- 01.32.11 O'NEILL-Sir, my mission report. Better late than ever, I always say.
- 01.39.15 TECHNICIAN (OS)-Chevron one, encoded.
- 01.41.29 O'NEILL-Yep. I always say that.
- 01.45.23 TECHNICIAN (OS)-Chevron two, encoded.
- 01.47.04 O'NEILL-What's goin' on?
- 01.48.16 HAMMOND-SG-9 was on an extended mission to reestablish diplomatic relations with
P2A 018.
- 01.55.20 O'NEILL (trying to remember)-018...
- 01.58.17 HAMMOND-Latona.
- 01.59.25 O'NEILL (he doesn't remember)-Oh, yes.
- 01.59.27 HAMMOND (OS)-One of several planets...
HAMMOND (CONT)-visited by the N.I.D. while running their off-world program.
- 02.05.15 O'NEILL-Right.

- 02.07.04 HAMMOND-Major Benton has spent several months trying to negotiate access to a defensive weapon they call the Sentinel. It's supposed to be capable of defending their entire planet.
- 02.09.04 TECHNICIAN (OS OVERLAPPING)-Chevron five, encoded.
- 02.16.01 O'NEILL-Yeah, I...I read the reports.
- 02.18.03 TECHNICIAN (OS OVERLAPPING)-Chevron six, encoded.
- 02.19.15 HAMMOND-They were scheduled to return early this morning.
- 02.23.13 TECHNICIAN (OS)-Chevron seven, wide.
TECHNICIAN (CONT)-Standing by, sir. MALP relay is active.
- 02.31.27 HAMMOND-This is Hammond. SG-9, report. (beat) Major Benton, you are overdue.
Please repond.
- 02.39.23 GROGAN (VO THRU SPEAKER FILTERED)-General, sir, this is Sergeant Grogan!
Major Benton was...(static)...three days ago! The star...(static)... The Latonans tried to...(static)...but the damn thing didn't work!
- 02.52.09 HAMMOND-Sergeant, can you make it back to the Stargate?

- 02.54.15 GROGAN (VO THRU SPEAKER FILTERED)-Negative. There are two Jaffa emplacements supported by a staff...all over, and there's no way I can get out of the Stargate. Under fire! Grogan out!
- 03.08.20 HAMMOND-Sergeant, shut it down.
- 03.10.01 TECHNICIAN (OS)-Yes, sir.
- 04.20.20 GRIEVES (VO FILTERED)-Okay, Marul, go ahead.
- 04.26.03 MARUL (FILTERED)-Your friends will see me?
- 04.28.09 GRIEVES (VO FILTERED)-Not right now. I'll send your greeting back with my report.
- 04.33.04 MARUL (FILTERED)-Well, what shall I say?
- 04.35.11 GRIEVES (VO FILTERED)-Anything you like. (beat) (BREATHY CHUCKLE) How 'bout, "Hello."
- 04.44.15 MARUL (VO FILTERED)-Hello?
- 04.51.14 MARUL (FILTERED CONT)-Hello.
- 04.53.01 GRIEVES (VO FILTERED)-That'll be fine.

- 04.59.00 O'NEILL-The rat bastard.
- 05.01.02 DANIEL-The guy came across as very nice.
- 05.03.02 O'NEILL-The voice behind the camera.
- 05.06.24 HAMMOND-Colonel Sean Grieves, formerly of the N.I.D.
HAMMOND (OS CONT)-He led an off-world team for Colonel Maybourne, and was
one of the members...
HAMMOND (CONT)-of that organization convicted of high treason for his actions.
- 05.16.10 DANIEL-And what was Grieves's team trying to steal?
- 05.19.02 HAMMOND-The Latonans possess a planetary defense they called the *Sentinel*,
which has apparently kept them safe from the Goa'uld for generations.
- 05.26.15 CARTER-I can see why the N.I.D. would want to get their hands on it.
- 05.29.09 O'NEILL-We put 'em all away before they could.
- 05.31.24 HAMMOND-Frankly, I'm afraid Colonel Grieves's team may have done something to
the Sentinel device they haven't admitted to.
- 05.38.23 O'NEILL-Fiddling around with it, was he?

- 05.40.26 CARTER-Well, according to his report, the Latonans never granted Grieves’s team access to the Sentinel device before they were recalled and arrested.
- 05.49.04 DANIEL-You don’t think it’s possible for an N.I.D. operative to *lie*.
- 05.53.03 TEAL’C-I believe it is, Daniel Jackson.
- 05.57.02 DANIEL-Right. Ughmm. So if Grieves’s team disabled the Latonans’ only means of defense –
- 06.03.07 CARTER-We’re responsible.
- 06.04.23 O’NEILL-*Grieves* is responsible, thank you.
- 06.07.10 HAMMOND-I doubt the Latonans will appreciate that distinction, Colonel.
- 06.11.19 TEAL’C (OS)-Time will be of the...
TEAL’C (CONT)-essence. The Goa’uld forces SG-9 encountered in Latona were most likely sent through the Stargate as a test.
- 06.19.04 CARTER-To determine if the Sentinel was operational –
- 06.21.10 DANIEL-And by now, they’ll have reported back.

- 07.36.22 O'NEILL-P2A 018. A device...
O'NEILL (OS CONT)-called the Sentinel.
- 07.41.01 GRIEVES-What about it?
- 07.42.26 O'NEILL-I need to know what you did to screw it up, and what I need to do to fix it.
- 07.46.13 GRIEVES-I'm more inclined to tell you where to shove it.
- 07.52.03 O'NEILL-As we speak, SG-9 is either pinned down by the Goa'uld, or dead. So let's
just cut the crap, okay?
- 07.59.21 GRIEVES-How is this my problem?
- 08.01.11 O'NEILL-You're responsible. 018 is defenseless because of *you*.
- 08.05.26 GRIEVES-Earth is defenseless because of *you*. You don't seem to have a problem
with that.
- 08.09.04 O'NEILL-You stole technology from our *allies*. If I hadn't shut you down, they would
have.

08.14.21 GRIEVES-Do you really think the Asgard or the Tok'ra will really rush to our defense
when the Goa'uld finally decide to stomp on us?

GRIEVES (OS CONT)-That day is coming, Colonel.

GRIEVES (CONT)-Don't kid yourself.

08.30.03 O'NEILL-Okay. I guess I should just go have a chat with Kershaw.

08.39.29 GRIEVES-The Latonans didn't want to show us the Sentinel. We found it ourselves,
not far from the city. There was a force field guarding the device itself.
Kershaw and I took almost two weeks to get in, take it apart, and put it back
together good as new.

08.55.16 O'NEILL-Not good as new. You did something *wrong*.

08.58.06 GRIEVES-The only thing we did wrong was come back to base to meet our new C.O.
It was funny, at the time, I was looking forward to meeting you.

09.06.21 O'NEILL-I need you to write down exactly how you got in, and exactly what I need to
do to fix this.

09.13.03 GRIEVES-If I do anything...*anything* – I want my sentence commuted.

09.18.15 O'NEILL-I think that's understood going in.

09.20.16 GRIEVES-And you'll need to take us with you. Kershaw and me.

09.24.14 O'NEILL-SG-1 can handle it.

09.25.26 GRIEVES (rants)-Who do you think you are?! We were good, Colonel, every bit as
good as you!
GRIEVES (OS CONT)-We believed what we were doing was for the good of the
country, ...
GRIEVES (CONT)-and if you hadn't put me in here, we might've had our own Sentinel
by now!

09.37.03 O'NEILL-Are you done?

09.38.11 GRIEVES-I don't care how good Carter thinks she is, or how *cocky* you are. The
device is way too complicated for you to try to repair without us. (beat) You
already know that, or you wouldn't be here.

10.02.03 TECHNICIAN-U.A.V. is away, sir, climbing into position.

10.06.22 CARTER (OS)-Receiving telemetry. Confirm two Staff cannon emplacements, ...
CARTER (CONT)-concealed twenty meters or so from the gate.
CARTER (OS CONT)-(to Hammond) We got lucky, sir.
CARTER (CONT)-The cannons weren't able to down the U.A.V. before it was out of
their range.

- 10.18.14 HAMMOND-Begin painting the target as soon as the U.A.V. reaches altitude. Close the blast doors. Prepare to launch.
- 10.26.00 TECHNICIAN (FILTERED, ECHOED)-Prepare to launch.
- 10.38.12 CARTER (OS)-Target Sierra-1 has been acquired.
- 10.40.11 HAMMOND-Sergeant, launch when ready.
- 10.48.02 TECHNICIAN-Missile away.
- 11.10.16 CARTER-Sierra-1 has been destroyed,...
CARTER (OS CONT)-attempting to acquire Sierra-2.
- 11.13.22 GRIEVES-How do you know those are the only emplacements guarding the gate?
- 11.18.03 O'NEILL-We don't.
- 11.19.00 CARTER-Sierra-2 has been acquired by U.A.V.
- 11.21.21 HAMMOND-Launch when ready.
- 11.27.14 WARRIOR-(SHOUTS)

- 11.33.15 CARTER (OS)-Sierra-2 has been destroyed,...
- CARTER (CONT)-but I can't confirm casualties. U.A.V. switching to recon mode for...
- CARTER (OS CONT)-stage two.
- 11.41.10 O'NEILL-That's us.
- 11.42.23 HAMMOND-Colonel, SG-3 will take...
- HAMMOND (OS CONT)-point.
- 11.53.13 GRIEVES-Kershaw.
- 11.56.19 O'NEILL-Major Lawrence, make it a clean sweep.
- 11.58.18 MAJOR LAWRENCE-Yes, sir.
- 12.00.24 O'NEILL-Why don't you go with them, keep 'em out of trouble. We'll be on your six
in...sixty seconds.
- 12.06.01 MAJOR LAWRENCE (OS)-SG-3. Let's go, let's go, let's...
- MAJOR LAWRENCE (CONT)-go!
- 12.09.14 GRIEVES (OS)-I'll...
- GRIEVES (CONT)-say it again, I don't like the idea of going into this unarmed.

- 12.13.00 O'NEILL-And...I don't care.
- 12.15.26 KERSHAW-Mm, I feel better just knowing there's an archaeologist watching our backs.
- 12.19.09 DANIEL-Yeah, which end do the bullets go in again?
- 12.22.00 GRIEVES-I'd be happy to show you.
- 12.27.27 O'NEILL-Our mission objective is to fix whatever you screwed up. If you get any ideas other than that, I'll shoot you. Understood?
- 12.40.26 GRIEVES-Yeah.
- 12.42.11 O'NEILL-Move out.
- 13.18.21 CARTER-No sign of SG-3.
- 13.21.16 O'NEILL (INTO RADIO)-SG-3, this...
O'NEILL (INTO RADIO CONT)-is SG-1 niner, report.
- 13.35.04 TEAL'C-Three Jaffa warriors survived the missile attack. SG-3 is in pursuit to prevent them from reporting our arrival. Major Lawrence suggests we continue on.

- 13.45.05 O'NEILL-Colonel?
- 13.47.13 GRIEVES-You want me to take point without a weapon?
- 13.50.11 O'NEILL-I want you to point Teal'c in the right direction.
- 14.03.01 DANIEL-Just out of curiosity... How many years did you promise to take off their sentence if they manage to fix this?
- 14.07.26 O'NEILL-Actually, they'll get a few more years out of this.
- 14.10.18 DANIEL-More?
- 14.12.15 O'NEILL-They were on death row.
- 14.21.06 CARTER-So, how did you manage to find the Sentinel if the Latonans didn't want to show it to you?
- 14.24.25 KERSHAW-Maybe we're good.
- 14.26.21 O'NEILL-Bribed the locals, eh?
- 14.28.04 GRIEVES (OS)-I see you've done *your* homework.

- 14.29.13 DANIEL-Major Benton’s preliminary report said the Latonans were egalitarian. They don’t use currency of any kind.
- 14.34.05 KERSHAW (OS)-They don’t care about material things.
- 14.36.29 O’NEILL-Everybody’s got their price.
- 15.01.01 GROGAN-Colonel...!
- 15.02.16 O’NEILL (OS)-Grogan. Are you all right?
- 15.10.05 GROGAN (OS)-There was a Jaffa patrol on my six most of the day.
GROGAN (CONT)-I decided to stop running and fight it out.
- 15.16.04 TEAL’C-How long ago?
- 15.17.03 GROGAN (OS) (getting his bearings)-Last night. I guess I passed...
GROGAN (CONT)-out and they went right by me. They’ll be long gone.
- 15.23.16 O’NEILL-Where’s the rest of your team?
- 15.25.00 GROGAN (OS)-Major Benton took a staff hit in the chest on our way back to the gate.
GROGAN (CONT)-Tarkman and Winters got away with me at first, but I’m the only one left,...
- GROGAN (OS CONT)-sir.

- 15.32.00 CARTER-Here.
- 15.35.03 GROGAN-This isn't supposed to be happening, sir. The Latonans have this device –
- 15.37.27 O'NEILL-We know, Lieutenant.
- 15.39.08 CARTER-We're here to fix it. (to O'Neill)-Sir, should I radio SG-3 and let them know...
CARTER (OS CONT)-Grogan's coming back to the gate?
- 15.45.01 O'NEILL-Negative, Major. (to Teal'c)-Teal'c, how soon should we expect a
mothership here?
- 15.50.22 TEAL'C-Of that I'm not sure, O'Neill. Could be hours, perhaps even days.
- 15.55.09 O'NEILL-Grogan, can you get me into the city?
- 15.57.15 GROGAN-There are Jaffa patrols all over the damn place making sure the Latonans
keep their curfew. (beat) But, yeah, I can take you straight to Marul if you want.
- 16.06.21 KERSHAW-That's a waste of time.
- 16.08.20 CARTER-Why do you say that?
- 16.10.02 KERSHAW-The Sentinel was built hundreds of years ago by Marul's ancestors. He
has no clue how to use it.

16.15.08 GRIEVES-None of ‘em do.

16.18.07 O’NEILL-All right, look. We’re here to help these people.

16.21.03 GRIEVES-What the hell d’you think *you* can do?

16.22.17 O’NEILL-Maybe give them another option than being *wiped out*.

O’NEILL (OS CONT)-Grogan, you good to go?

16.28.07 GROGAN-Mm-hm.

16.29.14 O’NEILL-Good. Carter, you’re in charge.

16.33.04 CARTER-Yes, sir.

16.34.24 O’NEILL-Fix it.

16.36.13 CARTER-Yes, sir. Good luck, sir. (beat) Let’s go.

17.06.06 GROGAN (OS)-That’s the main road leading in and out of the city.

17.10.05 O’NEILL-You wouldn’t happen to know a back way in there, would you?

17.14.00 GROGAN-Yes, sir, I think I do.

- 17.30.16 KERSHAW-This is it.
- 17.32.07 DANIEL-What is?
- 17.34.18 GRIEVES-You've got to know it's there. We went right by it the first time.
- 17.37.10 CARTER-All right. You're on.
- 17.49.24 TEAL'C (OS)-Major Carter, it would be wise if...
TEAL'C (CONT)-we were to remain in concealed positions guarding the entrance.
- 17.53.09 CARTER-Absolutely. At least, until the force field's down.
- 18.02.06 DANIEL-Now, how long will *that* take?
- 18.03.13 KERSHAW-Last time, it took just over forty-eight hours.
- 18.06.15 CARTER-Well, maybe Daniel can help you shave a couple of days off that estimate.
- 18.19.21 JAFFA COMMANDER (OS)-You are not preparing for his arrival as I instructed.
JAFFA COMMANDER (CONT)-Your people ignore the curfew.
- 18.25.27 MARUL-Because they do not understand it.

- 19.38.25 GROGAN-It's all right, Marul. He's a friend.
- 19.41.08 MARUL-From your world?
- 19.42.09 GROGAN-That's right. He's come all the way from Earth just to see you.
- 19.46.22 O'NEILL-I'm Colonel Jack O'Neill. We need to talk.
- 20.17.22 KERSHAW-Please don't do that.
- 20.21.02 DANIEL-It doesn't really look much like a weapon, does it?
- 20.23.04 GRIEVES-Why don't you make yourself useful, Doctor Jackson, and go watch the front door with your friends.
- 20.27.08 DANIEL-Well, I'd rather be trying to help *you*, but your approach looks completely random.
- 20.31.05 KERSHAW (OS)-The patterns...
KERSHAW (CONT)-change randomly. We're trying to keep ahead.
- 20.35.24 DANIEL-Those sounds?

22.09.09 O'NEILL-Marul, do you remember a team of guys who came here from Earth about two years ago?

22.14.06 MARUL-Oh. Colonel Grieves, of course. He asked that he might see the Sentinel,...
MARUL (OS CONT)-to learn its mysteries, so that, one day, your people might...
MARUL (CONT)-be protected, as we are. But to do that, that would be against our highest law. No one may see the Sentinel, except its Caretaker.

22.34.17 O'NEILL-Yeah... Well, they did anyway. Uh, they worked at night so no one would know. Somehow, they got in, they took it apart, put it...
O'NEILL (OS CONT)-back together again...but something's *wrong*.
O'NEILL (CONT)-They're there right now trying to fix it, but we might be running out of time.

22.51.13 MARUL-But...what you say cannot be so. This, this flame burns to tell us that the Sentinel is watching over us and, in turn, is being watched over. As long as this flame burns, we may rest assured that we are safe from harm.

23.08.07 O'NEILL (OS)-There is a battalion...
O'NEILL (CONT)-of Jaffa in your city right now, just waiting to harm you.

23.13.23 MARUL-There is an impenetrable barrier to the chamber.

23.16.06 O'NEILL-They got past it!

23.17.20 MARUL-Colonel Grievus gave me his word.

23.19.21 O'NEILL-He *lied*.

23.22.23 MARUL-Yet *you* speak the truth?

23.27.11 GROGAN-He does, Marul.

23.57.28 CARTER (INTO RADIO)-Teal'c, come in.

24.01.11 TEAL'C (INTO RADIO)-A Jaffa patrol.

24.03.18 CARTER (INTO RADIO)-I count ten, maybe more. With luck, they'll pass right by us.

24.08.20 TEAL'C (INTO RADIO)-It is more likely they have followed our tracks to this location.

24.26.26 GRIEVES-This is impossible.

24.28.12 KERSHAW-Look, we haven't been at it that long.

24.30.04 DANIEL-Let me try.

24.31.27 GRIEVES-D'you have any idea how complicated this code...
GRIEVES (OS CONT)-is?

- 24.33.24 DANIEL-Yes, I think so. Just let me try.
- 24.38.01 GRIEVES (OS)-It's hit the fan already.
GRIEVES (CONT)-Give me your Baretta. You think you can help in here? Well, I can help out there.
- 25.21.01 We have to take all of them out so they can't report back.
- 25.31.08 CARTER-A Jaffa patrol must have tracked us here!
- 25.38.04 CARTER (OS CONT)-We can hold them off for now! But get that Force...
CARTER (CONT)-Field down!
- 25.45.10 KERSHAW-D'you know what you're listening for?
- 25.46.24 DANIEL-The mathematical progression of the harmonic in each given pattern, relative to its spectral equivalent.
- 26.16.10 MARUL-My people have depended on the Sentinel for three hundred years. It was created to be there always. So that we might feel free to pursue matters of the mind and spirit without fear of what is happening now. (beat) If what you say is true...
- 26.37.09 O'NEILL-I didn't come all this way to lie to you.
- 26.39.12 MARUL-How many will die?

26.41.00 O'NEILL-I don't know. And I can't undo what's already been done. But we can still
save hundreds of your people. Maybe all of 'em.

26.49.06 MARUL-How?

26.50.18 O'NEILL-We're prepared to evacuate as many people as possible,...

O'NEILL (OS CONT)-and military support to get 'em to the gate.

26.57.01 MARUL-Leave our world?

27.00.03 O'NEILL-I'm afraid so. As we speak, a Goa'uld Mothership could be on its way here.

27.06.10 MARUL-What will I tell them? That the very people who doomed our world, now ask
us to trust our lives to them?

27.25.08 SVAROG (VO FILTERED, ECHOES)-I AM SVAROG. FROM THIS DAY FORTH,
YOU WILL SERVE ME.

27.58.23 GRIEVES-That's all of 'em I can see.

28.00.19 CARTER-What the hell are you doing out here?

28.02.00 GRIEVES-Helping you out.

- 28.02.28 CARTER-A mothership just opened up on the city.
- 28.04.26 GRIEVES-I saw –
- 28.05.23 CARTER (OS)-You need to get that...
CARTER (CONT)-Force Field down, that's the reason you're here.
- 28.09.05 GRIEVES-Jackson wanted a try. I gave him a try. You were getting shot at, so I
backed you up. Or is it you don't like the idea of me with a gun? It's empty.
- 28.19.02 CARTER-Get back in there. (beat) (INTO RADIO)-Teal'c, I wanna see what's taking
so long. Keep an eye out.
- 28.31.00 MARUL-That voice...
- 28.34.20 O'NEILL-All part of the show.
- 28.37.20 MARUL-The sky rained fire.
- 28.39.15 O'NEILL-It's from a ship in orbit. One with really big speakers.
- 28.44.25 ASSISTANT-Marul..?
ASSISTANT (OS CONT)-Marul!

- 28.52.12 MARUL (OS)-Has the messenger returned with any news?
- 28.56.08 GROGAN-There are Jaffa patrols all over the place. If Marul sent somebody, I doubt
 they made it...
 GROGAN (OS CONT)-very far.
- 29.00.20 MARUL (OS)-Go home. Tee h'eta.
- 29.07.01 O'NEILL-Do you have any other way of defending yourself?
- 29.16.21 (INTO RADIO)-Carter, come in.
- 29.18.17 CARTER (INTO RADIO)-Yes, sir.
- 29.19.20 O'NEILL (VO THRU RADIO FILTERED)-The Mothership's here. Some guy named...
 O'NEILL (CONT INTO RADIO)-Svarog.
- 29.24.21 CARTER (INTO RADIO)-He's one of the System Lords, sir. You should get out of
 there.
- 29.27.03 O'NEILL (INTO RADIO)-Yeah. Uh, what's your progress?
- 29.29.04 CARTER (INTO RADIO)-Still working on the Force Field, sir.
- 29.30.21 O'NEILL (INTO RADIO)-Major, people are startin' to die here.

29.33.04 CARTER (INTO RADIO)-Yes, sir. We're doing our best.

29.36.07 O'NEILL (INTO RADIO)-You tell Grievus if he doesn't fix that thing, I'll shoot him
anyway. (beat) (to Marul)-Marul, you have to make an announcement. Tell
your people to evacuate the city...
O'NEILL (OS CONT)-and head to the Stargate.

29.51.23 GROGAN-Many of your people could survive.

29.56.27 O'NEILL-You've got two options: sit here and watch your city burn to the ground...
O'NEILL (OS CONT)-or surrender. If you surrender,...
O'NEILL (CONT)-they'll enslave your people. And they'll take some of them as hosts.

30.07.10 GROGAN-The Goa'uld are parasites. They take over the bodies of people.

30.10.22 MARUL-My people are innocent. They have done nothing to deserve...
MARUL (OS CONT)-this.

30.14.29 O'NEILL-I can't stay here much longer. You've got to make a decision.

30.19.04 MARUL-But...but your friends may yet be able to repair the damage they have done.

30.23.15 O'NEILL-This Goa'uld is not gonna wait for that!

30.32.19 It's time to go. With or without you.

- 30.43.21 KERSHAW-Dammit!
