06.20.26 O'NEILL- Sorry. Who's in charge here?

06.24.22 HIBBARD- Casualties don't ask questions.

06.27.11 CARTER (OS)- Uhh... what...
CARTER (CONT)- rules are we talking about...
CARTER (OS CONT)- exactly?

06.33.19 HIBBARD- I said...
HIBBARD (OS CONT)- stop!

06.36.18 JACKSON- We're just trying to understand...
JACKSON (OS)- if we're supposed to be dead, how are you supposed to

HIBBARD (OS)- Follow me.

07.14.14 O'NEILL- Anyone notice the patch?

07.16.26 CARTER- SG-X.

07.18.26 TEAL'C- There is no SG-X, O'Neill.

07.21.03 O'NEILL- Not under Hammond's command, no.

07.23.07 HIBBARD (OS)- Hey!

HIBBARD (CONT)- I said, "follow me".

- 07.36.15 SOLDIERS (VO FILTERED)- (unintelligible)....Yes, sir. Take ten men and go to the west side and set up a perimeter....yes, sir....don't stop, keep movin', keep movin'...(unintelligible)
- 07.54.04 O'NEILL- Hey guys.
- 07.56.10 TEAL'C- They are no more than children.
- 07.57.20 CARTER- Playing some kind of war game by the look of things. Who do you think they are? N.I.D.? Colonel Mayborne?
- 08.03.26 O'NEILL- I wouldn't put it past him.
- 08.15.19 HIBBARD- SG-1, reporting as ordered, sir!
- 08.22.07 ROGERS- You are all casualties until 1400 hours.
- 08.26.13 O'NEILL- Would that be Daylight Savings or Standard?
- 08.30.22 ROGERS- You may not speak. Except to answer a direct question by the evaluating officer. Is that clear?! Is this the way you behave in your quadrant, mister?
- 08.52.13 O'NEILL- I think "Colonel" is the proper way to address me...Captain.

- 08.57.28 ROGERS- No rank is above strict adherence to the rules of engagement.
ROGERS (OS)- Rule two. Article four. Unauthorized forces shall be shot
 on sight. You are Unauthorized.
ROGERS (CONT)- In fact, you ruined our ambush. Nearly half of the
 enemy team got away.
- 09.11.11 O'NEILL- Carter, I've never been real big on regs. Is this familiar to you?
- 09.16.17 CARTER- No, sir.
- 09.18.06 TEAL'C- They are familiar to me. Kal vak. Jaffa.
- 09.28.00 ROGERS- You're not from D quadrant.
- 09.28.16 TEAL'C- We are not.
- 09.30.12 ROGERS- Then you came through the Chappa' ai. This is a challenge.
- 09.34.13 JACKSON- The... Chappa' ai.
- 09.38.21 O'NEILL- Oi.
- 09.40.20 HIBBARD- He meant the Stargate, sir.

- 09.44.28 ROGERS- Stargate.
 ROGERS (OS)- Of course.
 ROGERS (CONT)- We've been so long without challenges. I am sorry,
 Master Jaffa. I have revealed myself...and failed.
 ROGERS (OS CONT)- You must execute me...
 ROGERS (CONT)- for the remainder of the day.
- 10.04.03 HIBBARD- You must execute me as well.
- 10.21.14 O'NEILL- Master Teal'c?
 O'NEILL (OS CONT)- Might I suggest...
 O'NEILL- (CONT)- we...spare them this time?
- 10.30.08 TEAL'C- Very well. Underling. Captain? Your full name and rank.
- 10.39.23 ROGERS- My Earth name is Captain Kyle Rogers. Acting Quadrant A
 Commander, sir!
- 10.45.12 CARTER- Your Earth name?
- 10.47.05 TEAL'C (OS)- Your standing orders...
 TEAL'C (CONT)- given to you by your previous Jaffa master.

- 10.50.13 ROGERS- To practice the exercises of battle according to the rules of engagement until the return of our lord, Apophis!
- 10.58.02 JACKSON- Really...
- 10.59.05 ROGERS (OS)- When we are ready for...
ROEGRS (CONT)- the Final Challenge, he will come.
- 11.02.16 O'NEILL- Don't hold your breath.
- 11.04.16 ROGERS- We will be ready.
- 11.07.04 CARTER- You're training to serve Apophis wearing SG uniforms?
- 11.12.06 ROGERS- To know the enemy? Quadrant A has spared no detail.
ROGERS (OS)- We've studied long...and hard...and know much.
- 11.18.23 CARTER- About Earth?
- 11.20.00 ROGERS- Oh, yes. Corn and cotton are indigenous to North America.
- 11.25.10 O'NEILL- And that information could save your life one day.

- 11.28.17 ROGERS (OS)- So you see Master Teal'c?
ROGERS (CONT)- My mistake will not happen again. I am ready to
 infiltrate the Tauri at your command.
- 11.35.15 TEAL'C- That time has not yet come, Captain Rogers.
- 11.39.10 JACKSON (OS)- So...
JACKSON (CONT)- if you're pretending to be...who are those Jaffa
 attacking you?
- 11.48.05 ROGERS- They were led by my second-in-command. Captain Nelson.
 As part of the daily exercise. We have kept the Jaffa encampment
 separate...
ROGERS (OS CONT)- so that we may better practice our Earth behavior.
ROGERS (CONT)- Shall I have him sent for?
- 12.00.05 JACKSON- No, I don't think that will be necessary.
- 12.02.22 TEAL'C- Send for him.
- 12.03.28 JACKSON- Yes! Send for him.
- 12.09.26 ROGERS- How else may I serve?

- 12.11.17 O'NEILL- We'd like our weapons back. The ones... we came with.
- 12.16.00 ROGERS- They were stored in the armory tent. At the conclusion of this morning's war game.
- 12.20.07 TEAL'C- Take us to them.
- 12.21.21 ROGERS- As you wish.
- 12.27.21 SOLDIER (VO FILTERED)- Ten-hut, two , three, four!
- 12.36.05 CARTER- Colonel, none of them have symbiote pouches.
- 12.40.00 O'NEILL- I noticed that.
- 12.41.00 TEAL'C- Before Apophis requested asylum from the Tauri, there were but a handful of loyal Jaffa remaining in his service.
- 12.47.13 JACKSON- So he drafted ordinary humans?
- 12.49.25 TEAL'C- It is common practice among the Goa'uld to use humans as fodder during battle. Especially when facing defeat.
- 12.56.14 SOLDIERS (VO FILTERED)- (Unintelligible)

13.15.20 O'NEILL- All right, Captain. We can handle it from here.

13.17.26 ROGERS- I can assist you.

13.21.25 TEAL'C- Shal kek!

13.24.04 ROGERS- Yes, master.

13.26.24 O'NEILL (OS)- So Teal'c? How do you know about these rules of engagement?

13.30.26 TEAL'C- They are the code of battle during a young Jaffa's training...

TEAL'C (OS CONT)- spoken by Apophis himself.

13.36.03 CARTER- Teal'c, what about these?

13.38.28 TEAL'C- They are Intar.

13.40.16 O'NEILL- Short for...

13.42.20 TEAL'C-Intar.

TEAL'C (OS CONT)- They are used for training and only meant to stun.

TEAL'C (CONT)- They can be identified by this crystal. They can take the form of any weapon.

- 13.53.00 CARTER (OS)- Well, I got our...
CARTER (CONT)- G.D.O.'s, but my MP-5's still missing.
- 13.56.14 TEAL'C- As is my staff weapon.
- 13.59.11 O'NEILL (OS)- All right, Teal'c...
O'NEILL (CONT)- I want everyone in one place. Just to make sure. Can
you handle that?
- 14.05.17 TEAL'C- I can.
- 14.07.27 O'NEILL- You two keep lookin'.
- 14.16.06 TEAL'C- Captain Rogers. Where are the weapons with which we arrived?
- 14.23.10 ROGERS- They were returned to the armory tent, of course.
- 14.29.18 TEAL'C- Do you possess a Vo'cume?
- 14.31.13 ROGERS- Yes, sir.
- 14.33.04 TEAL'C- Use it.
- 14.34.16 ROGERS- Yes, Master Teal'c.

- 14.44.18 O'NEILL- What'd you tell him to do?
- 14.47.06 TEAL'C- I instructed him to use a training instrument to assemble his men
for inspection.
TEAL'C (OS CONT)- It may serve to emphasize our authority.
- 15.14.22 O'NEILL- Whoa.
- 15.17.12 APOPHIS- Warriors of Apophis. Assemble before me and listen to he
that possesses the Vo'cume.
- 15.24.14 CARTER (OS)- Sir?
- 15.26.12 O'NEILL- Just a huge, honkin' Apophis, Major.
O'NEILL (OS CONT)- Nothin' to worry about.
- 15.41.04 APOPHIS- The warrior before you speaks in my name.
APOPHIS (OS CONT)- Heed his words.
- 15.51.10 ROGERS- I would be honored if you would inspect my warriors, master.
Company!
- 16.02.04 TEAL'C- Ready weapons for inspection.
TEAL'C (OS CONT)- You do yourself proud, Captain Rogers.

- 17.41.15 NELSON- Sir?
- 17.49.00 O'NEILL- It's over, Nelson. Go tell your buddies to quit fightin'.
- 17.56.24 NELSON- You speak more like a Tauri than a warrior of Apophis.
- 18.00.06 O'NEILL- Well, thanks. You're not so bad yourself. Who taught you?
- 18.04.17 NELSON- If you are who you say you are, you already know the answer to
that, sir.
- 18.09.09 O'NEILL- Nelson? I am ordering you to recall your men from the field.
- 18.13.00 NELSON- Article Seven, Section Three, clearly states that once the battle
has commenced, it cannot be stopped.
- 18.18.18 O'NEILL- Well, you're obviously referring to the old Article seven.
- 18.27.25 CARTER- That's it.
- 18.30.18 JACKSON- That means those kids are out there playing war games with
real weapons.
- 18.34.06 CARTER- Colonel.

- 18.35.03 O'NEILL (VO RADIO FILTERED)- Go ahead, Carter.
- 18.36.07 CARTER- So far, all we've recovered is one nine millimeter and one MP-5.
- 18.39.26 O'NEILL- Roger that. Keep lookin'.
- 18.46.12 TEAL'C- I require all of Quadrant A to be assembled, including those engaged in the games. Immediately!
- 18.52.02 ROGERS- As Captain Nelson stated, Master, art...
- 18.53.08 TEAL'C (OVERLAPPING)- Do you wish to be punished?
- 18.55.25 ROGERS- I'll not fail your challenge a second time, Master Teal'c.
- 19.02.00 O'NEILL- Tell him the truth.
- 19.07.15 TEAL'C- Warriors of Apophis. Hear me. Apophis has been slain in battle with his enemies.
- 19.18.22 O'NEILL- Hey! He's telling you the truth. The battle you've been preparing for is never going to happen. He's not coming back. Hellooo, is this mike on? We're trying to tell you something important, here!

- 19.35.15 ROGERS (OS)- Apophis is a god.
 ROGERS (CONT)- And gods cannot die.
 ROGERS (OS CONT)- Therefore, Apophis cannot be dead.
- 19.41.04 NELSON- And anyone who says otherwise is either testing us...or is a
 traitor.
 NELSON (OS CONT)- Sir.
- 19.45.25 ROGERS (OS)- Sir. Now, we've passed your challenge.
 ROGERS (CONT)- If there's nothing else, sirs, we're scheduled to join the
 games in progress. Company! Dismissed!
- 20.04.29 TEAL'C- Apophis has lived for a thousand years. It is as if we said the sun
 will never rise again.
- 20.13.09 O'NEILL- It just might not for some of those kids if they don't wise up.
- 20.17.05 SOLDIER (VO FILTERED)- Jackson.
- 20.28.25 O'NEILL- What's goin' on?
- 20.32.06 HIBBARD- I'm trying to get a weapon, sir. I'm already late, the games
 have started.

20.35.11 CARTER- Colonel, one MP-5, Teal'c's staff weapon and two nine millimeters are still unaccounted for.

20.43.00 JACKSON (OS)- What does that mean?

20.44.00 HIBBARD- It means my team needs reinforcements.

20.46.15 O'NEILL- NO. The game is canceled.

20.49.19 HIBBARD (OS)- You can't do that.

20.57.00 O'NEILL (OS)- I believe...

O'NEILL (CONT)- I can.

20.58.16 HIBBARD- (groans)

21.02.15 O'NEILL- Everybody grab an Intar.

21.22.18 CARTER- It's a staff weapon wound. He's dead, sir.

21.30.00 O'NEILL (OS)- Take cover!

21.38.12 ROGERS- Colonel! I'll draw his fire.

21.40.03 O'NEILL- Negative! That is a real weapon!

21.46.01 ROGERS- Apophis will protect me.

21.48.00 O'NEILL- I said...

O'NEILL (OS CONT)- stay down!

21.52.23 ROGERS- (grunts)

21.55.05 GOA'ULD- (grunts)

21.56.25 O'NEILL- Secure that weapon!

21.58.09 CARTER- Yes, sir!

22.04.04 ROGERS- Have I displeased Apophis?

22.06.22 JACKSON- No.

22.09.15 TEAL'C- Apophis would be proud.

22.19.00 ROGERS- This is the Final Challenge.

22.21.29 NELSON- What happened?

- 22.26.16 ROGERS- The day has come, Nelson. It's the Final Challenge. (groans)
- 22.37.16 NELSON- Blood has been shed.
- 22.41.00 ROGERS- Prepare the men.
ROGERS (OS CONT)- The challenge must begin at first light.
- 22.44.24 NELSON- Yes, sir.
- 22.52.18 O'NEILL- What's he talkin' about? The Final Challenge?
- 22.56.27 TEAL'C- It is the day in a warrior's training when first blood is shed. And
 the games become real.
- 23.05.14 O'NEILL- Oi.
- 23.12.00 CARTER (VO RADIO FILTERED)- Colonel? We found something.
CARTER (CONT)- Our weapons were all turned in after the wargames,
 sir.
- 23.16.22 O'NEILL- Roger, that. Keep 'em secure. How's he doin'?
- 23.28.13 NELSON- Apophis will save him.

- 23.30.05 JACKSON- Well, actually, no.
JACKSON (OS)- As a matter of fact, there's probably nothing more we can do for him, as long as we stay here. There's probably internal injuries.
- 23.37.14 O'NEILL- So, we'll take him back with us.
- 23.40.07 NELSON- You cannot.
- 23.42.06 O'NEILL- Fer cryin' out loud.
- 23.43.21 NELSON- You know as well as I do: that the rules forbid entry or exit of the...
NELSON (OS CONT)- sector before the Final Challenge. Wounded...or not.
- 23.50.19 O'NEILL- Right, right, right.
- 23.52.13 ROGERS (OS)- Apophis would be...
ROGERS (CONT)- disappointed in me if... (shudders)... it there were an exception made for myself.

- 23.57.16 JACKSON (OS)- What if...
JACKSON (CONT)- I told you we were bringing you to see Apophis personally?
JACKSON (OS CONT)- To show him that...
JACKSON (CONT)- blood has been shed and that your quadrant is truly ready for his return? If we don't bring you back with us, then Apophis will know you failed our challenge and never return.
- 24.16.15 ROGERS- Then I must go.
- 24.17.13 O'NEILL-Good.
- 24.24.12 NELSON- Tell him we will make him proud.
- 24.28.07 ROGERS- I will.
- 24.41.04 O'NEILL- Need a medical team!
- 24.50.16 HAMMOND- What happened, Colonel?
- 24.52.20 ROGERS- My lord?
- 24.55.01 O'NEILL- Actually, we just call him General Hammond.

- 24.58.07 ROGERS- Where is Apophis?
- 25.01.06 O'NEILL- He's not here. I'm sorry.
- 25.03.04 FRASIER (OS)- What have we got?
- 25.04.21 ROGERS- Liars. Traitors!
- 25.07.07 FRASIER (OS)- Easy! Easy!
- 25.09.17 ROGERS- You will be punished. He will avenge me!
- 25.12.15 FRASIER- Who is this, sir?
- 25.13.17 O'NEILL- His name is Rogers. Despite appearances, he' s not SGC.
- 25.16.22 ROGERS- He will strike you down! You will all die!
- 25.19.25 FRASIER- Go! Let's get him to the infirmary!
- 25.25.08 HAMMOND- I'd like to de-brief, ASAP, Colonel.
- 25.29.14 O'NEILL- Yes, my lord.

- 26.11.23 TEAL'C (OS)- The Jaffa...
TEAL'C- (CONT)- masters who once supervised their war games have
 long ago abandoned them.
TEAL'C (OS CONT)- Yet, they have maintained their games until this day
 without fail.
- 26.19.09 JACKSON- So, what are you saying?
- 26.21.07 TEAL'C- That they are extremely resourceful and most determined.
- 26.23.15 CARTER- So...they might try to fulfill the Final Challenge whether they're
 issued lethal weapons or not.
- 26.29.10 TEAL'C- It is possible.
- 26.30.10 JACKSON (OS)- Well, let's face...
JACKSON (CONT)- it. If they really want to kill each other, they don't
 need guns to do it.
- 26.35.15 CARTER- We have to go back there, sir, and try to prevent this from
 happening.

- 26.41.28 JACKSON (OS)- General, we're indirectly responsible for all this. They think that...
- JACKSON (CONT)- we were sent through to... start this.
- 26.47.13 HAMMOND- I understand that.
- 26.49.04 O'NEILL- What we need to send back there is a team of shrinks. Those kids are out there.
- 26.54.16 HAMMOND (OS)- Maybe so, Colonel. But before I...
- HAMMOND (CONT)- send you or anyone else into a battle zone, I want to know what's going on--on that planet.
- 27.03.11 O'NEILL- Why don't I see what I can get out of Rogers?
- 27.06.21 HAMMOND- Very well.
- 27.16.08 FRASIER (OS)- He won't...
- FRASIER (CONT)- eat, he won't speak—except to call me a Sholva.
- 27.20.23 O'NEILL- You must be doin' a good job.

- 27.23.03 FRASIER- There's no internal injury. He mustn't have taken the full force
of the blast. Physically, he'll be fine. Emotionally...
- FRASIER (OS CONT)- that's another story.
- FRASIER (CONT)- He's very angry, Colonel.
- 27.33.16 O'NEILL- Where's his tray?
- 27.34.18 FRASIER- Right here. Good luck.
- 27.56.10 O'NEILL- Well, OI Doc Frasier says you haven't been eatin'.
- 27.59.27 ROGERS- It's poison.
- 28.01.12 O'NEILL- It's hospital food, of course it is. Mmmm. Tuna.
- 28.15.08 ROGERS- Go to Sokar.
- 28.19.00 O'NEILL- It's "go to hell", actually.
- O'NEILL (OS CONT)- Which...
- O'NEILL (CONT)- by the way is a very rude thing to say to a person
offering you a sandwich.
- 28.26.00 ROGERS (OS)- It means the same.

- 28.29.13 O'NEILL- You've got a point.
- 28.31.25 ROGERS- I will reveal nothing. You may begin torturing me.
- 28.36.17 O'NEILL- Oh, I've already begun. This...is the infamous "Tuna Torture".
Last chance. Good. So. You and I should have a little talk about
this Final Challenge thing.
- 29.15.05 ROGERS- We will battle to the death.
ROGERS (OS CONT)- And Apophis...
ROGERS (OS CONT) – will choose the victors as his personal guard.
- 29.29.21 O'NEILL (OS) - All right.
O'NEILL (CONT)- I'm gonna tell you the absolute truth right now. Apophis
is dead.
- 29.29.00 ROGERS- Gods cannot die. (grunts)
- 29.31.20 O'NEILL- Why do you think he's been gone for so long? Why have all the
Jaffa masters left? Apophis was on his way out when you got
drafted.
- 29.41.02 ROGERS- You lie.

- 29.41.21 O'NEILL- What if he told you himself?
- 29.43.29 ROGERS- If Apophis can speak, then he cannot be dead.
- 29.55.01 JACKSON- When Apophis came to us, he had already been tortured.
- 29.59.06 ROGERS- Impossible. He is a god.
- 30.04.08 CARTER- The images we are about to show you are of Apophis just
before he died...
CARTER (OS CONT)- and his body was sent to Sokar.
- 30.11.25 ROGERS- Gods cannot die.
- 30.13.02 O'NEILL- So you keep saying. Have a look.
- 30.22.00 APOPHIS (MONITOR FILTERED)- Help me. A host. I am...afraid.
(gasps)
- 31.07.11 ROGERS- What magic is this?
- 31.08.28 O'NEILL- No magic. I was there.

- 31.13.03 TEAL'C- As was I.
- 31.15.29 ROGERS- Then it is true.
- 31.18.12 TEAL'C- It is.
- 31.29.12 ROGERS- What will you do to us?
- 31.31.14 CARTER- We're not going to do anything to you. We want to help you.
- 31.37.09 O'NEILL- You can go home. Wherever that is. War's over.
- 31.44.02 ROGERS- No, it's not.
ROGERS (OS CONT)- Because...
ROGERS (CONT)- tomorrow the Final Challenge begins. And many of
 my men will die. For him.
- 32.07.02 HAMMOND (OS)- What's your real name, son?
- 32.09.16 ROGERS- My true name is Rophiaggisy, sir.
- 32.13.08 O'NEILL- Your earth name is Kyle. Can we call you Kyle?
- 32.16.14 ROGERS- That would be fine, sir. I'm very used to that.

- 32.18.25 HAMMOND- How long have you been on that planet?
- 32.21.07 ROGERS- We were brought there through our Chappa'ai five cycles ago
 from a...number of different worlds.
- 32.36.09 CARTER- Right after we blew up Apophis' ships.
- 32.28.06 ROGERS (OS)- He commanded that we worship...
 ROGERS (CONT)- no other god but him. He left many Jaffa warriors with
 us. They taught us everything.
- 32.35.24 HAMMOND (OS)- Who taught you all about Earth?
 HAMMOND (CONT)- Our uniforms, weapons.
- 32.39.00 ROGERS (OS)- Near the beginning...
 ROGERS (CONT)- Apophis captured one of your SG teams and forced
 them to teach us.
- 32.44.08 CARTER- SG-11.

32.46.08 ROGERS- Yes.

ROGERS (OS CONT)- At first, that was all they would reveal. But...
