01:10:06:25 JACOB (CONT'D): every time a Tok'ra died at the end of a staff weapon, a Jaffa
was holding it.

01:10:11:26 JACOB (CONT'D O/S): We just got our asses kicked by an army of Jaffa...

01:10:15:17 JACOB (CONT'D): loyal to Anubis. You think that helps?

don't mean the end of the Goa'uld, I mean the end of us...

01:34:41:03 TEAL'C (CONT'D): an Ashrak. A highly trained Goa'uld assassin of great strength
and power, most likely in the service of Anubis.

01:34:47:09 FRAISER (O/S): Wasn't it an Ashrak who was able to...

01:36:15:11 O'NEILL: Carter...are we there yet?

01:36:19:00 CARTER: Almost, sir. The reactor wasn't designed for a sustained output at this frequency range.

01:37:26:00 O'NEILL: Medics, we've got wounded out here. Go to work.

01:37:28:20 O'NEILL: You okay?

01:37:29:20 PIERCE (O/S): Colonel.

01:37:30:20 PIERCE (CONT'D): I'm sorry, sir. Somehow it got my GDO during the firefight.
