- 04.40.24 HAMMOND- Doctor Jackson, what can you tell us about this Imhotep. This is the first l've heard of him.

04.45.01 DANIEL (OS)- Well, during the third dynasy of ancient Egypt,...

DANIEL (CONT)- Imhotep was credited with being the first pyramid builder. He was later deified among the ancient Egyptians, but among the Goa'uld, at least as far as I know, he never achieved power of any kind.
