01:06:17:23 JACOB: Everything's out of proportion. Physiologically, the heart and lungs had to be abnormally large to supply enough blood and oxygen to its muscles. Basically, it's like someone tried to genetically engineer the perfect athlete without any concern for longevity.

01:08:09:06 SELMAK: Remnants of a unique energy signature within its cells. It's similar to the residual effects left by use of a sarcophagus.

01:08:23:29 SELMAK (O/S): No.

01:08:25:02 SELMAK (CONT'D): A sarcophagus is designed to boost health and longevity, heal...

01:08:27:28 SELMAK (CONT'D O/S): Or revive someone terminally injured.

01:08:30:09 SELMAK (CONT'D): They are nowhere near powerful enough to animate non-living cellular matter.

01:08:33:26 CARTER: Then what could have?

01:08:35:01 SELMAK (O/S): Thousands of years ago...

01:08:36:01 SELMAK (CONT'D): A Goa'uld found a device originally created by the ancients.

01:08:39:20 SELMAK (CONT'D O/S): He determined its primary purpose was...

01:08:42:10 SELMAK (CONT'D): To heal but it was so powerful, its effects on human hosts ultimately proved devastating.

01:08:47:14 SELMAK (CONT'D O/S): However, after much research and experimentation...

01:08:50:29 SELMAK (CONT'D): The Goa'uld was able to use the technology to create the first sarcophagus.

01:08:55:14 DANIEL: Obviously, he wasn't able to eliminate all of its negative side effects.

01:08:58:18 SELMAK: The Tok'ra have long sought this device, in the hope of using it to perfect the sarcophagus technology...

01:09:04:18 SELMAK (CONT'D O/S): So that we could all benefit from it. Now...

01:09:07:13 SELMAK (CONT'D): It may be the key to fighting this new warrior.

01:09:10:19 CARTER: How?

01:09:11:19 SELMAK (O/S): With the device, we may be able...

01:09:13:09 SELMAK (CONT'D): To devise a weapon to counteract this life-giving energy.

01:09:17:16 DANIEL: Who was the first Goa'uld to find the device?

01:09:20:23 SELMAK: His name was Telchak.

01:09:22:17 DANIEL: Telchak.

01:09:25:19 DANIEL: Nicholas Ballard, my grandfather. One of Nick's early obsessions was finding the so-called "Fountain of Youth". He claimed he'd found evidence indicating the source of the fountain's power was a piece of alien technology used by early Mayan tribes around 900 BC.

01:09:45:16 JACOB (O/S): And you think this Chac may have actually been Telchak.

01:09:56:09 JACOB (CONT'D): For humans to see any positive effect, it would be from very limited exposure at a safe distance.

01:10:06:14 DANIEL: Nick believed Chac's temple was located somewhere in Central America. He spent decades of his life searching for it, but came up empty.

01:10:14:20 DANIEL (CONT'D): Indecipherable, and the only mention of the temple's location is somewhere near a waterfall and river.

01:10:21:12 JACOB: This is written in an obscure dialect of Goa'uld.

01:10:30:03 HAMMOND: So where is it?

01:10:31:09 DANIEL (O/S): It's here.

01:10:31:25 DANIEL (CONT'D): If Selmak's right, Telchak's temple is in southern Honduras.

01:10:35:08 HAMMOND: How can we be certain the device is there?

01:10:37:09 DANIEL: We can't, but...

01:10:39:22 CARTER: We think we know who's responsible for creating the Goa'uld warrior.

01:10:42:14 HAMMOND: Telchak?

01:10:43:19 DANIEL: No.

01:10:44:19 SELMAK (O/S): After Telchak created the sarcophagus...

01:10:47:13 SELMAK (CONT'D): Anubis went to war with him for possession of the original Ancient device.

01:10:51:10 DANIEL: That was long ago before Anubis attempted to Ascend.

01:10:53:24 SELMAK: Anubis defeated Telchak, but he never did find the device. It was
believe to be hidden in one of Telchak's many temples.

01:11:03:21 CARTER (O/S): He knew about the technology.

01:11:04:28 CARTER (CONT'D): While he never actually found the device, he ultimately
wouldn't need to.

could have built himself a new one.

 Goa'uld wither in defeat.

01:15:03:08 HAMMOND (CONT'D): This ancient device...

01:15:04:16 BRATAC (O/S): Even if he does...

01:15:05:16 BRATAC (CONT'D): There is no guarantee the Tok'ra can devise a weapon capable of fending off these warriors.

01:15:11:03 CARTER (O/S): We were only able to learn a limited amount...

01:15:13:04 CARTER (CONT'D): From our study of the dead warrior and its armor.

01:15:15:14 TEAL'C: The only way to learn more is through interrogation.

01:15:18:11 CARTER: Which means we have to capture one alive.

01:15:28:19 HAMMOND: What have we got, Major?

01:15:32:05 CARTER: The warrior's armor is able to resist our strongest armor-piercing weapons, as well as absorb energy weapon fire. However, we've discovered that the material is made up...
