse.

26.38.23 ELLIOT- Colonel, are you reading this?

26.40.05 O'NEILL (OS FILTERED THROUGH RADIO)- Yeah, I read you. That's enough
chatter, huh?

26.43.21 ELLIOT (OS)- The Goa'uld Pelops used nanotechnology...

ELLIOT (CONT)- to rapidly age the people on Argos.

26.48.07 HAILEY- Well, let's get a blood sample from one of the S.F.'s.

26.50.25 ELLIOT- First we shut down the gate.

27.02.18 O'NEILL- O'Neill. Yeah, I got 'em. Elliot, get out of there! That's an order.

- 27.12.19 ELLIOT- Colonel, we're at the gate room.
- 27.15.13 O'NEILL- Pull back to my position.
- 27.17.12 ELLIOT- Yessir.
- 27.25.29 HAILEY (OS)- Oh, my God, this blood is teeming with nanobots.
HAILEY (CONT)- The nanobots must somehow rewire the brain and make people
 responsive to the suggestions from the alien device that we saw in the briefing
 room.
- 27.36.05 SATTERFIELD- So the nanobots work together as...
SATTERFIELD (OS CONT)- some kind of receiver?
- 27.38.28 ELLIOT- Well, that's how they worked on Argos. Right, Colonel?
- 27.42.28 O'NEILL- I was a hundred years old at the time. The memory's the first to go.
- 27.48.18 SATTERFIELD- Maybe we can find out how they communicate with the master and
 shut it down.
- 27.51.26 HAILEY- There are no analog or digital signals being transmitted.
- 27.54.23 ELLIOT- Then we need to shut down the device in the briefing room.

27.57.02 GROGAN- That level's heavily guarded.

27.59.24 HAILEY- We still need to get control of the Stargate.

28.05.08 ELLIOT- If we take out the briefing room at the same time, you'll have a better chance
to get into the gate room and lock out the dialing computer.

28.12.08 O'NEILL- That's the plan then. Take corridor C-19.

28.16.29 ELLIOT- Sir.

28.43.18 O'NEILL- They're on their way.

29.43.19 S.F.- (GROANING IN PAIN)

29.46.03 ELLIOT- Step away from the prisoner, please, Colonel.

29.53.16 CARTER- Colonel O'Neill's obviously been compromised. I'll take it from here.

29.56.20 O'NEILL- Lieutenant, you've only been gone for two minutes. There's no way in that
time that--

30.00.20 CARTER (OS)- You saw what he was...

CARTER (CONT)- doing.

31.35.25 O'NEILL- "Colonel O'Neill has been compromised?"
